### WEST BANK

# ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

# • <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

### **JERUSALEM**

- (i) At 15:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Abu Dis.
- (ii) At 20:30, the Israeli army aided and patrolled the village of Kafr Agab.
- (iii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Izariyyeh.
- (iv) At 01:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Anata.
- <u>House Demolition</u>: The Israeli army demolished 1 civilian house in Dahiyet al-Salam that is located between the town of Anata and the refugee camp of Shu'fat in the city of Jerusalem under the pretext of unlicensed construction. The house belongs to civilian Hassan Mohammad Khalaf Hamdan.

# • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	• Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

- (i) At 01:30 on March 2, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians and confiscated a revolver from one of them. The arrested civilians are:
  - (a) Jihad Mohammad Sa'ed al-Khouli;
  - (b) Mohammad Ahmad al-Balhawi; and
  - (c) Hakim Mohammad Mousa.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in the town of Qafin is Khaled Wallid Mohammad Sabbah.
  - <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

# Closure of Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Asla.
- (iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army closed with dirt barriers the road connecting Azzun town to Izbat Tabib village.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access.

# • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 13:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of Izbet al-Tabib.
- (ii) The Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Kafr Thulth, and searched civilians and vehicles.

# • Raids: At 17:05, the Israeli raided the city of Qalqilya and photographed 2 mosques and the municipality. The raid recurred at 00:40 during which the Israeli troops searched a number of civilian houses, arrested 3 civilians, and then withdrew at 03:15.

- Arrests: The 3 civilians arrested in the city of galgilya are:
- (a) Sa'ed Jamal Nazzal;
- (b) Shaher Fathi Baker Zayd; and
- (c) Muath Hakem Abu Rayyash.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 11:00, a bunch of settlers from Qadumim settlement stoned civilian vehicles on Qalqilya-Nablus main road.
- <u>Palestinian Security Measures</u>: At 23:00, the Palestinian security forces stormed barracks in the town of Kafr Thulth, found 3 rifle stores, 213 bullets, M16 machine gun, 3 hunting rifles, and different kinds of arms.

### • Wall Gates:

- (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma

- <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.
- **Flying Checkpoints**: At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the village of al-Shawawreh, and searched civilians and vehicles.

### • Raids:

- (i) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem.
- (ii) At 00:45, the Israeli army raided the city of Beit Sahour and set up a checkpoint on the eastern entrance to the city in fro not the Palestinian security forces station, and then withdrew at 02:15.
- <u>Arrests</u>: At 22:30, the Israeli army arrested at al-Walaja checkpoint civilian Ahmad Ma'roof al-Atrash.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

# • <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi

#### **HEBRON**

- neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

# • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the overpass of the town of Halhoul, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Yatta, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 17:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the road that connects the city of Hebron with the town of Dura, and searched civilians and vehicles.

### • Raids:

- (i) At 09:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron, and set up a checkpoint in the industrial zone. The raid recurred at 16:20 during which the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area of al-Hawooz. The raid occurred for a third time during which the Israeli troops detained a Palestinian patrol in duty in Bab al-Zawiyyeh.
- (ii) At 10:25, the Israeli army raided the town of Edna and clashed with civilians during search of an aluminum factory.
- (iii) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the area of Kinar in the town of Dura and searched 1 civilian house.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access).
- Raids: At dawn on April 3, the Israeli army raided the area of al-Waha that is located north-west of the town of Beit Lahia, opened fire intensively during house search, arrested 5 civilians, and clashed with armed individuals. In addition the Israeli troops razed agricultural land.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The 5 civilians arrest in the town of Beit Lahia have not been identified.

### • Palestinian Attacks:

(i) At 13:00, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
