MONTHLY SUMMARY OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS 01 September 2014 – 30 September 2014

The following summary tables and overview of events survey hostile Israeli activities during the period 01 September 2014 to 30 September 2014. The report includes a summary table of events, classified by type, throughout the West Bank and Gaza Strip, in addition to a comparative table surveying events over the past three months. The survey is compiled from the Daily Situation Reports of the Palestinian Monitoring Group (PMG) of the Negotiations Affairs Department (NAD) of the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO). The PMG monitors ground conditions in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, including Israeli and Palestinian violations. The PMG Daily Situation Reports are a survey of daily events collated from information provided by civil ministries and security agencies of the Palestinian National Authority. The information reported through the PMG process represents data available at the time of distribution only.

#### SAMPLE OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS DURING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2014

- September 1<sup>st</sup> 2014: The child: Ziyad Al-Rifi (9 years old) {A resident of Gaza} died at Al-Shifa hospital of injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes on the Gaza strip.
- September 2nd 2014: Bassem Al-Ajouz {A resident of Gaza} died at a hospital in Jerusalem of serious injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes on the Gaza strip.
- September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014: Attef Ja'rour(A resident of Gaza) died at a hospital in the Arab Republic of Egypt from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza strip and Nasser Abu Marahil (A resident of Al-Nusserrat camp) died at a hospital in Jerusalem from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza strip.
- September 4<sup>th</sup> 2014: Mariyam Abu Amarah(A resident of Deir Al-Balah) died at a hospital in Jerusalem from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza strip.
- September 6<sup>th</sup> 2014: Mahmoud Al-Zamili (A resident of Deir Al-Balah) died at a hospital in the Arab Republic of Egypt from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza strip
- September 7<sup>th</sup> 2014: The child Mohammad Sinukrut (15 years old) {A resident of Jerusalem} died of a serious head injury sustained during confrontations between Israeli forces and residents in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem as mentioned in the report of September 1st 2014.
- September 8th 2014: Mohammad Al-Rabatti (A resident of Rafah) died at a hospital in Egypt of serious injuries sustained from the Israeli Military assault on the Gaza strip.
- September 9<sup>th</sup> 2014: Raed Abdel-Salam Al-Ja'bari (35 years old) {A resident of Hebron} died at a hospital in Israel after having health complications inside of Israeli prisons.
- September 9th 2014: The child Rahaf Abu Jama' (5 years old) {A resident of Bani Suhaylah} died at a hospital in Egypt of injuries sustained from the Israeli Military Assault on the Gaza strip.
- September 9<sup>th</sup> 2014: Abdel Fatah Abu Salaymeh (72 years old) died at a hospital in Egypt of injuries sustained from the Israeli Military Assault on the Gaza strip.
- September 9<sup>th</sup> 2014: Israeli force killed Issa Khaled Al-Qatari (22 years old) during their raid into Al-Amari camp in Al-Bireh city.
- September 9<sup>th</sup> 2014: Samirah Ahmad (53 years old) {A resident of Tel Al-Sultan neighbourhood in Rafah died at a hospital in Jerusalem of injuries sustained from the Israeli Military Assault on the Gaza strip.
- September 10<sup>th</sup> 2014: Israeli forces positioned near "Paseguot" settlement fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in the funeral of Issa Al-Qatari and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Khalil Muhasib (15 years old) and Mohammad Abu Ali.
- September 11<sup>th</sup> 2014: The child Yusef Shallashfah (11 years old) {A resident of Al-Mawasi area in West Rafah} died at a hospital in Gaza of injuries sustained from the Israeli Military Assault on the Gaza strip.
- September 11<sup>th</sup> 2014: Israeli forces raided Hebron, clashed with several residents as they stormed Al-Rabat Mosque and surrounded several homes during which they fired several missiles and opened fire towards a home (with the intention of killing the alleged suspects behind the kidnap and murder of 3 Israeli settlers over 3 months ago) and as a result killed 2 residents: Marwan Al-Qawasmeh and Amar Abu Eisheh and demolished a home owned by Maharn Al-Qawasmeh and detained 3 residents.
- September 11<sup>th</sup> 2014: an Israeli settler vehicle ran over 2 residents: Fayez Odat and Yasser Odat {residents of Aqbat Al-Jabr camp) near the Dead Sea junction and as a result left one them injured with a broken leg.
- September 14<sup>th</sup> 2014: Anas Al-Hinawi (A resident of Jabaliya camp) died at a hospital in Jordan of injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip.

- September 17<sup>th</sup> 2014: an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured the child: Musa'ab Al-Hilu (14 years old) along the main road in Huwara and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.
- September 19<sup>th</sup> 2014: Israeli forces positioned in Beituniya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 children: Mahmoud Ghoush (16 years old) and Sayf Harish (17 years old).
- September 22<sup>ND</sup> 2014: During confrontations between Residents and Israeli forces in Hebron report 12 resents including 2 children were injured: Hamza Burqan (16 years old), Fakhri Al-Haymouni (17 years old), Wissam Al-Haymouni, Wissam Al-Aduwat, Thaer Al-Haymouni, Nu'man Al-Natour, Wahib Zahidah, Nidal Al-Qimri, Nasser Al-Qawasmi, Issam Al-Qariqi, Munjid Al-Qawasmi and Abdel Karim Abu Sbieh.
- September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2014: Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including a child: Abdel-Al-Ghafour Abu Shamsiya (12 years old), Samer Abdel-Karim Al-Za'tari and Haydar Al-Alami.
- September 30<sup>th</sup> 2014: 2 children: Malik Abu Daya (12 years old) and Ali Abu Daya {residents of Taqou'} were injured after an Israeli Miitary UXO exploded as they were herding their goats in an area located in West Taqou'.

# **ANALYSIS OF EVENTS**

#### Assassination:

On September 11<sup>th</sup> 2014,Israeli forces Assainated 2 residents: Marwan Al-Qawasmeh and Amar Abu Eisheh as they raided Hebron, clashed with several residents as they stormed Al-Rabat Mosque and surrounded several homes during which they fired several missiles and opened fire towards a home (with the intention of killing the alleged suspects behind the kidnap and murder of 3 Israeli settlers over 3 months ago) and as a result and demolished a home owned by Maharn Al-Qawasmeh and detained 3 residents.

#### Killings:

During the month of September 2014, Israeli forces killed 15 residents (3 in the West Bank and 12 in the Gaza Strip) which included the following:

- (i) September 1<sup>st</sup> 2014: The child: Ziyad Al-Rifi (9 years old) {A resident of Gaza} died at Al-Shifa hospital of injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes on the Gaza strip.
- (ii) September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014: Bassem Al-Ajour {A resident of Gaza} died at a hospital in Jerusalem of serious injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes on the Gaza strip.
- (iii) September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014: Ettaf Ja'rour(A resident of Gaza) died at a hospital in the Arab Republic of Egypt from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza strip and Nasser Abu Marahil (A resident of Al-Nusserrat camp) died at a hospital in Jerusalem from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza strip.
- (iv) September 4<sup>th</sup> 2014: Mariyam Abu Amarah(A resident of Deir Al-Balah) died at a hospital in Jerusalem from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza strip.
- (v) September 6<sup>th</sup> 2014: Mahmoud Al-Zamil (A resident of Deir Al-Balah) died at a hospital in the Arab Republic of Egypt from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza strip.
- (vi) September 7<sup>th</sup> 2014: The child Mohammad Sinukrut (15 years old) {a resident of Jerusalem} died of a serious head injury sustained during confrontations between Israeli forces and residents in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem as mentioned in the report of September 1st 2014.
- (vii)September 8<sup>th</sup> 2014: Mohammad Al-Rabatti (A resident of Rafah) died at a hospital in Egypt of serious injuries sustained from the Israeli Military assault on the Gaza strip.

- (xii)**September 9<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Samirah Ahmad (53 years old) {A resident of Tel Al-Sultan neighbourhood in Rafah died at a hospital in Jerusalem of injuries sustained from the Israeli Military Assault on the Gaza strip.
- (xiii) September 11<sup>th</sup> 2014: The child Yusef Shallashfah (11 years old) {A resident of Al-Mawasi area in West Rafah} died at a hospital in Gaza of injuries sustained from the Israeli Military Assault on the Gaza strip.
- (xiv) September 14<sup>th</sup> 2014: Anas Al-Hinawi (A resident of Jabaliya camp) died at a hospital in Jordan of injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip.

# Injuries

89 injuries were reported in the month of September (82 Palestinians in the West Bank and 7 in the Gaza Strip). Injuries included 21 children and 4 residents after being ran over by Israeli settler vehicles.

# Arrests

During the month of September, the Israeli military arrested 407 Palestinians (399 the West Bank and 8 in the Gaza Strip). The majority of arrests took place in the districts of Jerusalem (95); Ramallah (26); Jenin (54); Tubas (14) Tulkarem (13); Qalqiliya (4); Nablus (25); Salfit (15); Jericho (11); Bethlehem (57); Hebron (85), North Gaza (6) and Rafah (2). Among those arrested by the Israeli military were 30 children,8 Security Force officers, 6 Fishermen, an Ex-Detainee, 3 Women and 3 University Students.

Israeli forces temporarily detained 287 residents at checkpoint and in residential area including 45 children, 6 Women, 15 Security Force Officer and 5 Fishermen.

# Closure

Especially on Fridays, the Israeli military continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances of Jerusalem, and to restrict entrance to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem, preventing worshippers from accessing the Mosque. At the *Qalandiya checkpoint north of Jerusalem*, the Israeli military continues to prevent PNA registered civilian vehicles from crossing the checkpoint towards Ar Ram and Qalandiya as well as Dahiyat al Bareed. The checkpoint is overcrowded daily, particularly during rush hours, due to intensified restrictions and search measures applied by Israeli troops. During the month of March the Israeli military also continued to intensify restrictions at the *Tayasir checkpoint* and *Al Hamra junction checkpoint* leading to the Jordan Valley area, only allowing access to civilians whose IDs indicate District of Jericho residence or others holding special access permits. In addition, restrictions were intensified and civilian access was obstructed at the *Za'tara junction checkpoint* (separating the northern and central West Bank districts) as well as at the *As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint* (separating the central and southern West Bank districts).

The Israeli military installed 493 flying checkpoints in September (compared with 485 in August and 446 in July) and as a result restricted the free access and movement of residents, merchant supplies and agricultural goods.

## Distribution of flying checkpoints in the West Bank

The Israeli military set up 493 flying checkpoints in September and searched Palestinian civilians and vehicles in and around Palestinian residential areas in the districts of Jerusalem (77); Ramallah (48); Jenin (13), Tubas (17); Tulkarem (18); Qalqiliya (41); Nablus (62); Salfit (16); Jericho (86); Bethlehem (86) Hebron (49).



## Raids

The Israeli military carried out 464 **raids** in Palestinian residential areas during the month of September {460 in the West Bank and 4 in the Gaza Strip}. The majority of Israeli military raids were reported to have taken place in the districts of Jerusalem (33); Ramallah (65); Jenin (47); Tubas (19); Tulkarem (40); Qalqiliya (27); Nablus (68); Salfit (20); Jericho (12); Bethlehem (56); Hebron (73),Gaza (1) Khan Yunis (2) and Rafah (1). The Israeli military opened fire on 221 occasions during raids and clashes with civilians. (90.6% of attacks)

#### Attacks

244 attacks were reported to have taken place during the month of September (224 in the West Bank and 20 in the Gaza Strip).

The Israeli military carried out 5 attacks during raids into Palestinian residential areas, 216 attacks during confrontations between the Israeli military and Palestinians and 6 attacks from Israeli military posts on civilian homes and property. In addition Israeli navy vessels carried out 15 attacks on Palestinian fishermen and territory.

#### Home Demolition

# During the month of September 2014, the Israeli military demolished Palestinian homes and residential tents, which consisted of the following:

- Israeli forces demolished 4 homes in Al-Thahriya in Hebron.
- Israeli forces demolished 5 Bedouin tents near Jaba' village in Jerusalem district.
- Israeli forces demolished 2 homes (consisting of 2 rooms and a barracks) and livestock barracks in in Wadi Al-Dam area in Beit Hanina town in Jerusalem district.
- Israeli forces demolished a section of a home (consisting of 5 floors) in Abu Dis town in Jerusalem district for allegedly being built without a licence.
- Israeli forces demolished a section of a home in Hebron.

#### During the month of September the Israeli Military served the following Demolition orders:

- Israeli forces served demolition orders for to homes in Wadi Al-Rakhim area located near "Suseya" settlement in south east Yatta.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 3 homes in Khashim Al-Daraj village located in south east Yatta.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 7 homes in Kisan village for allegedly being built without proper licences.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 7 homes in Wadi Al-Nis village in Bethlehem for allegedly being built without proper licences.

## Attacks on Public and Private Property

A total of 83 **incidents of destruction and confiscation** of Palestinian public and private property by Israeli settlers and Israeli forces were reported in September 2014

#### Attack on Public and Private property occurred as follows per District:

**Jerusalem:** Israeli forces demolished four livestock barracks owned by Bedouin families, demolished a vehicle repair shop and a carwash in Al-Jib village, demolished a livestock barracks in Beit Hanina, Israeli forces closed down "Ammar Association" in Jerusalem, Israeli forces levelled 20 Tombstones in an Islamic Cemetery located near Al-Absate Gate (one of the main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem.

**Tubas:** Israeli forces temporarily seized a herd of goats near Al-Farissiya village in the North Jordan valley.

**Tulkarem:** Israeli forces uprooted several Olive trees located near Beit Lid junction.

**Nablus:** Israeli forces demolished a barracks near Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya village, prevented several Sheppard's from herding their sheep, and temporarily seized a herd of goats in "Barja" settlement, Israeli settlers stoned and damaged a bus near "Yitsahar" settlement, and Israeli forces destroyed an electricity network and uprooted and disposed of 28 Electricity poles in Aqraba.

Salfit: Israeli forces prevented worker for the Palestinian Ministry of Public works and Housing from paving a road, temporarily seized Bulldozer owned by the Ministry as they were paving a road in Salfit.

Jericho: Israeli forces temporarily seized a Camel near "Malee Ofrim" settlement.

**Bethlehem:** Israeli forces set fire to agricultural land near the entrance of Taqou' after a tear gas grenade exploded.

**Hebron:** Israeli forces demolished aa dairy products factory, an Israeli settler ran over and killed 8 heads of goats in east Yatta, Israeli settlers chopped down 25 Olive trees in Wadi Al-Rish area in Beit Ummar.

#### The Israeli military served the following Halt to construction and demolition orders for the month of September 2014:

- The Israeli Military served a halt to construction order for a livestock den and a water well network in Al-Hafriya village in Jenin.
- The Israeli Military served a demolition order for a home and halt to construction for the pavement of a road in Yasuf.
- The Israeli Military served demolition orders for 2 homes in Yarza village.
- The Israeli Military served demolition orders for 2 barracks near Al-Hamra checkpoint.
- The Israeli Military served halt to construction orders for 2 barracks near Bardalah.
- The Israeli Military served an eviction order of a plot of agricultural land (Planted with trees) in east Tubas.
- The Israeli Military served a demolition order for a barrack's in Al-Malah area located in the North Jordan valley area in Tubas.
- The Israeli Military served a demolition order for a barrack's in Al-Khadr in Bethlehem.
- The Israeli Military served an order for the removal of a mobile home in the area located between Al-Khan Al-Ahmar and Al-Eizariya.

#### Israeli forces confiscated the following property during the month of August 2014:

- Jerusalem: Israeli forces confiscated several office equipment for "Institute for the development of Al-Aqsa mosque compound" in the old city of Jerusalem.
- <u>Tubas:</u> Israeli forces confiscated several water pipe lines, an agricultural tractor, an electric generator, a residents Identification card in east Tamoun,

confiscated a water tank truck in Khirbiet Abu Samara area in the North Jordan valley.

- <u>Tulkarem</u>: Israeli forces confiscated surveillance several cellular telephones, surveillance camera footage from a merchant shop in Tulkarem.
- Jenin: Israeli forces confiscated a hunting rifle from a home in Al-Arqa village and a resident's personal identification card near "Movo Dotan" checkpoint.
- Jericho: Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint in Jericho confiscated a personal Identification card.
- **Bethlehem:** Israeli forces confiscated a agricultural tractor in Beit Fajjar.
- Hebron: Israeli forces confiscated a computer from a home in Beit Ummar, confiscated several crops from 4 dunumes of agricultural land in east Hebron.
- Gaza: Israeli forces confiscated a fishing boat off the shores of Gaza.
- North Gaza: Israeli forces confiscated 3 fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

# Settlement Activity:

Israeli authorities levelled a plot of land in Jabal Zarour area near Irtas village in Bethlehem.

Israeli authorities published the tenders for the construction of 283 settlement unites in "Al-Kana" settlement located on land occupied in 1967 in Salfit. On September 6<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces served a land confiscation order for the confiscation of 2000 dunumes of agricultural with several homes built on them in Wadi Bani Zied area near Al-Dirat village located in east Yatta for allaged military purposes.

Israeli forces levelled a plot of land in south Kafil Harris in Salfit.

Israeli forces levelled a plot of land in east Burin.

# <u>Settler Violence</u>

28 incidents of Settler violence occurred during the month of September including:

**Jerusalem:** Israeli settlers assaulted and injured an 11 year old child as they attempted to abduct him in the old city of Jerusalem, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over an 11 year old child in Silwan neighbourhood leaving him hospitalised with contusions, Israeli settlers attempted to seize 26 apartments in a 10 floor building (unoccupied) in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.

**Ramallah:** Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles near "Bet El" settlement junction in North Al-Bireh and as a result injured a resident, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles near "Halamish" settlement, Israeli settlers gathered near Wadi Al-Laymoun area located in Aboud village and provoked several worshipers, Israeli settlers positioned near "Shilo settlement levelled a plot of agricultural land near Turmusaya, Israeli settlers stoned several residents in in a stone cutting factory in Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya.

**Jenin:** Israeli settlers positioned near "Movo Dotan" settlement stoned a vehicle causing it to crash then stoned several children, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the main road connecting Jenin-Tulkarem, Israeli settlers stormed the previously abandoned settlement of "Homish" and lite up several fireworks.

**Nablus:** An Israeli settler vehicle ran over a 14 year old child in Huwarah, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Haja area in east Burin village, Israeli settlers stoned several Sheppard's as they were herding their sheep in the area, Israeli settlers stoned a resident's vehicle and damaged the vehicle.

Salfit: Israeli settlers stormed Qarwat Bani Hassan then withdrew after being chased away by local residents.

**Jericho:** An Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured 2 residents at a gas station near the Dead Sea junction, Israeil settlers stormed and planted agricultural land near Ein Dweik village during which they damaged a water pipe line.

Hebron: A group of Israeli settlers stormed Wadi Abu Rish area in Beit Ummar and chopped down 15 Olive trees, grape vines and peach trees, an Israeli

settler vehicle ran over a 6 year old child: Mohammad Al-Ja'bari leaving him hospitalised with contusions, Israeli settlers sprayed pepper spray onto the faces of several residents in the old city of Hebron, an Israeli settler vehicle travelling near Aquis area in east Yatta ran over aa herd of sheep and as a result killed 8 heads of livestock and Israeli settlers levelled land in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron



#### <u>Closure of Crossing Points</u>

The Israeli military completely closed crossing points into the Gaza Strip, including access points within the Green Line, on **133** occasions during the month of September. The Israeli military closed crossing points within the Green Line on **103** occasions. It opened *Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing* for 26 days for previously-coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals and *Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing* for **21** days for transportation of food supplies, humanitarian aid, and cooking gas. In addition to allowing in animal feed, construction cargo designated for UNRWA and internationally-funded projects was transported through the Crossing. *Sufa Crossing* was closed throughout the month. On the other hand, the Israeli authorities have continued to unilaterally close *Ash Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing*. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Israeli authorities has also continued to completely close *Al Muntar (Karnei) Commercial Crossing*.

The Israeli military closed international crossing points on **30** occasions. *Rafah Crossing* was open for 30 days to allow access to civilians departing the Gaza Strip and to those arriving from Egypt. *Yasser Arafat International Airport* has remained closed since the outbreak of the second *Intifada*.
