MONTHLY SUMMARY OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS **01 November 2013 – 30 November 2013**

The following summary tables and overview of events survey hostile Israeli activities during the period 01 November 2013 to 30 November 2013. The report includes a summary table of events, classified by type, throughout the West Bank and Gaza Strip, in addition to a comparative table surveying events over the past three months. The survey is compiled from the Daily Situation Reports of the Palestinian Monitoring Group (PMG) of the Negotiations Affairs Department (NAD) of the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO). The PMG monitors ground conditions in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, including Israeli and Palestinian violations. The PMG Daily Situation Reports are a survey of daily events collated from information provided by civil ministries and security agencies of the Palestinian National Authority. The information reported through the PMG process represents data available at the time of distribution only.

SAMPLE OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2013

- **04 November:**, Rami Al-Zabani,(27 years old) a resident of Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem died of injuries sustained after being struck by a rubber coated steel bullet in the chest in 2009 and left him in Israeli hospitals with severe heart condition.
- **05 November:** Israeli forces positioned in near the wall gate in Qutna village fired rubber coated steel bullets towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured YusefTaha (13 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- **05 November :**Palestinian detainee Hasan Turabi, a resident Nablus- Sara village died from complication from leukemia due to medical negligence form Israeli prison authorities.
- **07November:** Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint opened fire towards and killed Bashir Janayin, a resident of Jenin.
- **07November:**Israeli forces positioned at container checkpoint opened fire towards Anas Al-Atrash and killed him for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- **08 November:**Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Kabsa area located between Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Usayed Afana (16 years old) after being struck with a tear gas grenade canister in his head leaving him hospitalised and detained 2 residents.
- **08November:**Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in the funeral of Anas Al-Atrash who was killed near Al-Container checkpoint and as a result injured 4 residents including a child and an elderly resident: Rawan Abu Ziena (9 years old), Najah Abu Ziena (60 years old), SufiyanHadib and Mohammad Abu Daoud leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- **09November:** Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Joulani (15 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- **10 November:** Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Lawza area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed a home and as a result injured 2 children: Diyana Taya (15 years old) and Baha Taya (16 years old) with moderate contusion sand detained a resident..
- **11 November:**Israeli forces positioned at Attara bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 students: Mohammad Dweik (16 years old) and Mohammad Al-Barghouthi.
- **13November:** Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda cam in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Hani Bashrat (14 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions..
- **14 November:** Israeli forces positioned near "Ofar" prison fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mohammad Abu Al-Rub(16 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- **14 November:**Israeli settlers stormed Burin village under the protection of Israeli forces that fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and as a result injured 4 residents including a child and a woman: MuthniAsous, Ma'moun Eid, MunaKan'an and AlaaKan'an (17 years old).
- **19 November: Mohammad Al-Sawarka,** a resident of Bethlehem died of injuries sustained during an Israeli military attack in 2006 which left

him paralyzed and in critical condition.

- **23 November:** Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack near Al-Jalazoun camp and as a result injured 6 residents including 2 children: Yusef Al-Khali (12 years old), Jamal Najla (14 years old), Fadi Qaddum, Khadr Masaleh, Alaa Al-Amouri and Islam Hussein. Israeli forces also detained 2 residents and assaulted the child WajihShiekha (14 years old) as they temporarily detained him.
- **26 November:**Israeli forces killed 3 residents after opening fire towards their vehicle: Mohammad Nuriej, Musa Abdel-Fansha and Mohammad Al-Najjar in Hebron.
- **28 November:**The child Nour Afana (14 years old), a resident of Abu Dis in Jerusalem died waiting at a checkpoint after Israeli forces intensified restrictions and would not allow the ambulance transporting her to a hospital in Bethlehem to pass through the checkpoint.
- **28 November:** Mahmoud Awad, a resident of Qalandiya camp died of a serious head injury sustained after a tear gas grenade struck him during confrontations with Israeli forces near Qalandiya camp on March 2nd 2013.
- **28 November:** Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Zakariya Hamad (17 years old) and Omar Shihadeh.
- **28 November:** Israeli forces raided Al-Samou'as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed the area, clashed with several residents and as a result injured 3 children: HakamHamoudeh (13 years old), Ahmad Khalayleh (17 years old), Mushieb Abu Karsh (15 years old) leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- **29 November:** Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents including 3 children : Anas Al-Mimi (16 years old), Layth Sha'ban (17 years old), Mohammad Hashim (17 years old), Ibrahim Hamdi Ibrahim and Ibrahim Yaqoub.
- **30 November:** The child ImadAyad (9 years old) was injured after an Israeli military UXO exploded near him in Silwad.
- **30 November:** AntarAlAqra' was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him as he was attempting to cross the wall gate to work inside Israel.





ANALYSIS OF EVENTS

1. Killing: A total of 11 killings were reported in the month of November:

- On November 4th 2013, Rami Al-Zabani, (27 years old) a resident of Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem died of injuries sustained after being struck by a rubber coated steel bullet in the chest in 2009 and left him in Israeli hospitals with severe heart condition.
- On November 5th 2013, Palestinian detainee Hasan Turabi, a resident Nablus- Sara village died from complication from leukaemia due to medical negligence from Israeli prison authorities.
- On November 7th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint opened fire towards and killed Bashir Janayin, a resident of Jenin.
- On November 7th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at container checkpoint opened fire towards Anas Al-Atrash and killed him for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- On November 19th 2013, Mohammad Al-Sawarka, a resident of Bethlehem died of injuries sustained during an Israeli military attack in 2006 which left him paralyzed and in critical condition.
- On November 26th 2013, Israeli forces killed 3 residents after opening fire towards their vehicle: Mohammad Nuriej, Musa Abdel-Fansha and Mohammad Al-Najjar (Residents of Yatta) in Zif village located in Hebron.
- On November 28th 2013, Nour Afana (14 years old), a resident of Abu Dis in Jerusalem died waiting at a checkpoint after Israeli forces intensified restrictions and would not allow the ambulance transporting her to a hospital in Bethlehem to pass through the checkpoint.
- On November 28th 2013, Mahmoud Awad, a resident of Qalandiya camp died of a serious head injury sustained after a tear gas grenade struck him during confrontations with Israeli forces near Qalandiya camp on March 1st 2013.
- On November 30th 2013, Antar Al-Aqra' was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him as he was attempting to cross the wall gate to work inside Israel.

2. Injuries

A total of 148 injuries were reported in the month of November (142 Palestinians in the West Bank and 6 in the Gaza Strip). Injuries included 33 children, 25 students, a woman and an elderly resident.


3. Arrests

During the month of November, the Israeli military arrested 428 Palestinians (422 the West Bank and 6 in the Gaza Strip). The majority of arrests took place in the districts of Jerusalem (86); Ramallah (41); Jenin (42); Tubas (11) Tulkarem (16); Qalqiliya (35); Nablus (50); Salfit (8); Jericho (8); Bethlehem (35); Hebron (97) , North Gaza (3) and Central Gaza (3). Among those arrested by the Israeli military were: 63 children; 8 University students, 4 fishermen, 3 women, a journalist and 8 Security officers.

Israeli forces temporarily detained 307 residents at checkpoint and in residential area including 47 children, 7 women, 2 fishermen, a school teacher, 3 journalists, a Palestine Broadcast Channel crew and 18 Palestinian Security Forces officer.

4. Closure

Especially on Fridays, the Israeli military continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances of Jerusalem, and to restrict entrance to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem, preventing worshippers from accessing the Mosque. At the *Qalandiya checkpoint north of Jerusalem*, the Israeli military continues to prevent PNA registered civilian vehicles from crossing the checkpoint towards Ar Ram and Qalandiya as well as Dahiyat al Bared. The checkpoint is overcrowded daily, particularly during rush hours, due to intensified restrictions and search measures applied by Israeli troops. During the month of November, the Israeli military also continued to intensify restrictions at the *Tayasir checkpoint* and *Al Hamra junction checkpoint* leading to the Jordan Valley area, only allowing access to civilians whose IDs indicate District of Jericho residence or others holding special access permits. In addition, restrictions were intensified and civilian access was obstructed at the *Za'tara junction checkpoint* (separating the northern and central West Bank districts) as well as at the *As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint* (separating the central and southern West Bank districts).

The Israeli military set up 465 flying checkpoints in November and searched Palestinian civilians and vehicles in and around Palestinian residential areas in the districts of Jerusalem (68); Ramallah (36); Jenin (18); Tubas (1); Tulkarem (11); Qalqilya (44); Nablus (71); Salfit (23); Jericho (44); Bethlehem (35)


and Hebron (114).

5. Attacks

A total of **285** attacks were reported to have taken place during the month of November (**238** in the West Bank and 47 in the Gaza Strip).

The Israeli military carried out 13 attacks during raids into Palestinian residential areas, 225 attacks during confrontations between the Israeli military and Palestinians, 17 attacks from Israeli military posts on civilian homes and property and 3 from Military checkpoints towards Palestinian residents and vehicle. In addition, Israeli navy vessels carried out 18 attacks on Palestinian fishermen and territory and Israeli aircrafts carried out 9 attacks on civilian targets.

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli military declared a unilateral ceasefire following the large-scale offensive it had launched against the Gaza Strip. However, the Israeli military violated the ceasefire on **47 occasions** during the month of November (compared to **40** last October). Also disregarding Israel's unilaterally declared ceasefire armed Palestinian groups fired **7** mortar rounds.



Attacks on residential areas in West Bank districts


6. Raids

The Israeli military carried out a total of **473 raids** in Palestinian residential areas during the month of November, including **464 in the West Bank** and

9 in the Gaza Strip. The majority of Israeli military raids were reported to have taken place in the districts of Jerusalem (29); Ramallah (59); Jenin (58); Tubas (19); Tulkarem (48); Qalqiliya (34); Nablus (52); Salfit (23); Jericho (12); Bethlehem (39); Hebron (91); North Gaza (3); Gaza (1), Central Gaza (1) and Khan Yunis (4).

The Israeli military opened fire on 238 occasions during raids and clashes with civilians. (A total of 835% of attacks)

The chart below shows the correlation between the number of raids and the resulting human casualties in November.



7. Home Demolition

During the month of November the Israeli military demolished Palestinian homes and residential tents which consisted of the following:

- Israeli forces forced a resident to dismantle his residential Caravan used to shelter his family (After Israeli forces demolished his home consisting of 2 floors 9 months ago) in Beit Hanina town in Jerusalem.

- Israeli forces forced a resident to demolish a portion of his home (consisting of 2 rooms approximately 24 m²) in Aqbat Al-Sireh neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem, enforced a financial penalty for allegedly being built without proper construction licence.
- Israeli forces demolished a home owned by the Latin Patriarch which houses 14 members of a family in south Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces demolished a home in Khlit Ibrahim area located in Ithna in Hebron.
- Israeli forces demolished a home located in Al-Karmil area in Hebron.
- Israeli forces demolished a home (Under construction) in Deir Ballut in Salfit.
- Israeli forces demolished a residential tent in Al-Jiftlik village in Jericho.

The Israeli Military served the following demolition orders during the Month of November 2013:

- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish 8 homes in Barta'a Al-Shariqiya village located in Jenin.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a home consisting of 3 floors in Al-Issawiya village in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish 6 homes (Under construction) near Barta'a village located near the wall gate in Jenin.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a section of a home (consisting of a kitchen and bathroom) in Al-Qarami neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish several residential tents in Ibziq village in Tubas.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a room (Constructed from concrete) in Beit Hanina in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a home in Harasa area located in East Beit Sahur in Bethlehem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a home in Anata in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a residential tent located in Al-Farisiya village in the north Jordan Valley in Tubas.
- Israeli forces served eviction orders to for the eviction of 3 homes for demolition preparation in Zeita located in Tulkarem.

8. Attacks on Public and Private Property

A total of 80 **incidents of destruction and confiscation** of Palestinian public and private property by Israeli settlers and Israeli forces were reported in November including 100 in the West Bank and 0 in the Gaza Strip.

Attack on Public and Private property occurred as follows per District:

Jerusalem: Israeli forces closed the offices of "The Jerusalem Center for Development" in Dahiyat Al-Barid area in the old city of Jerusalem based on an Israeli Police order, Israeli forces prevented an event commemorating the 9th anniversary of President Yasser Arafat's death in Silwan neighbourhood Jerusalem and Israeli forces smashed the windows of the College of Science building and widows of a mosque in Al-Quds University located in Abu Dis. **Ramallah:** Israeli forces damaged furniture as they stormed and searched a home in Al-Bireh city and demolished several Livestock sheds in Al-Taybeh.

Jenin: Israeli forces uprooted 100 Olive trees planted along the main road between Jenin and Tulkarem in south Ya'bad (20 meters wide and 3 km long)

Tubas: Israeli settlers slashed the tires of several vehicles near Tayasir checkpoint.

Qalqiliya: Israeli settlers uprooted 100 Olive trees located in Al-Jit village, Israeli forces prevented a truck carrying agricultural products from passing through the wall gate entrance leading to Azzun Atma village and Israeli settlers set fire to a vehicle and a truck in Far'ata village.

Salfit: Israeli settlers uprooted and damaged 15 Olive trees in Bruqin village.

Jericho: Israeli forces demolished 4 livestock Sheds in Al-Jiftlik village.

Nablus : Israeli settlers damaged several Olive trees in Furiq village, prevented several residents from collecting Olive harvests in Qaryut village, damaged several Olive tree limbs in Burin village, uprooted 27 Olive trees in Qusra village and Israeli forces demolished a barracks in Aqraba.

Bethlehem: Israeli settler damaged the limbs of 20 Olive trees in Al-Jab'a village, damaged the limbs of 40 Olive trees in Husan village, set fire to 4 Olive

trees and uprooted 40 Olive trees in Taqou.

Hebron: Israeli forces prevented residents from using water wells located in Al-Far'a area located between Tafuh and Dura, Israeli settlers damaged the limbs of several Olive trees in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood located in the old city of Hebron, Israeli settlers damaged 3 trees (1 Olive tree, 1 Almond tree and 1 fig tree) near Qarbata school in the old city of Hebron, Israeli settlers uprooted 106 Olive trees in Wadi Mu'en area located in south Yatta, Israeli forces opened fire towards 2 vehicles causing them to explode in Zif village and Israeli forces demolished 2 livestock barracks in Khilat Ibrahim area in Ithna.

Khan Yunis: Israeli airstrikes towards Khan Yunis destroyed 2 livestock dens (1 for chickens and 1 for goats) and as a result killed 3500 total livestock.

The Israeli military served the following demolition orders for the month of November 2013:

- The Israeli military served halt to construction order for 2 homes in Wadi Aziz and Al Be'r area in Ithna located in Hebron.
- The Israeli military served halt to construction order for the construction of a mosque in east Yatta and confiscated several construction tools after forcing construction workers to leave the construction site.
- The Israeli military served demolition orders to demolish 9 barracks in Bardala village located in Tubas.
- The Israeli military served orders for the removal of 25 electrical poles and the demolition of 7 barracks in Barta'a Al-Sharqiya village located in Jenin.
- The Israeli military served halt to construction orders for 2 homes in Deir Ballut in Salfit.
- The Israeli military served halt to construction orders for 2 homes in Harris village in Salfit.
- The Israeli military served demolition orders for the demolition of 2 barracks in Barta'a Al-Sharqiya located behind the wall gate in Jenin.
- The Israeli military served orders for the uprooting of 100 Olive trees planted along the main road between Jenin and Tulkarem in south Ya'bad (20 meters wide and 3 km long) located in Jenin.

Israeli forces confiscated the following property during the month of November 2013:

Jerusalem: Israeli forces confiscated several computers after storming a computer store in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood, a computer after storming a home in Al-Thuri neighbourhood and a computer after storming a computer store in Anata.

Ramallah: Israeli forces confiscated a computer after storming a home in Ramallah

Jenin: Israeli forces confiscated a computer and a cellular telephone in Jaba', an agricultural tractor and computer in Jenin, a computer in Ya'bad, several tons of meat, eggs and several heads of livestock (goats) from Barta'a Al-Sharqiya

Tulkarem: Israeli forces confiscated several vehicle spare parts from a store in Far'un village.

Nablus: Israeli forces confiscated a computer in Balata camp.

Hebron: Israeli forces confiscated a concrete pump truck, several sacks of concrete mix from a construction site (Mosque) in east Yatta, a gun after storming a Palestinian National security officers home in Tarqumiya and a truck in Ithna

North Gaza: Israeli forces confiscated 2 fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

Rafah: Israeli forces confiscated 2 fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.

12. Settler Violence

A total of **67** incidents of Settler violence occurred during the month of November including:

Jerusalem: Israeli settlers stormed Hosh Al-Shuhab area and damaged tiles while replacing them with new ones in an attempt to change the cultural heritage of the site in the old city of Jerusalem, assaulted several residents in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood and attempted to steal 70 heads of livestock (goats) in Mikhmas village.

Ramallah: Israeli settlers chased several school children in Turmus'aya and stoned vehicles near "Bet El" settlement junction along the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp.

Jenin: Israeli settlers prevented several residents from entering their agricultural land near Kafrit village, set fire to several tires near Ya'bad junction and stormed Jabal Al-Hafirat area.

Tulkarem: Israeli settlers stormed Beit Lid.

Nablus: Israeli settlers damaged several Olive tree limbs in Burin village, stormed Asira Al-Qibliya, uprooted 27 Olive trees and demolished a storage shed in Qusra village, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over a residents along the main road in Huwara, stormed the outskirts of Burin village, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured a 74 year old residents along the main road in Huwara, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Mas'udiya area in Burqa, hurled firebombs towards a home in Burin village and stormed Yanun village.

Qalqiliya: Israeli settlers sprayed pepper spray onto a resident face in Al-Nabi Elisa's, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over a resident in south Qalqiliya, uprooted 100 Olive trees in Al-Jit village, an Israeli settler riding a tractor stormed Immatin village and provoked residents, set fire to a vehicle and truck then sprayed racist graffiti on walls of a home in Fara'ta village

Salfit: Israeli forces uprooted 15 Olive trees in Bruqin.

Bethlehem: Israeli settlers damaged tree limbs of 20 Olive trees in Al-Jaba'at village,, stoned vehicles near the entrance of Taqou', damaged the limbs of 40 Olive trees in Husan village, set fire to 4 Olive trees in Taqou' ,uprooted 40 Olive trees in Taqou', stormed Ush Al-Ghurab area and stormed the west entrance of Taqou'.

Hebron: Israeli settlers set fire to 2 vehicles and spray painted racist graffiti on the walls of a home near "Kiryat Araba'" settlement in the old city of Hebron, chopped down 3 trees in Qarbata, uprooted and chopped 106 Olive trees in Wadi Mou'in area located in south east Yatta, stormed an archeological building and damaged several tiles while replacing them with new ones in an attempt to change the cultural legacy of the site located in the old city of Hebron, assaulted and injured 4 residents as they were farming their land in south Yatta and assaulted and injured several farmers and Sheppard's as they were on agricultural land in Qawawis village.

13. Closure of Crossing Points

The Israeli military completely closed crossing points into the Gaza Strip, including access points within the Green Line, on **155** occasions during the month of November. The Israeli military closed crossing points within the Green Line on **105** occasions. It opened ***Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing*** for 25 days for previously-coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals and ***Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing*** for 20 days for transportation of food supplies, humanitarian aid, and cooking gas. In addition to allowing in animal feed, construction cargo designated for UNRWA and internationally-funded projects was transported through the Crossing. ***Sufa Crossing*** was closed throughout the month. On the other hand, the Israeli authorities have continued to unilaterally close ***Ash Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing***. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Israeli authorities has also continued to completely close ***Al Muntar (Karnei) Commercial Crossing***.

The Israeli military closed international crossing points on **50** occasions. ***Rafah Crossing*** was open for 10 days to allow access to civilians departing the Gaza Strip and to those arriving from Egypt. ***Yasser Arafat International Airport*** has remained closed since the outbreak of the second *Intifada*.
