MONTHLY SUMMARY OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS 01 June 2014 – 30 June 2014

The following summary tables and overview of events survey hostile Israeli activities during the period 01 June 2014 to 30 June 2014. The report includes a summary table of events, classified by type, throughout the West Bank and Gaza Strip, in addition to a comparative table surveying events over the past three months. The survey is compiled from the Daily Situation Reports of the Palestinian Monitoring Group (PMG) of the Negotiations Affairs Department (NAD) of the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO). The PMG monitors ground conditions in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, including Israeli and Palestinian violations. The PMG Daily Situation Reports are a survey of daily events collated from information provided by civil ministries and security agencies of the Palestinian National Authority. The information reported through the PMG process represents data available at the time of distribution only.

SAMPLE OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS DURING THE MONTH OF JUNE 2014

- **June 2nd 2014:** Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara Checkpoint opened fire towards and killed Alaa Odeh, a resident of Huwara in Nablus (for allegedly opening fire towards Israeli forces according to the Israeli Military) during which Israeli military prevented Medical personnel and ambulances from reaching him.
- **June 8th 2014:** At 06:30 on June 8th 2014, Imad Salam died of injuries sustained after Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards his fishing boat off the shores of Beit Lahiya as mentioned in May 27th 2014 Report.
- **June 11th 2014:** Israeli drones launched missiles towards a motor cycle carrying a Palestinian gunmen in Beit Lahiya and as a result killed a gunmen: Mohammad Al-Arour and injured 3 residents including 2 critically injured and a child: Ali Al-Arour (10 years old), Hamad Nassar and Munthir Al-Massar'i.
- June 14th 2014: Ali Al-Arour (10 years old)died of injuries sustained after Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards a Palestinian Gunmen travelling on a motor cycle in Beit Lahiya as mentioned in June 12th 2014 Report
- **June 16th 2014:** At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazun camp, clashed with its residents as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result killed a resident: Ahmad Samad'a and injured Ibrahim Thaher, Mohammad Husni, Mohammad Abu Sharifa, Eyad Abu Radaha and detained 5 residents then withdrew at 04:45.
- **June 19th 2014:** Israeli forces raided Dura, Sinjil area and Nazlat Jawiya village, clashed with several residents as the stormed and searched homes and as a result killed a child: Mohammad Dudien (14 years old) and injured Ramzi Al-Sha'rawi and closed down an Orphanage and confiscated several computers and files and searched a Traffic Police office after blasting the main entrance using explosives and detained 3 residents.
- **June 21**st **2014:** Israeli forces raided Harris village, stormed and searched Abu Bakr Al-Sadiq mosque, a reception hall and several homes and as a result killed a resident: Jamil Suf (60 years old after he suffered a heart attack as Israeli forces stormed his home and prevented medical unites from reaching him and also assaulted and injured 2 residents: Jawdat Daoud and Awad Daoud (broken arm) then withdrew at 05:20.
- June 22nd 2014: Israeli forces raided Ramallah and Al-Bireh cities, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and merchant shops as well as Rashad school for the mute and an Islamic charity organization and as a result injured killed a resident: Mohammad Ismail and injured 6 others: Usayed Sawafta, Mohammad Badwan, Alaa Zawari', Othman Daraja, Odeh Al-Barghouthi, and Ahmad Atta and summoned Bushra Al-Taweel to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- **June 22nd 2014:** Israeli forces raided Nablus, Balata and Ein Beit Al-Ma camps, stormed and searched several homes and buildings, opened fire towards a resident: Ahmad Khaled as he was heading to the mosque for dawn prayers and as a result killed him.
- **June 25**th **2014:** Mustafa Aslan (A resident of Qalandiya camp) died of serious injuries sustained during clashed with Israeli forces in Qalandiya camp as mentioned in the June 20th 2014 Report.
- **June 26th 2014**: Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, clashed with residents in Sa'ir as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result killed a 65 year old resident: Fatima Rushdi after she suffered a heart attack as result of the attack on her home and injured 9 residents and left several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation and detained 3 residents.
- **June 27th 2014**: Israeli Drones lunched missiles towards a vehicle carrying 2 Palestinian gunmen near Al-Shat'e camp in Gaza and as a result killed Mohammad Qaddih and Osama Al-Husami.
- June 29th 2014: Israeli Drones launched missiles towards Palestinian gunmen in east Al-Qarara and as a result killed Mohammad Abu Rizq and injured 2 others.





Killings and Assassinations:

A total of **11** killings were reported in the month of June:

Injuries

A total of 181 injuries were reported in the month of June (144 Palestinians in the West Bank and 37 in the Gaza Strip). Injuries included 34 children, 1 elderly resident and 12 Women.

Arrests


During the month of June, the Israeli military arrested 781 Palestinians (775 the West Bank and 6 in the Gaza Strip). The majority of arrests took place in the districts of Jerusalem (115); Ramallah (76); Jenin (55); Tubas (8) Tulkarem (24); Qalqiliya (37); Nablus (97); Salfit (20); Jericho (13); Bethlehem (103); Hebron (227), North Gaza (5) and Khan Yunis (1). Among those arrested by the Israeli military were: 36 children; 15 University student, 19 Members of Palestinian Parliament (PLC), 52 Ex-detainees previously released in the "Gilad Shalit" prisoner exchange agreement with Israel, 2 fisherman and 14 Security Force officers.

Israeli forces temporarily detained 296 residents at checkpoint and in residential area including 15 children, 2 Journalists, a Palestine Television news crew, 5 Women and 12 Security Force officers.

Closure

Especially on Fridays, the Israeli military continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances of Jerusalem, and to restrict entrance to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem, preventing worshippers from accessing the Mosque. At the Qalandiya checkpoint north of Jerusalem, the Israeli military continues to prevent PNA registered civilian vehicles from crossing the checkpoint towards Ar Ram and Qalandiya as well as Dahiyat al Bareed. The checkpoint is overcrowded daily, particularly during rush hours, due to intensified restrictions and search measures applied by Israeli troops. During the month of March the Israeli military also continued to intensify restrictions at the *Tayasir checkpoint* and *Al Hamra junction checkpoint* leading to the Jordan Valley area, only allowing access to civilians whose IDs indicate District of Jericho residence or others holding special access permits. In addition, restrictions were intensified and civilian access was obstructed at the **Za'tara junction checkpoint** (separating the northern and central West Bank districts) as well as at the As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint (separating the central and southern West Bank districts). The Israeli military installed 555 flying checkpoints in June (compared with 491 in May and 511 in April) and as a result restricted the free access and

movement of residents, merchant supplies and agricultural goods.



Distribution of flying checkpoints in the West Bank


The Israeli military set up 555 flying checkpoints in June and searched Palestinian civilians and vehicles in and around Palestinian residential areas in the districts of Jerusalem (91); Ramallah (57); Jenin (14), Tubas (15); Tulkarem (10); Qalqiliya (54); Nablus (38); Salfit (16); Jericho (93); Bethlehem (68) and Hebron (99).

5. Attacks

A total of 431 attacks were reported to have taken place during the month of June (327 in the West Bank and 104 in the Gaza Strip).

The Israeli military carried out 13 attacks during raids into Palestinian residential areas, 306 attacks during confrontations between the Israeli military and Palestinians, 22 attacks from Israeli military posts on civilian homes and property, and 9 from settler attacks. In addition Israeli navy vessels carried out 18 attacks on Palestinian fishermen and territory, Israeli aircrafts carried out 60 attacks on civilian targets and Israeli forces carried out attacks from Military checkpoints on 3 occasions.

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli military declared a unilateral ceasefire following the large-scale offensive it had launched against the Gaza Strip. However, the Israeli military violated the ceasefire on **104** occasions during the month of June (compared to **54** last May). Also disregarding Israel's unilaterally declared ceasefire armed Palestinian groups fired **51** mortar rounds.




Attacks on residential areas in West Bank districts

6. Raids

The Israeli military carried out a total of **918 raids** in Palestinian residential areas during the month of June, including **913 in the West Bank** and **5 in the Gaza Strip.** The majority of Israeli military raids were reported to have taken place in the districts of Jerusalem (60); Ramallah (97); Jenin (97); Tubas (14); Tulkarem (58); Qalqiliya (48); Nablus (125); Salfit (35); Jericho (24); Bethlehem (127); Hebron (228); North Gaza (1), Gaza (2), Khan Yunis (1) and Rafah (1).

The Israeli military opened fire on 319 occasions during raids and clashes with civilians. (A total of 74% of attacks) *The chart below shows the correlation between the number of raids and the resulting human casualties in June.*



7. Home Demolition

During the month of June 2014 the Israeli military demolished Palestinian homes and residential tents which consisted of the following:

- Israeli forces demolished 2 homes in Jabal Al-Aswad area west Al-Khadr in Bethlehem.
- Israeli forces demolished 4 homes in Barin area located in between Hebron and Yatta.
- Israeli forces demolished a home (under construction) in Khirbit Al-Ras area of Ithna in Hebron.
- Israeli forces demolished a home (under construction) in Far'un village in Tulkarem.

The Israeli Military served the following demolition orders during the Month of June 2014:

• Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a home in Beit Liqya village in Ramallah.

- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish 3 homes in Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a home in Ithna village in Hebron.

8. Attacks on Public and Private Property

A total of 331 **incidents of destruction and confiscation** of Palestinian public and private property by Israeli settlers and Israeli forces were reported in June 2014

Attack on Public and Private property occurred as follows per District:

Jerusalem: Israeli forces closed an elementary school in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood in Jerusalem, demolished the outer fence of a home in Shu'fat camp, stormed Al-Quds Development Association located on Salah Al-Din road and order its closure for a period of 12 months, Israeli settlers slashed the tires of 3 vehicles in Beit Hanina, Israeli forces closed down a Charitable association in Sur Bahar village and Woman's association in Beit Safafa village, demolished a fruit and vegetable shop and a car wash in Al-Eizariya, Israeli settlers set fire to and destroyed several tons of Wheat and flour harvest in Al-Jib village, Israeli forces stormed the offices of Palestine television and interrupted the live broad cast of "Good Morning Jerusalem show" in Al-Tur neighbourhood, Israeli forces demolished 5 barracks used as car wash and car repair shops in Hizma and demolished the outer fence of parking lots in Al-Sheikh area, demolished a livestock barrack (Hose Barn) in Silwan and a storage room near a home in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem.

Ramallah & Al-Bireh: Israeli forces closed the offices of "Tarnsmedia" in Al-Bireh city.

<u>Jenin</u>: Israeli forces damaged furniture as they stormed and searched 2 homes in Arraba and Bir Al-Basha villages, Israeli forces damaged furniture as they stormed and searched 7 homes in Jenin and Jenin camps, Israeli settlers killed 10 heads of livestock (goats) after running them over with his vehicle near the entrance of Barta'a Al-Sharqiya.

Tubas: Israeli forces demolished 8 fruit and vegetable selling vendors located along road (90) near Ein Al-Bayda and Al-Zabidat villages.

<u>Tulkarem:</u> Israeli forces damaged the main entrance of a charitable organization as they stormed and searched it in Tulkarem city.

<u>Nablus:</u> Israeli settlers damaged a vehicle and damaged several Olive trees in the area between Talfit, Al-Sawiya and Qaryut villages, Israeli forces escorted several archaeologists as they levelled archeological sites in Burqa village and Israeli forces damaged furniture as they stormed and searched several homes in Awarta village.

Qalqiliya: Israeli settlers chopped off the limbs of several Olive trees as they stormed Kafr Qaddum village and damaged several oat and wheat harvest sacks in Jinsafut village, set fire to and damaged several Olive trees in Far'ata and Immatin villages.

Bethlehem: Israeli settlers uprooted and damaged several trees and plants as well as damaging an irrigation network in Husan village, uprooted and damaged several Olive tree and Grape vines in Nihalin village, Israeli settlers uprooted and damaged several Grape vines near "Betar Aliyat" settlement.

<u>Hebron:</u> Israeli forces damaged furniture as they stormed and searched 3 homes in Halhul, damaged a vehicle in Haska area in Halhul, detonated and damaged a main entrance for a home using explosives as they stormed and searched a home in Dura, Israeli forces closed down a Orphan fund organization in Dura, Israeli forces set fire to and damaged several Olive trees in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and Israeli forces demolished several vegetable and fruit vending carts along road (60) near Beit Ummar.

Gaza: Israeli airstrikes towards Gaza destroyed a steel mill and damaged 4 other industrial mills (Lime stone, stone cutting and Wood mills).

North Gaza: Israeli airstrikes towards North Gaza caused extensive damage to 8 homes, several vehicles and a steel mill.

The Israeli military served the following Halt to construction and demolition orders for the month of June 2014:

- The Israeli Military served a Military order for the removal of a steel fence surrounding approximately 150 dunumes (acres) of agricultural land in Um Al-Kheir village in Hebron.
- The Israeli Military served a demolition order to demolish a Livestock barracks owned by an Islamic Charitable fund in Hebron.
- The Israeli Military served a military order for the closure of an electronic appliance store in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- The Israeli Military served a demolition order for the demolition of a barracks (Used as a chicken coup) in the old city of Hebron

<u>Israeli forces confiscated the following property during the month of June 2014:</u>

- Jerusalem: Israeli forces confiscated surveillance camera footage from a merchant shop in Ras Khamis neighbourhood, a computer and cellular telephone, several files and surveillance camera footage from several merchant shops, confiscated several Television Cameras and Broadcasting equipment as they stormed Palestine Television offices in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood and stopped the broad cast of "Good Morning Palestine Show".
- Ramallah: Israeli forces confiscated a computer and surveillance camera footage from a gas station in Al-Bireh city and confiscated a computer and laser printer in Beituniya.
- **Jenin:** Israeli forces confiscated 8 agricultural tractors in Al-Yamun.
- <u>Tulkarem:</u> Israeli forces confiscated. a computer and cellular telephone, several files and surveillance camera footage from several merchant shops.
- Nablus: Israeli forces confiscated a computer, 150000 NIS approximately \$43000 in Madma village and 5000 JD in Nablus, 5000 JD and a computer in Asira Al-Shamliya.
- Salfit: Israeli forces confiscated 85000 NIS approximately \$24600 in Iskaka village
- <u>Bethlehem:</u> Israeli forces confiscated a computer and surveillance camera footage for a Currency exchange store in Bethlehem and 10000 NIS approximately \$3450 in Beit Sahur.
- Hebron: Israeli forces confiscated a cellular telephone in Jabal Juhar surveillance camera footage from a merchant shop in Beit Kahil, a computer and surveillance camera footage in Beit Awwa, surveillance camera footage from 3 merchant shops and several homes, a computer and files for 3 Charitable Organizations in Beit Ummar and Bani Na'im, Identification Cards for a resident in Beit Ummar, 10 Portable bathrooms and 8 water tanks (approximately 1500 Litres) and 3 Trucks owned by a Christian Charitable fund in east Sa'ir.

11. Settlement Activity:

Israel authorities began levelling land for the construction of additional settlement unites on land surrounding "Avi Gal" settlement outpost in east Yatta in Hebron, The Israeli Ministry of Public works and Housing issued tenders for the construction of 1500 settlement unites in "Ramat Shlomo", "Givat Zaif", "Alviya Mansha", "Ifrat", "Betar Eliyat", "Adam" and "Ariel" settlement located in Jerusalem, Qalqiliya, Salfit, Ramallah and Bethlehem and also approved the construction of several settlement unites in Al-Khdr for the expansion of "Aliaz" settlement in Bethlehem all ion land occupied in 1967. *Israeli authorities approved the construction of 1800 settlement unites { 500 in "Brujin" settlement, 381 in "Jivat Zaif" settlement, 38 im "Mitan" settlement, 25 in "Kokhav Yacoub" settlement, 54 in "Lavi Minsha" settlement, 10 in "Tusfit" settlement and 683 in "Eli Zahav" settlements located in Jerusalem, Qalqiliya and Salfit all on land occupied in 1967 Israeli authorities issued tenders for the construction of 387 settlements unites near "Ramat Shlomo" settlement in North Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. Israeli military bulldozers levelled land near settlement outpost "777" and placed several mobile homes in Beit

Furiq in order to expand the settlement; levelled land near "Jivgat Ormoma" settlement in Nablus Israeli authorities approved tenders for the construction 172 settlement unites in "Har Homa" settlement located in south Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. Israeli authorities approved the construction of 380 settlement unites in "Ramat" and Givat Za'if' settlement located in North Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. Israeli military bulldozers began construction work on a rod in Jabal Nu'emeh area in Jericho. Israeli authorities began mapping Al-Mas'udiya area near Burqa for the purpose of installing electricity poles near "Shave Shamron" settlement.

12. Settler Violence

A total of **87** incidents of Settler violence occurred during the month of June including:

<u>Jerusalem:</u> Israeli settlers opened fire towards residents in Silwan neighbourhood, slashed the tires of 3 vehicles and sprayed racist graffiti in Beit Hanina; an Israeli settler launched a surveillance drone on top of Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road leading to Biddu.

Ramallah: Israeli settlers opened fire towards 9 labourers in Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya village, slashed the tires of several vehicles at the entrance of Silwad, opened fire towards several Bedouin Sheppard's near "Kokhav Hashar" settlement, set fire to 7 dunumes of wheat harvest in Deir Jreir, attacked 2 residents and sprayed pepper spray on to their faces in Sinjil and stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp.

Jenin: An Israeli settler vehicle ran over herd of goats and as a result killed 10 heads of goat near the entrance of Barta'a Al-Sharqiya.

Qalqiliya: Israeli settlers chopped the limbs of several Olive trees in Kafr Qaddum, stormed Talluza village, slashed and spoiled several sacks of wheat and oat harvest, stoned residents and vehicles and as a result damaged 3 vehicles near the entrance of Jinsafut village and an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured child in Sanniriya village.

<u>Nablus:</u> Israeli settlers chopped off the limbs of several Olive trees in an area located between Taflit, Al-Sawiya and Qaryut villages, assaulted a residents near "Yitsahar" settlement, stole 40 heads of Livestock (goats) in east Aqraba, confiscated a plot of land in Qaryut then proceeded to plant it with trees, prevented residents and vehicles from passing through "Yitsahar" settlement junction and assaulted a child leaving him injured with a broken leg as they apprehended him near "Barghat" settlement.

Salfit: Israeli settlers stoned a Telecommunications tower owned by (Jawal), a Palestinian Cellular phone company near Za'tara checkpoint junction.

<u>Jericho:</u> Israeli settlers opened fire towards several Sheppard's as they were herding their goats near "Tumar" settlement in south Fasayil village and slaughtered 2 goats in Al-Oja village.

Bethlehem: Israeli settlers uprooted and damaged several trees plants and damaged an Irrigation network in Husan village, uprooted several Olive trees and grape vines in Nahhalin village, set fire to agricultural land near "Betar Aliyat" settlement, assaulted and injured two residents near "Daniel" settlement and opened fire towards residents at the entrance of Al-Jub'a village.

Hebron: Israeli settlers herded their goats on agricultural lands in Sweisiya village, attempted to kidnap a child in Yatta, assaulted and injured several farmers as they were harvesting wheat crops in Al-Tuwani village in east Yatta, assaulted and injured 2 children in the old city of Hebron, stormed agricultural land in Wadi Abu Rish area in Beit Ummar, chopped down 15 Olive trees, an Israeli settler ran over and injured Ashraf Idris in the old city of Hebron leaving him hospitalised with contusions

13. Closure of Crossing Points

The Israeli military completely closed crossing points into the Gaza Strip, including access points within the Green Line, on 155 occasions during the month of June. The Israeli military closed crossing points within the Green Line on 104 occasions. It opened *Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing* for 25 days for previously-coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals and *Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing* for 21 days for transportation of food supplies, humanitarian aid, and cooking gas. In addition to allowing in animal feed, construction cargo designated for UNRWA and internationally-funded projects was transported through the Crossing. *Sufa Crossing* was closed throughout the month. On the other hand, the Israeli authorities have continued to unilaterally close *Ash Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing*. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Israeli authorities has also continued to completely close *Al Muntar (Karnei) Commercial Crossing*.

The Israeli military closed international crossing points on **51** occasions. *Rafah Crossing* was open for 9 days to allow access to civilians departing the Gaza Strip and to those arriving from Egypt. *Yasser Arafat International Airport* has remained closed since the outbreak of the second *Intifada*.
