MONTHLY SUMMARY OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS 01 September 2015 – 30 September 2015

The following summary tables and overview of events survey hostile Israeli activities during the period 01 September 2015 to 30 September 2015. The report includes a summary table of events, classified by type, throughout the West Bank and Gaza Strip, in addition to a comparative table surveying events over the past three months. The survey is compiled from the Daily Situation Reports of the Palestinian Monitoring Group (PMG) of the Negotiations Affairs Department (NAD) of the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO). The PMG monitors ground conditions in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, including Israeli and Palestinian violations. The information reported through the PMG process represents data available at the time of distribution only.

SAMPLE OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS DURING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2015

- September 2nd 2015: Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem clashed with several residents and as a result injured a child as they detained him.
- September 3rd 2015: Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents for allegedly attempting to climb the border fence in west Beit Lahiya and as a result injured Bilal Abu Ammro (12 years old).
- September 7th 2015: Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Qa'daeh area located near Beit Furiq fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Amir Malitat (13 years old) after assaulting him leaving him hospitalised with cuts and bruises to the face as well as a fractured arm.
- September 7th 2015: Reham Dawabsheh died from injuries sustained after his home was torched by Israeli settlers, which killed her 18month-old son and her husband who died of injuries and her 4-year-old child (Ahmmad) who was critically injured in Duma village in Nablus.
- September 8th 2015: Israeli forces raided Subustiya village as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed archaeological sites in the area during which Israeli bulldozers levelled surrounding area near the sites in preparation for planned celebrations by the settlers in the Jewish holidays during which local residents clashed with Israeli forces in an attempt to prevent the land levelling and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Ayoub Kayed and Haytham Al-Sha'ir.
- September 11th 2015: Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 children: Abdel-Raziq Hamed (15 years old) and Abdallah Hamed (17 years old) and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions.
- September 13th 2015: Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents inside Al-Aqsa mosque in an attempt to evacuate them from the mosque and as a result injured the child Anas Siyam and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation during which Israeli forces detained a Security guard at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and assaulted Omar Kiswani (Head of Al-Aqsa mosque) and another Security guard and then allowed The Israeli Minister of Agriculture : Ori Arail accompanied by several Israeli settlers to enter Al-Aqsa mosque compound. 25 residents were injured during the confrontations.
- September 15th 2015: Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram's north junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (as they protested the continued attack from Israeli settlers, Israeli military and Police officers towards worshipers inside Al-Aqsa mosque) confrontations continued later time, resulting in the injury of 3 residents including 2 children: Basel Al-Salaymeh (17 years old), Mahmoud Sharabati (15 years old) and Qusay Al-Matour leaving them hospitalised.
- September 15th 2015: Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eisawiyya village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured, and detained a resident, and also the child Sali Muhiesin (13 years old) as she was near the village entrance.
- September 16th 2015: Yusef Araf Njoum, was injured after he was ran over by an Israeli military Truck as he was travelling along road (90) in Al-Oja village and left him hospitalised.
- September 17th 2015: Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Anas Saleh (17 years old) {A resident of Al-Duhisheh camp.

- September 18th 2015: Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 children: Moath Zahran (17 years old), Adam Baker (15 years old), Mohammad Abu Al-Roub (15 years old) and Obay Hammad (15 years old).
- September 18th 2015: Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur, Silwan, Shu'fat checkpoint, Abu Dis, Al-Ezariya and Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the photojournalist Mohammad Ashour.
- September 18th 2015: Israeli forces positioned near the entrance "Ofar" Military base/ Prison fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including a child: Anas Abu Hussien (15 years old), Mohammad Khamel and Mohammad Abed.
- September 18th 2015: Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mohammad Safi (16 years old).
- September 18th 2015: A demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the eastern entrance of the village,during which they clashed with Israeli forces who raided the village, occupied the rooftops of two homes and converted them into military posts and tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured 3 residents including a child: Mohammad Ali (12 years old), Bashar Ishtewi and Nasser Barham also left several residents suffocating form tear gas inhalation as well as assaulting and spraying pepper spray onto the faces of 3 women: Suriya Ishtewi, Salma Ishtewi and Qamar Ishtewi.
- September 19th 2015: Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents as they stormed homes and as a result injured the child Mohammad Darwish (11 years old) leaving him hospitalised and detained 2 residents.
- September 19th 2015: a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum village protesting against the continued closure of the east entrance of the village during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenade towards several demonstrators in order to prevent them from reaching the demonstration site and as a result injured Abdallah Abbas (14 years old).
- September 20th 2015: an Israeli settler driving his vehicle near Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron ran over the child: Mahdi Idris (7 years old) leaving him hospitalised with a broken neck.
- September 21st 2015: an Israeli settler vehicle ran over 40 Goats owned by Aysh Da'ajneh (A resident of Fasayil village) near "Malee Ofrim" settlement.
- September 21st 2015: Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Nour Al-Khatib.
- September 21st 2015: Israeli forces positioned in Al-Zawiya and Tal'at Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron, near Halhoul area junction, Halhoul bridge and at the entrance of Bani Na'im fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were protesting against the continued Israeli attack on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and as a result injured the child Hamza Abu Ayash (17 years old) near Bab Al-Zawiya area and detained a resident near Al-Huwar area junction.
- September 22nd 2015: Hadeel Al-Hashlamoun (A resident of Hebron) Died of Injuries sustained after Israeli forces opened fire towards her near a checkpoint located in the old city of Hebron.
- September 24th 2015: Ahmad Khattatbeh (A resident of Beit Furiq) died of critical injuries sustained after Israeli forces opened fire towards him near the entrance of Beit Furiq in Nablus district.

- September 25th 2015: A demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who raided the village, occupied the rooftops of several homes and converted them into military posts and tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured Musa Al-Qaddumi (A Police officer) and his child Maram Al-Qaddumi after storming their home leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- September 25th 2015: Israeli forces raided Taqou', set up a checkpoint at the west entrance, clashed with several residents and as a result injured three residents including a child: Qussay Al-Ammour (16 years old), Ali Sabah and Farouq Al-Amour.
- September 26th 2015: Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Mohammad Hanani (13 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- September 29th 2015: , Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahkama checkpoint located near Bet El settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards residents(who protesting the continued Israeli settler and Israeli Military attacks on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents including a child: Zayed Abu Hamad (16 years old), Ahmad Hjair, Saher Jum'a Snief, Ahmad Al-Taweel, Hazem Nassar and Mohammad Azmi (who was also detained).



ANALYSIS OF EVENTS

Killings:

During the month of September 2015, Israeli forces killed three residents in the West Bank included the following:

- (iv) September 7th 2015: Reham Dawabsheh died from injuries sustained after his home was torched by Israeli settlers which killed her 18 month old son and her husband who died of injuries and her 4 years old (Ahmmad) who was critically injured in Duma village in Nablus.
- (v) September 22nd 2015: Hadeel Al-Hashlamoun (A resident of Hebron) Died of Injuries sustained after Israeli forces opened fire towards her near a checkpoint located in the old city of Hebron.

September 24th 2015: Ahmad Khttatbeh (A resident of Beit Furiq) died of critical injuries sustained after Israeli forces opened fire towards him near the entrance of Beit Furiq in Nablus district.


Injuries

156 injuries were reported in the month of September 2015 (152 Palestinians in the West Bank and six in the Gaza Strip). Included 29 children, 2 Women, 2 journalists and a Security Force Officer.

Arrests

During the month of September, the Israeli military arrested 444 Palestinians (395 the West Bank and 49 in the Gaza Strip). The majority of arrests took place in the districts of Jerusalem (163); Ramallah (47); Jenin (17); Tubas (1) Tulkarem (8); Qalqiliya (3); Nablus (21); Salfit (15); Jericho (19); Bethlehem (27); Hebron (74), North Gaza (12) ,Gaza (3), Central Gaza (16) and Khan Yunis (18). Among those arrested by the Israeli military were 59 children, 4 Women, 10 Security Force officers, 2 University students, 2 Journalists and a Paramedic.

The Israeli Military temporarily detained 271 Palestinians, which included 17 children, 4 women, 3 Journalist, A Telivison crew and 13 Security Force officers.




Closure

Especially on Fridays, the Israeli military continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances of Jerusalem, and to restrict entrance to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem, preventing worshippers from accessing the Mosque. At the *Qalandiya checkpoint north of Jerusalem*, the Israeli military continues to prevent PNA registered civilian vehicles from crossing the checkpoint towards Ar Ram and Qalandiya as well as Dahiyat al Bareed. The checkpoint is overcrowded daily, particularly during rush hours, due to intensified restrictions and search measures applied by Israeli troops. During the month of August the Israeli military also continued to intensify restrictions at the *Tayasir checkpoint* and *Al Hamra junction checkpoint* leading to the Jordan Valley area, only allowing access to civilians whose IDs indicate District of Jericho residence or others holding special access permits. In addition, restrictions were intensified and civilian access was obstructed at the *Za'tara junction checkpoint* (separating the northern and central West Bank districts) as well as at the *As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint* (separating the central and southern West Bank districts).

Distribution of flying checkpoints in the West Bank

The Israeli military set up 474 flying checkpoints in September and searched Palestinian civilians and vehicles in and around Palestinian residential areas in the districts of Jerusalem (109); Ramallah (62); Jenin (6); Tulkarem (12); Qalqiliya (28); Nablus (80); Salfit (8); Jericho (32); Bethlehem (63) and Hebron (74).



Raids


The Israeli military carried out 393 raids in Palestinian residential areas during the month of September {386 in the West Bank and seven in the Gaza Strip}. The majority of Israeli military raids were reported to have taken place in the districts of Jerusalem (109); Ramallah (62); Jenin (6); Tulkarem (12); Qalqiliya (28); Nablus (80); Salfit (8); Jericho (32); Bethlehem (63) and Hebron (74).

The Israeli military opened fire on 285 occasions during raids and clashes with civilians. (85.8% of attacks)

• <u>Attacks</u>

340 attacks were reported to have taken place during the month of September (292 in the West Bank and 48 in the Gaza Strip).

The Israeli military carried out 282 attacks during confrontations between the Israeli military and Palestinians 22 attacks from Israeli military posts on civilian homes and property. In addition Israeli navy vessels carried out 22 attacks on Palestinian fishermen and territory, 2 from Military Checkpoint, 1 from Settler attack, 8 from Air Strike and 3 attack during raids.



Home Demolition

During the month of September 2015, the Israeli military demolished Palestinian homes and residential tents, which consisted of the following:

- The Israeli military demolished 10 homes owned by the AlArarat (A Bedouin) Family and 6 Livestock dens in Jaba' village in Jerusalem.
- The Israeli military demolished home (under construction) in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- The Israeli military demolished a residential tent in Humsa Al-Foqa village in the North Jordan valley area in Tubas.
- The Israeli military demolished homes owned by Bedouin families located near Al-Taybeh junction (along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho) in Ramallah District
- During the month of September 2015 the Israeli Military served the following Demolition orders:
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for three homes in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for the partial demolition of a home (25m²) in Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for a home (under construction) in Al-Jiftlik village in Jericho.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 12 homes in Khirbeit Al-Deir village located near Taqou' in Bethlehem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for two homes in Kisan village in Bethlehem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for a home in Al-Jawiya village located in South Yatta in Hebron.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for four homes in Khilat Al-Miya and Al-Rafa'iya villages in east Yatta of Hebron District.

- Israeli forces served demolition orders for several homes including two tents in AL-Musafir area located in east Yatta of Hebron District.
- During the month of September 2015 Israeli forces occupied 14 homes and converted their rooftops into Military post: Jerusalem District: Al-Eisawiya village. Jenin District: Jenin Camp. Nablus District: Beit Furiq. Qailqiliya District: Kafr Qaddum village. Bethlehem District: Taqou' and Deir Al-Zier village. Hebron District: Tarma village and the old city of Hebron.

<u>Attacks on Public and Private Property</u>

A total of 70 **incidents of destruction and confiscation** of Palestinian public and private property by Israeli settlers and Israeli forces were reported in September 2015 (69 in the West Bank and 1 in The Gaza Strip).

Attack on Public and Private property occurred as follows per District:

Jerusalem: Israeli forces set fire to the inside of Al-Aqsa mosque after firing stun and tear gas grenades towards worshipers and sawed off the steel window bars of the mosque as they detained several worshipers from inside the mosque in the old city of Jerusalem, demolished a barracks in Al-Eisawiya village, damaged several windows, destroyed a main entrance and burned the rugs inside Al-Qibli mosque after Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards worshipers inside the mosque, Damaged the main gate entrance and burned the rugs inside the mosque after firing stun and tear gas grenades as they stormed Al-Aqsa mosque, set fire to a home after firing stun and tear gas grenades towards it during their raid into Al-Eisaya village, damaged the vehicle of a handicapped driver in Al-Tur neighbourhood, demolished 6 livestock dens near Jaba' village.

Ramallah: Israeli forces demolished three livestock dens near Al-Taybeh junction along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho.

Tubas: Israeli forces forcibly removed several families from their homes on September 9th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Khirbeit Ras Al-Hamra area located in the North Jordan valley and removed residents from their homes until 24:00 in order to conduct Military exercises in the North Jordan valley and forced 14 families from their homes from 06:00 until 12:00 in order to conduct Military exercises in the North Jordan valley.

Jenin: Israeli forces damaged furniture after storming and searching a home in Jenin camp, and damaged furniture as they stormed and searched five homes in Fahma village.

Tulkarem: Israeli forces destroyed several fruit and vegetable carts located near Al-Tebah checkpoint.

<u>Qalqiliya:</u> Israeli forces damaged a vehicle after firing a tear gas grenades towards demonstrators in Kafr Qaddum protesting against the continued closer of the village entrance.

Nablus: Israeli settlers damaged a vehicle after stoning several vehicles passing along the main road near "Shave Shomron" settlement junction, destroyed several Olive trees after setting fire to agricultural land in Burin village, Israeli forces prevented several construction workers with a bulldozers from rehabilitation work on a plot of agricultural land located south of Qusra, Israeli forces destroyed a main entrance after storming and searching a restaurant and damaged a vehicle during their raid into Nablus, Israeli forces closed down several merchant shops located along the main road in Huwara.

Jericho: An Israeli settler killed 40 heads of cattle after running them over with his vehicle near "Ma'alee Ifrim" settlement and damaged the main gate entrance to a park after they stormed Ein Sdweik Al-Foqa village.

Bethlehem: A group of Israeli settlers damaged a water well network used to irrigate crops on agricultural land in Al-Thaghra area located in Al-Khadr located near "EliIzar" settlement, a group of Israeli settlers set fire to Olive trees near the west entrance of Taqou' and demolished a "Green house" in Sakariya village.

Hebron: Israeli settler's levelled agricultural land and destroyed irrigation network in Al-Buq'a area in east Hebron and an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and killed five heads of livestock (goats) in east Yatta.

Israeli forces served military orders for the following:

Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of agricultural Green houses in Hizma village in Jerusalem district.

Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of a vehicle repair shop in Kisan village in Bethlehem.

Israeli forces served military orders for the halt of construction on a barracks (agricultural storage room) in Faroush Beit Dajjan village in Nablus.

Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of two water wells in Al-Musafer area located in east Yatta in Hebron District.

Israeli forces served military orders for the halt of construction on 2 homes in Khirbeit Al-Deir village located near Taqou' in Bethlehem District.

Israeli forces served military orders for the eviction of several families from their homes from September 6th 2015 until September 11th 2015 in Bardala village located in the north Jorden valley in Tubas district for alleged military training in the area.

Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of a "slaughter house" owned by Beit Sahur Municipality in Bethlehem district.

Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of steel mill in Al-Jiftlik village in Jericho district. Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of a school in Sha'b Al-Batim area located in south east Yatta in Hebron district. Israeli forces served military orders for the eviction from a plot of agricultural land in Qarwar Bani Hassan in Salfit.

Confiscation and seizure of Palestinian owned property during September 2015:

- Jerusalem: Israeli forces confiscated a computer and a Cellular phone from a resident after detaining him in Beit Hanina.
- **<u>Tubas:</u>** Israeli forces confiscated an agricultural tractor in Um Al-Jamal village in the North Jordan valley.
- **Tulkarem:** Israeli forces confiscated surveillance camera footage from three merchant shops and a Gas Station in Anabta.
- **Qalqiliya:** Israeli forces confiscated surveillance camera footage from several merchant shops in Al-Nabi Eliyas village.
- **Nablus:** Israeli forces confiscated a resident's Identification Card at a flying checkpoint located in the area between Aqraba and Khirbeit Yanoun village, confiscated a computer and 2500 NIS from a University student after detaining him in Nablus city and confiscated a vehicle in Beit Furiq.
- <u>Salfit:</u> Israeli forces confiscated a vehicle at Za'tara checkpoint junction.
- Jericho: Israeli forces confiscated a water tank truck near Al-Jiftlik village.
- **Bethlehem:** Israeli forces confiscated a vehicle near the entrance of Beit Jallah and surveillance camera footage for a gas station in Al-Ayda camp'.
- <u>Hebron:</u> Israeli forces confiscated surveillance camera footage for a gas station in Huwawer area in Halhoul and plant irrigation network in Al-Buq'a in east Hebron.
- North Gaza: Israeli forces confiscated a fishing boat off the shores of North Gaza.

• <u>Settlement Activity:</u>

At dawn on September 1st 2015, a group of Israeli settlers from "Aterot Kohana" Organization under the protection of Israeli forces forcibly took over a home owned by Jihad Sarhan (Deceased) in Batn Al-Hawa area in Silwan neighbourhood after Israeli forces broke into the main entrance during which local residents clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to prevent the settlers from taking over the home during which Israeli forces detained 3 residents including a woman.

Israeli forces levelled a plot of agricultural land located in Al-Buq'a area located in east Hebron.

Israeli forces levelled a plot of land in Subustiya village in Nablus and levelled a plot of land (approximately 10 dunums/ acres) in Jabal Abu Zied located in south Irtas village in Bethlehem claiming it is government owned land.

<u>Settler Violence</u>

54 incidents of Settler violence occurred during the month of September 2015 including:

Jerusalem: Israeli settlers stoned vehicles near "Gevat Za'iv" settlement, assaulted 2 residents in Silwan neighbourhood, stormed Al-Rahma Islamic Cemetery in Jerusalem and provoked worshipers, assaulted a child in Silwan neighbourhood, spray painted anti-arab slogans near Bab Al-Rahma gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem.

Ramallah: Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Abu Qash village, an Israeli settler installed a barbed wire fence around a plot of land (approximately 30 Dunumes) in Turmus'aya in an attempt to confiscate it, Israeli settlers stormed Ain Al-Ma area located between Al-Nabi Saleh and Deir Nathim villages and stormed the entrance of Al-Janiya village.

Jenin: Israeli settlers stormed Ti'inik and Rumana villages.

Nablus: Israeli settlers aimed their guns towards residents and stoned vehicles along Beit Furiq junction, stormed Nablus city and attempted to enter Joseph's tomb, stormed agricultural land in Khilat Al-Ruman area located in south Qusra village, aimed their weapons towards the faces of a resident and his child near the entrance of Beit Furiq, Israeli settlers riding motorcycles stormed agricultural land in Al-Jabaliya area located in Aqraba, assaulted a resident near "Shave Shomron" settlement, assaulted a child near the main road in Huwara, temporarily seized a vehicle near Khirbeit Yanoun village, stormed Madma village, set fire to vehicle tires along a road between Burin village and "Yitsahar" settlement, stoned residents and vehicles at the entrance of Beit Furiq, levelled a plot of land in Qaryout village.

Jericho: Israeli settlers stormed Ain Dweik Al-Foqa village.

Bethlehem: Israeli settlers demolished a water well for crop irrigation in Al-Thaghra area in Al-Khader and set fire agricultural land near the entrance of Taqou'.

Hebron: Israeli settlers chased and harassed 3 school girls and as a result injuring 1 school girl with a fractured leg after she stumbled while escaping the Israeli settlers in the old city of Hebron, prevented residents from drawing water from a water well in Ain Al-Far'a located in Dura, stoned residents and vehicles travelling along road (25) which leads to Tarqumiya crossing, opened fire towards a residents home in Abu Snieneh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron, a Israeli settler vehicle ran over ran over a herd of goats near "Malee Ivrim" settlement in Jericho, Israeli settlers assaulted and injured a child in the old city of Hebron, a Israeli settler vehicle ran over a child in the old city of Hebron, assaulted and sprayed pepper spray onto the faces of 2 residents including a child along Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron, stormed agricultural land in Al-Baqar and Safa area's located in Halhoul, a Israeli settler vehicle ran overa herd of goats in east Yatta and temporally abducted several members of a private Security company "Himaya" (Protection) near the entrance of "Hadgi settlement.

• Closure of Crossing Points

The Israeli military completely closed crossing points into the Gaza Strip, including access points within the Green Line, on **166** occasions during the month of September. The Israeli military closed crossing points within the Green Line on **111** occasions. It opened *Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing* for 22 days for previously-coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals and *Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing* for **17** days for transportation of food supplies, humanitarian aid, and cooking gas. In addition to allowing in animal feed, construction cargo designated for UNRWA and internationally funded projects was transported through the Crossing. *Al Jamla* crossing was closed 4 times during the month of September. *Sufa Crossing* was closed throughout the month. On the other hand, the Israeli authorities have continued to unilaterally close *Ash Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing*. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Israeli authorities has also continued to completely close *Al Muntar (Karnei) Commercial Crossing*.

The Israeli military closed international crossing points on **55** occasions. *Rafah Crossing* was opened 5 times during the month of September. *Yasser Arafat International Airport* has remained closed since the outbreak of the second *Intifada*.
