MONTHLY SUMMARY OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS

01 November 2015 - 30 November 2015

The following summary tables and overview of events survey hostile Israeli activities during the period 01 November 2015 to 30 November 2015. The report includes a summary table of events, classified by type, throughout the West Bank and Gaza Strip, in addition to a comparative table surveying events over the past three months. The survey is compiled from the Daily Situation Reports of the Palestinian Monitoring Group (PMG) of the Negotiations Affairs Department (NAD) of the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO). The PMG monitors ground conditions in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, including Israeli and Palestinian violations. The information reported through the PMG process represents data available at the time of distribution only.

SAMPLE OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2015

- 01 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned t the junction of Beit Einun village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents during the funeral of martyr Raed Jaradat in Sa'ir town. In addition, Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed civilian Fadi Hassan Abbas Al-Froukh, 27, from Sa'ir for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- **02 November 2015:** Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Al-Jalama checkpoint north of Jenin city, opened fire towards 2 children, killing 1; Ahmad Awad Abu Al-Rub, 17, for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier. Israeli forces held the dead body in custody and arrested the other child.
- **04 November 2015:** Israeli forces killed civilian Ibrahim Samir Ibrahim Skafi, 23, from Hebron city near Al-Hawawer area (north entrance of Halhul) for allegedly running over 2 Israeli soldiers, according to Israeli claims. The Israeli forces also arrested 1 civilian.
- **05 November 2015:** Israeli forces killed civilian Malik Talal Mohammad Al-Sharif, 26, from Hebron city, near Kfar Itzyon settlement for allegedly stabbing an Israeli soldier.
- 05 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards residents east of Al-Farrahin area east of Abasan Al-Kabira during a demonstration in protest of continuous Israeli attacks on the al-Aqsa Mosque, killing civilian Salama Mousa Abu Jame', 23, from Al-Zanna area in Ben Suhayla, and injuring 3 civilians. Also several civilians were suffocated as a result of tear gas inhalation.
- **06 November 2015:** Israeli forces killed female civilian Tharwat Ibrahim Salim Al-Sharawi, 73, from Hebron city as she was entering a gas station in Ras Al-Jora north of Hebron for allegedly attempting to run over an Israeli soldier. Israeli forces opened fire at her and killing her instantly and injuring 2 civilians working in the gas station: Ihab Kamal Khalil Badawi and Mahmoud Youssef Mohammad Zamareh. Moreover, Israeli forces confiscated surveillance cameras from the gas station.
- **08 November 2015:** Israeli forces position dint he vicinity of Zaatara junction killed civilian Sleiman Adel Mohammad Shahin, 22, from Al-Bireh city in Ramallah district, for allegedly running over 4 civilians near the checkpoint (according to Israeli claims).
- **09 November 2015:** Israeli forces positioned at checkpoint (109) southeast Qalqilya city, killed female civilian Rasha Mohammad Ahmad Eweisi, 23, from Qalqilya city, for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier (according to Israeli claims). At once Israeli forces set up checkpoints at the east and south entrances of Qalqilya city and at the entrance of Azzun and Izbet Al-Tabib villages and denied civilian access.
- 10 November 2015: Israeli forces killed civilian Mohammad Abed Ali Nimer, 37, from Isawiyye village, in Musrara neighbourhood for allegedly attempting to stab a Jewish settler (according to Israeli claims).
- 10 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned at the Container checkpoint shot dead civilian Sadeq Ziyad Sadeq Gharibe, 16, from Sanour village in Jenin district.
- 12 November 2015: Israeli special force raided Al-Ahli Hospital in Hebron city and arrested one injured civilian. In addition, Jewish settlers shot dead civilian Abdallah Azzam Shaaban Al-Shalaldeh, 27, who was shot by Jewish settlers in Wadi Sa'ir area during the olive picking season.
- 13 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Al-Mahkama checkpoint near bet El settlement north of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning during a demonstration against the continuous Israeli attacks on Al-Aqsa Mosque, injuring 26 civilians (including 4 children): Sleiman Nassar Hamdan, 15, Mohammad Muhsen Ataya, 17, Riyad Abdel Munem Matar, 17, Mohammad Yihya Al-Tokhi, 16, Qaisar Rasem Hamdan, Abdel Majeed Hassan Bader, Qussai Amin Al-Sie'ri, Qusai Saleh Al-Fara, Hilmiyye Samih Hassan, Basel Ibrahim Rayyash, Abdel Rahman Ahmad Hassan, Ahmad Mohammad Turki, Mansour Yasser Hawamreh and others whose names were not identified. In addition, several civilians were suffocated as a result of tear gas inhalation.
- 13 November 2015: Israeli forces near Budrus village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for

- alleged stoning and as a result killed civilian Lafi Youssef Awad, 22.
- 13 November 2015: Civilian Mahmoud Mohammad Issa Al-Shalaldeh, 22, from Sa'ir town died of injuries sustained during clashes with Israeli forces.
- 13 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Halhul bridge and Ras al-Jora area north of Hebron city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result killed university student Hassan Jihad Al-Bou, 23, from Halhul, and injured 5 residents including a child: Yihya Sharif Hamdi Abu Seif, 16, Mahmoud Tayeh Al-Shalalda, 50, Mazen Abdel Hameed Abu Asaba, Jamil Abdel Razik Abu Rayyan and Mohammad Salman Zamaareh.
- 16 November 2015: Israeli forces raided Qalandia refugee camp, detonated 1 civilian home owned by a prisoner's family of Mohammad Abu Shahin (who was accused of opening fire at Jewish settlers in Deir Bzeegh village), clashed with civilians and as a result killed 2 civilians: Ahmad Subhi Abu Al-Aish, 27, and Laith Ashraf Manasra, 22, and injured 4 civilians (once seriously injured and arrested 1 injured child.
- 17 November 2015: Israeli forces near Turmusayya town opened fire towards a civilian vehicle for alleged stoning of an Israeli patrol, killing civilian Mohammad Munir Hassan Saleh, 24, from Aroura. In addition, Israeli forces arrested 2 civilians (including 1 military staff from the Civil Defence).
- 19 November 2015: University student Mahmoud said Mahmoud Ilayyan, 23, from Anata town in Jerusalem, died of injuries sustained during clashes in the vicinity of al-Hikma checkpoint near Bet El settlement north of Al-Bireh city in Ramallah district about a week ago.
- 19 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Kfar Itzyon opened fire towards 1 civilian (who was driving his car for allegedly shooting at settlers near Alon Shavot settlement, killing 2 settlers and injuring 10 others) and as a result killed a civilian who happened to be in the location: Shadi Zuhdi Rateb Arafeh, 26, from Hebron. The civilian driving the car was injured and arrested.
- 22 November 2015: Israeli forces opened fire and killed civilian Shadi Mohammad Mahmoud Khasib, 31, from Aroura village in Ramallah district and who works as a taxi driver in Al-Khan al-Ahmar area while he was going back home from work from Jericho to Ramallah. He was shot for allegedly stabbing a Jewish settler (according to Israeli claims).
- 22 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Huwara checkpoint opened fire at a killed a girl called Ashraqat Taha Ahmad Qatnani, 16, from Askar refugee camp in Nablus for allegedly attempting to stab a Jewish settler (according to Israeli claims).
- 22 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Kfar Itzyon settlement shot dead civilian Issam Ahmad Salman Thawabteh, 31, from Beit Fajjar for allegedly stabbing a female Jewish settler (according to Israeli claims).
- 23 November 2015: Female child Hadil Wajih Awwad, 16, was shot dead and child Nourhan Ibrahim Awwad, 15, was seriously injured and arrested (both from Qalandia refugee camp) as they were shot by Israeli forces for allegedly attempting to stab a Jewish settler (according to Israeli clams).
- 23 November 2015: Israeli forces near the gas station alongside bypass road 443 near Beit Ur Al-Tahta village shot dead civilian Ahmad Jamal Ahmad Taha, 20, from Qatanna village in Jerusalem, for allegedly stabbing a Jewish settler and causing injury to a female Israeli soldier (according to Israeli claims).
- 23 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Huwara checkpoint shot dead child Ala' Khalil Hashash, 16, a resident of Askar refugee camp for allegedly attempting to stab a Jewish settler (according to Israeli claims). Also Israeli forces opened fire towards civilians seriously injuring female civilian Samah Abdel Mu'men Ahmad from Uriyye village in Salfit district and was taken to Nablus Government Hospital.

- 25 November 2015: Child Ibrahim Abdel Halim Youssef Daoud, 16, from Deir Ghassana town died of injuries sustained during clashes with Israeli forces two weeks ago in the vicinity of Al-Mahkama checkpoint near Bet El settlement north of Al-Bireh city.
- 25 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Al-Fawwar junction opened fire and killed civilian Mohammad Ismail Al-Shweiki, 21, for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- **26 November 2015:** Israeli forces raided Qatanna village, clashed with civilians, stormed civilian homes and shot dead civilian Yihya Yusri Taha, 21.
- 26 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Zaatara checkpoint opened fire and killed civilian Saner Hassan Sarisi, 51, from Jenin city for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- 26 November 2015: Israeli forces positioned in front of Al-Arroub refugee camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun grenades and tear gas canisters towards civilian homes at the entrance of the camp for alleged stoning, killing civilian Khalid Mahmnoud Jawabreh, 20, a resident of the camp.
- 27 November 2015: Jewish settlers near Kfar Edumim settlement in Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area opened fire and killed civilian Fadi Mohammad Mahmoud Khasib, 31, from Ramallah city (brother of martyr Shadi Khasib who was killed in the same location as mentioned in 23 November 2015 report) for allegedly running over 3 Israeli soldiers (according to Israeli claims).
- 27 November 2015: Israeli forces near the entrance of Beit Ummar opened fire and killed civilian Omar Arafat Issa Al-Za'aqiq a resident of Beit Ummar or allegedly running over and injuring 5 Israeli soldiers (according to Israeli claims).
- 29 November 2015: Israeli forces opened fire and killed civilian Bassim Abdel Rahman Salah, 38, from Nablus city in Al-Wad Street in the old city of Jerusalem for allegedly stabbing an Israeli soldier.
- 29 November 2015: Israeli force in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun grenades and tear gas canisters towards civilians for alleged stoning, killing child Ayman Samih Hassan Al-Abbasi, 17.



ANALYSIS OF EVENTS

• Killings:

During the month of November 2015, Israeli forces killed 34 residents including seven children, one university student and one elderly woman


• <u>Injuries</u>

910 injuries were reported in the month of November 2015 (813 Palestinians in the West Bank and 97 in the Gaza Strip), including 114 children, 7 journalists, 1 paramedic, 2 women, 2 elderly civilians, 1 university student and 3 fishermen.

Arrests

During the month of November, the Israeli military arrested 701 Palestinians (697 the West Bank and 4 in the Gaza Strip). The majority of arrests took place in the districts of Jerusalem (118); Ramallah (83); Jenin (28); Tubas (3); Tulkarem (17); Qalqiliya (49); Nablus (67); Salfit (13); Jericho (16); Bethlehem (50); Hebron (253); Northern Gaza (3); Khan Yunis (1). Among those arrested by the Israeli military were 106 children, 9 Women, 10 Security Force officers, 9 University students and 2 Journalists.

The Israeli Military temporarily detained 413 Palestinians which included 57 children, 4 women, 10 journalists, 3 television crew and 5 Security Force officers.



Closure


Especially on Fridays, the Israeli military continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances of Jerusalem, and to restrict entrance to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem, preventing worshippers from accessing the Mosque. At the *Qalandiya checkpoint north of Jerusalem*, the Israeli military continues to prevent PNA registered civilian vehicles from crossing the checkpoint towards Ar Ram and Qalandiya as well as Dahiyat al Bareed. The checkpoint is overcrowded daily, particularly during rush hours, due to intensified restrictions and search measures applied by Israeli troops. During the month of August the Israeli military also continued to intensify restrictions at the *Tayasir checkpoint* and *Al Hamra junction checkpoint* leading to the Jordan Valley area, only allowing access to civilians whose IDs indicate District of Jericho residence or others holding special access permits. In addition, restrictions were intensified and civilian access was obstructed at the *Za'tara junction checkpoint* (separating the northern and central West Bank districts) as well as at the *As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint* (separating the central and southern West Bank districts).

The Israeli military installed 691 flying checkpoints in November (compared with 535 in October and 474 in September) and as a result restricted the free

The Israeli military installed 691 flying checkpoints in November (compared with 535 in October and 474 in September) and as a result restricted the free access and movement of residents, merchant supplies and agricultural goods.

Distribution of flying checkpoints in the West Bank

The Israeli military set up 459 flying checkpoints in September and searched Palestinian civilians and vehicles in and around Palestinian residential areas in the districts of Jerusalem (116); Ramallah (109); Jenin (18); Tubas (3); Tulkarem (10); Qalqiliya (48); Nablus (61); Salfit (31); Jericho (28); Bethlehem (129) and Hebron (138).



Raids


The Israeli military carried out 678 raids in Palestinian residential areas during the month of November {671 in the West Bank and 7 in the Gaza Strip}. The majority of Israeli military raids were reported to have taken place in the districts of Jerusalem (71); Ramallah (84); Jenin (36); Tubas (8); Tulkarem (42); Qalqiliya (35); Nablus (68); Salfit (31); Jericho (24); Bethlehem (102); Hebron (170); Northern Gaza (2); Gaza (3); Khan Yunis (2).

The Israeli military opened fire on 962 occasions during raids and clashes with civilians (90.1% of attacks).

Attacks

742 attacks were reported to have taken place during the month of November (659 in the West Bank and 83 in the Gaza Strip).

The Israeli military carried out 634 attacks during confrontations between the Israeli military and Palestinians 61 attacks from Israeli military posts on civilian homes and property. In addition Israeli navy vessels carried out 22 attacks on Palestinian fishermen and territory, 11 from Military Checkpoint, 4 from Settler attack, 5 from Air Strike and 4 attacks during raids.



Home Demolition

<u>During the month of November 2015, the Israeli military demolished Palestinian homes and residential tents, which consisted of the following:</u>

- The Israeli military demolished 1 home in Jabal Al-Mukabber neighbourhood in Jerusalem and a 3-storey building of 3 apartments in Beit Hanina in Jerusalem.
- The Israeli military forced Disi family inn Jaffa Gate area to demolition a 3x3 addition to their home in enforcement of a court decision or pay the amount of ILS 30,000 as a fine for unlicensed construction.
- The Israeli military detonated an apartment owned by a pris0oner's family in Qalandia refugee camp in Jerusalem.
- The Israeli military demolished 2 barracks used as living quarters in Al-Hadidiyye village in the northern valley in Tulkarem.
- The Israeli military detonated and demolishes a home in Silwad in Ramallah and three homes in Nabklus.

During the month of November 2015 the Israeli Military served the following Demolition orders:

- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 10 homes in Jaloud village in Nablus and order for the demolition of martyr's home in Hebron.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 1 home in Baqaa area in the old city of Hebron.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for a rented home of prisoner Hilweh Salim Hamamreh in Bethlehem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 2 apartments in Bir Ayyoub area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition order home of a martyr in Beit Ula in Hebron district.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for barracks in Fasayel Al-Foqa village in Jericho district.

- Israeli forces served demolition orders for home of a prisoner in Balaa town in Tulkarem district.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for several homes in Bustan area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- During the month of November 2015 Israeli forces occupied 38 homes and converted their rooftops into Military post:
 Ramallah District: Sinjil town, Al-Mazraa village and Al-Bireh city. Nablus District: Beit Furiq and Nablus city. Salfit District: Deir Istiya town. Bethlehem District: Brit Fajjar town, Taqou' and Al-Minya village. Hebron District: Al-Arroub refugee camp, Beit 'Ummar, Sa'ir town and the old city of Hebron.

Attacks on Public and Private Property

A total of 163 **incidents of destruction and confiscation** of Palestinian public and private property by Israeli settlers and Israeli forces were reported in November 2015 (161 in the West Bank and 2 in The Gaza Strip).

Attacks on Public and Private property occurred as follows per District:

Jerusalem: Israeli forces forced merchants to close their stores in Hizma village and closed coffee shop in Al-Qatanin market in the old city of Jerusalem. Israeli forces cuased material damage to civilian homes in Qalandia refugee camp. Israeli forces detained a bulldozer while cleaning the road near Al-Quds University in Abu Dis. Israeli forces damaged doors of the Registrar's Office in Abu Dis University. Jewish settlers backed up by Israeli forces stormed the compound to Al-Aqsa Mosque and provoked civilians.

Ramallah: Israeli forces inflicted damage to 2 civilian homes during search in Al-Janiye village and targeted an ambulance with live fire and rubber coated bullets. Israeli forces forced civilian picking olives on the land in Oyoun Al-Haramiyye area north of Silwad town to leave their land.

<u>Tubas:</u> Israeli forces forcibly removed several families from their homes on 26 November 2015 from 06:40 till 12:30 under the pretext of conducting military training in Humsa village in North Jordan valley. Israeli bulldozers levelled 3 km road leading to Al-Hadidiye village, detained 2 trucks and 1 bulldozer in Ras Al-Ahmar area east of Khirbet Atuf village. Israeli forces forcibly removed families from their homes from 06:30 till 24:00 on 19 November 2015 in Humsa Al-Foqa village under the pretext of conducting military training.

Jenin: Israeli forces demolished 3 artesian wells water tank and green houses, and caused damage to a civilian vehicle at Arraba junction. Israeli forces also closed a car park in the vicinity of Al-Jalama checkpoint.

Tulkarem: Israeli forces set green houses on fire as a result of firing tear gas canisters towards civilians in the vicinity of Gishuri factories.

Qalqiliya: Israeli forces fires tub grenade inside 1 civilian home and as a result fire broke out in the home. Israeli forces damaged a mobile phone owned by a military officer in Azzun town.

Nablus: Israeli settlers uprooted olive trees in Awarta village and kicked out farmers from their land during olive picking season south west Qaryut village.

Salfit: Israeli forces caused material damage to home furniture in Arraba, Alzawiyye and Kafr Al-Dik towns.

<u>Bethlehem:</u> Israeli forces demolished 2 establishments and one store selling construction material in Husan village; Israeli forces demolished windshield of civilian vehicles and caused damage to water tanks in Um Rukba in al-Khader and set home furniture on fire in Aida refugee camp.

<u>Hebron:</u> Israeli forces damages windshields of civilian vehicles in Wadi Al-Joz area in Hebron district and issued order for the closure of Dream Radio Station for 6 months after confiscation of equipment. Israeli forces demolished water catchment tank in Al-Hawawer area north of Halhul, and demolished 3 livestock in Joret Al-Kheil area in Wadi Sa'ir. Israeli forces also forcibly removed farmers and families from their land during olive picking near bet En settlement. Israeli forces demolished barracks in Jabal Johar in the old city of Hebron and broke down 3 doors in Salaymeh quarter during home search. Israeli forces shurt down Al-Huriyyeh Radio station in the old city of Hebron.

Gaza: Israeli forces caused material damage to fishing boats.

Central Gaza: Israeli forces damaged fishing boats.

<u>Israeli forces served military orders for the following:</u>

Israeli forces served military orders for the closure and confiscation of equipment from Al-Zaitouneh Radio Station in Salfit.

Israeli forces served military orders to stop construction work in 2 buildings in Anata in Jerusalem under the pretext of unlicensed construction.

Israeli forces served military orders for the closure of Hebron radio station for 6 months and confiscation of its equipment.

Israeli forces served military orders to stop construction of a 3 kilometre road leading to Al-Jadida village in the North Jordan Valley.

Israeli forces served military orders for uprooting 80 olive trees in Wadi Qana in Salfit district.

Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of commercial stores in Izbet al-Tabib village in Qalqlya.

Israeli forces served military orders for the demolition of barracks and the eviction of a farm in Fasayel al-Foqa village in Jericho district.

Confiscation and seizure of Palestinian owned property during September 2015:

- **Jerusalem:** Israeli forces confiscated surveillance cameras from stores in Abu Dis.
- **Ramallah:** Israeli forces confiscated surveillance cameras from an organization and a factory in al-Bireh and from a restaurant in Birzeit and from a store in Jifna and from a gas station in Ein Sinya and from commercial stores in Dura al-Qare'.
- Jenin: Israeli forces confiscated stand and cameras from journalists in the vicinity of Al-Jalama checkpoint.
- <u>Tubas:</u> Israeli forces confiscated 4 water pumps used for irrigation in Khirbet Al-Deir and Al-Hadiddiye villages, 7 tents used As living quarters in EIN AL-Beida village, and a truck east of Tamon.
- **Tulkarem:** Israeli forces confiscated 2 vehicles from a public park on Iktaba suburb.
- Qalqiliya: Israeli forces confiscated surveillance camera footage from several merchant shops in Al-Nabi Eliyas village.
- Nablus: Israeli forces confiscated a bulldozer near Beit Dajan village, 3 buses in Nablus city and ILS 23,000 from a civilian in Nablus city.
- Salfit: Israeli forces confiscated a civilian vehicle at a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballout village.
- <u>Bethlehem:</u> Israeli forces confiscated a vehicle in Hindaza area and 3 caravans near Husan village as well as surveillance cameras from a pharmacy in Bethlehem.
- **Hebron:** Israeli forces confiscated 2 civilian vehicles in Sa'ir town, equipment from Dream radio Station in Hebron, electrical appliances and files from a charity institution in Al-Shyukh town, computers and mobile phones in Beit Ummar, water tank in Zif village, ILS 65,000 from a woman in Surif, and a motorbike in Hebron city. Israeli forces also confiscated surveillance cameras from a home in Khursa village and files from a youth centre in Tel Rmeideh.

• Settlement Activity:

Israeli forces razed agricultural land in Khirbet Makhoul area in the North Jordan Valley in Tubas.

Israeli PM approved a plan for the construction of 454 new housing units, 436 in Ramat Shlomo settlement and 18 in Ramot Alon settlement north of east Jerusalem within 1967 borders.

• Settler Violence

60 incidents of Settler violence occurred during the month of November 2015 including:

<u>Jerusalem:</u> a stabbing incident in Hizma; settlers gathered in east Jerusalem and shouted anti Arab slogans; settler stabbed child near Ramat Shkol settlement; settlers damaged barbed wire around land in Nabi Samuel village.

Ramallah: Israeli settlers attacked 2 civilian homes with Molotov cocktail and wrote anti-Arab slogans on walls in Al-Mazraah Al-Gharbieh village.

Jenin: Israeli settlers stormed Palestinian land in Kafr Al-Ra'i and Movo Dotan settlement.

<u>Nablus:</u> Israeli settlers physically assaulted 1 civilian in Yitma village; stormed the villages of Bourin, Madama and Asira al-Shimaliyye; stoned civilian vehicles near Huwara; attacked civilian picking olives in Bourin village; ran over child in the vicinity of Huwara checkpoint; opened fire towards famers.

Qalqilya: Settlers stoned civilian vehicles near Jit village; attacked child near Jaljoulia checkpoint south of Qalqilya; detained civilian near Jinasaphot village.

Salfit: Settlers attacked 2 civilians during olive picking near Rafafa settlement; stoned civilian vehicles near Za'atara checkpoint;

<u>Bethlehem:</u> Israeli settlers wrote in Hebrew anti Arab slogans on civilian vehicles; hoisted Israeli flags in Sakaria village; shouted anti-Arab slogans near Kfar Etzyon settlement; stormed civilian vehicles near Bital Illit settlement.

<u>Hebron:</u> Israeli settlers attacked civilians in Al-Sahla area in the old city of Hebron; attacked civilians near Al-Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron; stoned civilian vehicles and homes; prevented residents from drawing water from a water well in Ain Al-Far'a located in Dura; stoned residents and vehicles travelling along road (25) which leads to Tarqumiya crossing; opened fire towards a residents home in Abu Snieneh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron; Israeli settlers assaulted and injured a child in the old city of Hebron, a Israeli settler vehicle ran over a child in the old city of Hebron, assaulted 3 residents in Al-Zahed area located in the old city of Hebron.

Closure of Crossing Points

The Israeli military completely closed crossing points into the Gaza Strip, including access points within the Green Line, on 163 occasions during the month of November. The Israeli military closed crossing points within the Green Line on 103 occasions. It opened *Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing* for 26 days for previously-coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals and *Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing* for 22 days for transportation of food supplies, humanitarian aid, and cooking gas. In addition to allowing in animal feed, construction cargo designated for UNRWA and internationally-funded projects was transported through the Crossing. *Al Jamla* crossing was closed 4 times during the month of September. *Sufa Crossing* was closed throughout the month. On the other hand, the Israeli authorities have continued to unilaterally close *Ash Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing*. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Israeli authorities has also continued to completely close *Al Muntar (Karnei) Commercial Crossing*.

The Israeli military closed international crossing points on 60 occasions. *Rafah Crossing* was closed during the month of November. *Yasser Arafat International Airport* has remained closed since the outbreak of the second *Intifada*.
