ALL DISTRICTS	• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.			
JERUSALEM	<ul> <li>Closure: <ul> <li>(i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, set up several checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound, and denied access to civilians above 45 years of age to perform Friday prayers at the Al Aqsa Mosque.</li> <li>(ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli authorities issued Military Order # S/02/09 on the closure of and denial of civilian access to the "demarcation area" along the Wall in the area surrounding the city of Jerusalem. Accordingly, local residents and civilians holding permits can access this area through crossings and gates set up at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. (The demarcation area is defined by a set of military orders relating to land confiscation for Wall construction).</li> <li>Closure of Main Roads:</li> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'.</li> <li>(ii) Beginning on 16 February 2009, the Israeli army has continued to close the iron gate along the Wall section, separating the area of Dahiyat al Bareed from the town of Ar Ram.</li> <li>Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>Attack: At 18:00, Israeli troops guarding the Wall section near Qalandiya Airport opened fire towards a number of children in the area of Samir Amis, allegedly for throwing stones.</li> <li>Raids:</li> <li>(i) At dawn on 01 April 2009, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit 'Anan and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li>(iii) On 01 April 2009, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit Duqqu and arrested 2 civilians.</li> <li>(iv) At 03:00, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians, and withdrew at 03:50.</li> <li>Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the town of 'Anata:</li> <li>(ii) Mohammed Khalil Abd</li></ul></li></ul>

#### Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall (ii) gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu; in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina; west of the village of Al Jib; in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna; south of the village of Beit Hanina; and in the area surrounding the checkpoint set up at the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp.

#### Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades and cement blocks the road connecting the villages of Ras Karkar and Kharbatha Bani Harith; the entrances to the villages of Sinjil, Saffa, and 'Ein Yabrud; and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – 'Ein Samiya.

- **Checkpoint:** The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint on the overpass to 'Atara town and impede civilian access. At 08:30, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint and denied access until 10:00.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles on the junction to the town of At Tayba along the Ramallah-Jericho road.

- (i) At 13:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Lid, searched 1 house and 1 commercial shop, detained 9 civilians, and released them after interrogation.
- (ii) At 04:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 Palestinian National Security officer.

#### • Arrests:

- <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

## • <u>Closure of Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun.

• <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and to impede civilian access. At 09:40, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint, denied civilian access, and reopened it at a later time.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Qalqiliya. At 01:25, the Israeli army raided the city again, arrested 2 civilians, and withdrew at 02:30.
- (ii) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Sanniriya and searched an internet cafe.

#### • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the city of Qalqiliya:

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.

#### • Wall Construction:

(i) Having completed the Wall-related infrastructure, land levelling for Wall construction ceased in the towns of 'Azzun and Kafr Thulth as well as in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif.

JERICHO	<ul> <li>Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. At 15:20, Israeli troops positioned at the Al 'Auja junction checkpoint prevented vehicles not registered on the names of their respective owners from crossing.</li> </ul>

#### • Raids/Injury:

- (i) At 01:35, the Israeli army raided the village of Fasayil and arrested 1 civilian.
- (ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Marj Na'ja and used Police dogs to search a house. A dog bit a civilian, leaving him with injuries. Consequently, he was transported to hospital for medical treatment. The Israeli army also arrested 3 civilians (brothers).
- (iii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Az Zubeidat and arrested 1 civilian.

#### • Arrests:

- (i) The Israeli army arrested Dawoud Ghawanmeh in the village of Fasayil. The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the villages of Marj Na'ja:
- (ii) Jadallah Nimer Sawarkeh;
- (iii) Ibrahim Nimer Sawarkeh; and
- (iv) Subhi Nimer Sawarkeh.
- (v) The Israeli army arrested Mohammed Mahmoud Zubeidat in the village of Az Zubeidat.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) According to Military Order # 07/02/S, the Israeli army has continued since 15 September 2007 to deny civilian access to an area measuring 22 *dunums* (5.436 acres) of land in the area of Mazmuriya in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. The land was confiscated pursuant to Military Order # 07/31/T.
- Closure of Main Roads: In addition to 2 side roads east and south of the village of Al Walaja, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad; Talita-Nazlet as Sidr in the city of Beit Jala; Al Khadr -Road # 60; Al Khadr -Beit Jala Housing Project; Wadi Rahal-Efrat; and the side road east of the town of Beit Fajjar.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: At 11:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint and impeded civilian access in both directions.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 15:20, and again at 19:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Al Khadr.
- (ii) At 18:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar and arrested 1 civilian.
- (iii) At 01:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala.

#### • Arrests

(i) At 02:35 on 01 April 2009, the Israeli army arrested Abdullah 'Isa Shu'eibat during its raid into the city of Beit Sahur, as was reported yesterday.

#### **BETHLEHEM**

- (ii) At 02:40, the Israeli army arrested Mohammed Fu'ad Zabboun during its raid into the city of Bethlehem, in addition to those reported yesterday.
- (iii) The Israeli army arrested Taher Saber Diriyyeh in the town of Beit Fajjar.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ifrat settlement; and in the area surrounding the village of Al Walaja.

#### • <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prevent civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron.
- (iii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued Military Order # 09/06/S for closure of the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta, evacuation of civilian residents, and prevention of civilian access to the area. According to Military Orders # 05/03/T and 05/04/T, land in this area was confiscated for Wall construction.

#### **HEBRON**

#### Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to Al Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; as well as the entrances to Al 'Arrub refugee camp and the village of At Tuwani.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Ash Shalala Old Street leading to the old city of Hebron.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to open the iron gate on the junction of Farsh Al Hawa, which leads to Road # 35 that leads to Tarqumiya Crossing, from 05:00 until 07:00 and from 09:00 until 13:00.
- (v) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrances to the villages of Wadi ash Shajina and Khirbet Basam.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Beit Kahil and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 16:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Beit 'Einun and searched civilians and vehicles.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Bani Na'im and patrolled the area until 09:00.
- (ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, set up a checkpoint in the area of Ras al Jora, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city again and patrolled the area.
- (iii) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area of Sinjir between the city of Hebron and the town of Dura.
- (iv) At 01:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Samit and searched offices of the village's council.
- (v) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura and patrolled the area until 04:30.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: On 01 April 2009, a group of Israeli settlers severely beat Abdul Razzaq 'Azzam Da'na in the area of Wadi an Nassara in the old city of Hebron, leaving him with contusions. As a result, Da'na was transported to hospital for medical treatment.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal; in the area between the settlement of Eshkolot and the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta; and in the village of 'Arab ar Ramadin.

- At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by the Israeli authorities came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire for a week. Later, armed Palestinian groups extended the ceasefire until 05 February 2009. Despite the fact that the extension period expired, the ceasefire continues to hold pending negotiations carried out by Egypt.
- <u>Violation of the Ceasefire</u>: The Israeli army raided Palestinian territory. Israeli armoured vehicles and navy boats also opened fire towards civilians and property.
