ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (a) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (b) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (c) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Rafat and Ramot checkpoints, as well as the checkpoint set up near the village of Jaba'
- Raids: At 00;10, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of Qalandya and opened fire intensively during house search. The Israeli army withdrew at 03:00.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west

RAMALLAH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. Flving Checkpoints: At 09:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Deit Dibwan and impeded traffic. Raids: At 10:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of al-Bireh. The raid recurred at 14:10 during which the Israeli army besieged the Civil affairs Ministry and confiscated the IDs of security guards. The Israeli army withdrew after the intervention of the military liaison. At 02:50, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al-Jalazon and searched one civilian house. At 02:55, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah and the refugee camp of al-Am'ari, searched 3 houses, arrested one civilian in the camp, handed a number of civilians notices to see the Israeli intelligence, and withdrew at 04:30. Arrests: At 18:00, it was found out that the civilian arrested in the refugee camp of al-Jalazon is Fadi Bassem Saqer. His place of detention is not known. The civilian arrested in the refugee camp of al-Am'ari is Waleed Mohammad Suleiman Khader. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town
	of 'Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Tayaseer checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. Flying Checkpoints: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a 2 checkpoints between the city of Jenin and the town of Qabatia, and between the town of al-Zababdeh and the Arab-American University. At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the town of 'Arraba, and searched civilians and vehicles.
	• Raids:

	(i) At 08:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Qabatia and the village of Deir al-Pasha.
	(ii) At 18:30, the Israeli army raided the area located between the town of al-Zababdeh and the village of Misliyyeh. The Israeli army conducted military maneuvers inj the area of Sahl Sanour.
	(iii) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the area around the town of Toubas and conducted military training.
	(iv) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Kafr Dan and the area of Wadi Bruqin.
	Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
	• <u>Closure</u> : The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.
	• Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt
	barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain;

	them into military posts. The Israeli army withdrew at 05:00.
	• <u>Wall Gates</u> : Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted

	(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.
	• <u>Wall Construction</u> : Land leveling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr
	Thulth and 'Azzun.
	Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al- Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.
	 (iv) The Israeli army continues to block the roads leading to the town of al-Jama'een with dirt barricades. <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing
	checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:
	(i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other
NABLUS	days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only. (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.
	(iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.
	(iv) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the checkpoints around the city of Nablus and impeded traffic.
	(v) The Israeli army razed land in the area near Beit Iba checkpoint that is set up at the western entrance to the city of Nablus. In addition, the Israeli army set up 3 metal gates at the checkpoint for civilian access.
	• Flying Checkpoints: At 13:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the
	entrance to the town of al-Jamma'een, and searched civilians and vehicles.
	• Raids:
	(i) At 00:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, the refugee camp of Balata, and the refugee camp of Ein al-Ma' and withdrew at 03:00.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
SALFIT	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western

	entrance to the town of Kafr al-Dik.
	 Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tarah checkpoints and to deny civilian access. At 13:10, the Israeli army closed Za'tarah checkpoint and opened it at 13:40. The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the junction of the town of Za'tarah and impede traffic. Flying checkpoints: At 08:30, the Israeli army et up 2 checkpoints at the entrances to the
	town of Bruqin and the village of Hares. (ii) At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the
	village of Qarawat Bani Hassan. (iii) At 18:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Salfit, and searched civilians and vehicles until 19:00. • Raids: At 22:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Bruqin and opened fire and fired tear gas bombs after civilians stoned a settler vehicles passing on the bypass road alongside the village. The Israeli army withdrew at 12:30.
	 <u>Settler Attacks</u>: At 22:10, a bunch of settlers attacked the house of civilian Hikmat Ismail Abdel Rahman which is located in the town of Bruqin near the bypass road. The settlers damaged the window panes and incurred damage to his car and chased his cattle. At once the Israeli army interfered and evacuated the settlers at 01:00. <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the
	city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ari'el.
	• <u>Closure</u> : The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.
JERICHO	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 16;45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of Vered Yeriho settlement. <u>Raids</u>: at 12:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Jericho.
BETHLEHEM	• Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land
	that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number

07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahour and Bethlehem.

• Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 12:25, the Israeli army set up 2 checkpoints at the entrance to the city of Beit Sahour and the village of al-Shawawreh, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 15:00, the Israeli army setup a checkpoint on Wadi al-Nar road that connects the town of al-Ubaidiyyeh with al-Sawahreh al-Sharqiyyeh, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the town al-Khader, and searched civilians and vehicles.

Raids:

- (i) At 16:00. the Israeli army raided the area of al-Zeer, where clashed with civilians broke our during house search.
- (ii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Salah and set up a checkpoint.
- (iii) At 01;00, the Israeli army raided the town of Teqoa, detained one civilian but released him at a later time.
- (iv) At 01:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem and the refugee camp of al-Dheisheh, searched one house and arrested 3 civilians.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The 3 civilians arrested in the city of Bethlehem and the refugee camp of al-Dheisheh are:
- (a) Omar Mohammad al-Effendi;
- (b) Mohammad Khader Da'amseh; and
- (c) Ghassan Hermas.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

• Closure:

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of

Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- (iii) At 13:00, the Israeli army closed the entrance to the town of Beit 'Ummar with an iron gate after clashes with civilians.

• Raids:

- (i) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Bani Na'eem where clashes with civilians broke out. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 3 children.
- (ii) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the refugee camp of al'Arroub.
- (iii) At 18:45, the Israeli army raided the area around the bridge of the town of Beit Kahel and combed it.
- (iv) At 22:45, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron and the area of Kinar in the town of Dura, and patrolled them until 04:00.
- (v) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Yatta.

• Arrests:

- (i) At 20:00, the Israeli army arrested civilian Ayman Ismail Aweidat, a resident of the refugee camp of al-'Arroub, while he was reporting to the Israeli intelligence in Kfar Etzyon settlement.
- (ii) The 3 civilians arrested in the town of Bani Na'eem are;
- (a) Mohammad Ahmad al-Tarayreh, 12;
- (b) Hamadah Farah Mteir, 16; and
- (c) Abed Khaled Mteir, 14.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

Prisoners' Conditions

- Palestinian prisoners in Huwara detention camp south of the city of Nablus, threatened to launch a
 hunger strike because of the deteriorated conditions they are living in. The prison administration
 prevents prisoners from going to the restroom and deliberately delays breakfast until noon. In
 addition, the prison administration deprives prisoners of winter clothing.
- The military court in al-Jalama prison extended the administrative detention term of 11 Palestinian prisoners, and prevented the advocate from visiting 10 of the prisoners under the pretext of the expiry of the investigation period.
