WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Anata, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 16:30, the Israeli army set p a checkpoint on the junction of the village of Jaba', and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit Anan and handed a number of civilians notifications to report to the Israeli military intelligence.
- (ii) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Abu Dis and et up a checkpoint.
- (iii) At 02:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Jaba'.
- <u>House Demolition</u>: On April 9, the Israeli army demolished 1 civilian house under the pretext of unlicensed construction in the town of Beit Hanina al-Tahta. The house is owned by civilian Aref Argoub.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall

	gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
	Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western

	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.
	 Flying Checkpoints: (i) At 17:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the village of Ibzeeq, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 17:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint n the road that connects

Raids: (i) At 11:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Kur. (ii) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Qafin and clashed with civilians during search of 1 civilian house. (iii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the suburb of Irtah in the city of Tulkarem, and set up a checkpoint. Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. **Closure of Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural (i) roads east of the town of 'Azzun (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Asla. At 11:30, the Israeli army closed with dirt barriers the road connecting (iii) Azzun town to Izbat Tabib village. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access. Flying Checkpoints: At 18:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the town of Jayyous and the village3 of Kafr Jammal. **QALQILYA Raids**: At 02:00, the Israeli raided the city of Oalgilva and searched 1 civilian house. **Wall Gates:** Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special (i) Israeli permits. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma (ii) Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. Wall Construction: Land leveling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler **NABLUS** bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing

checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:

- (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.
- (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.
- (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.
- (iv) At 11:00, the Israeli army closed Huwara checkpoint and impeded traffic until 12:00.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 13:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint of al-Badhan road, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 13:25, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Beita, and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 16:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Talouza.
- (ii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Beita, searched a number of civilians, and arrested 3 civilians, including 2 children.
- (iii) The Israeli army raided the refugee camp of Balata in the city of Nablus and arrested 1 child.

Arrests

- (i) The 3 civilians arrested in the town of Beiat are:
 - (a) Kifah Inad Jaghoub, 17;
 - (b) Tareq Abdallah Adili, 17; and
 - (c) Fadl Kamel Jarwan.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in the refugee camp of Balata is Diya' Samih Abu Arab, 17.

• <u>Settler Violence</u>:

- (i) At 13:00, a bunch of settlers uptooted and broke trees and damaged irrigation water tanks that belong to civilian Mohammad Suleiman Ishtiyyeh in the area between the villages of Tel and Burin.
- (ii) At 14:30, a bunch of settlers from Barakha settlement stole 3 shepp that belong to civilian Abdel Jabbar Hussein Fajjar.
- (iii) At 17:15, a bunch of settlers stoned civilian vehicles on the road near the junction of Yitzhar settlement and uninjured 3 civilians from the same family.

• Closure of Main Roads:

SALFIT

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current *Intifada* (Uprising).
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. In addition, the Israeli army

continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Yassouf and the southern entrance to the village of Deir Istiyya with dirt barricades, as well as the southern entrance to the town of Kafl hares and the 2 northern entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Qarawa Bani Hassan.

• <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tara checkpoints and prevent civilian vehicles from traveling towards the town of Kafr al-Dik. At 12:00, the Israeli army closed Za'tara checkpoint and impeded traffic upon the arrest of a civilian under the pretext of finding a suspicious object with him. The checkpoint was reopened at 14:20.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrances to the town of al-Zawiyye and the village of Iskaka.
- (ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to town of Kafl Hares.

• Raids:

- (i) At 13:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Kafll Hares, detained 3 civilians, including 2 children, but released them at 15:20.
- (ii) At 18:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Marda and set up a checkpoint in the village center. The Israeli army withdrew at 19:20.
- (iii) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Bruqin and arrested 3 children.
- Arrests: The 3 children arrested in the town of Bruqin are:
 - (i) Hilmi Rabah Samara, 17;
 - (ii) Sameh Hatem Samara, 17; and
 - (iii) Hamada Issam Samara, 16.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.

JERICHO

- <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.

• Raids:

- (i) At 09:30, the Israeli army raided the village of al-'Auja and patrolled it until 10:30.
- (ii) At 02:40, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of Aqabat

BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Flying Checkpoints: At 12:45, the Israeli army set up 2 checkpoints opn the north-western entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and impede traffic. Raids: At 09:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Teqoa and occupied 1 civilian house and converted it into a military post. At 12:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Khader. At 12:45, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Salah, set up a checkpoint, impeded traffic, and arrested 2 civilians. At 02:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala. Arrests: The 2 civilians arrested in the village of Deir Salah have not been identified. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.
HEBRON	• Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to

implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 10:20, the Israeli army set up 6 checkpoints on the entrances to the towns of Beit Kahel, Edna, and Yatta checkpoint on al-Fawwar junction, and searched civilians and vehicles, on Halhoul overpass, on the junction of the village of al-Kharsa, and on the entrance to the refuge camp of al-Arroub.
- (ii) At 13:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of al-Tabaqa and detained a Palestinian police vehicle carrying detainees to prison in the town of al-Thahiriyyeh, but released it at a later time.

Raids:

- (i) At 16:20, the Israeli army raided the city of, set up a checkpoint and arrested 1 university student. The raid recurred at 23:00 during which the Israeli army set up a checkpoint.
- (ii) At 16:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Tafouh, searched 1 civilian house and 1 commercial store and a printing press after demolishing. In addition, the Israeli army clashed with civilians and injured 4 civilians, including 3 children.
- (iii) At 18:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Yatta and set up checkpoints at its entrances.
- (iv) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided an patrolled the town of Edna.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The civilian arrested in the city of Hebron is Eid Ahmad Eid Ziyadat.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route

that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

GAZA STRIP

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access).
- <u>Palestinian Attacks</u>: At 14:00, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.

• Closure of Crossing Points:

- (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed.
- (ii) Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is partially open to let in a limited quantity of fuel.

• Air Attacks:

- (i) at 15:40, an Israeli drone fired 1 missile targeting a vehicle carrying armed individuals in al-Zaytounah neighborhood east of the city of Gaza, and injured 4 armed civilians, including 1 armed individual who was seriously wounded.
- (ii) At 15:50, an Israeli drone fired 1 missile towards armed individuals east of al-Shuja'iya neighborhood east of the city of Gaza.
- (iii) At 17:55, an Israeli drone fired 2 missiles towards armed individuals near Karni Mintar Crossing east of the city of Gaza and killed 1 armed individual an injured 3, including 2 armed individuals who were seriously wounded.
- (iv) At 20:40, an Israeli drone fired 1 missile targeting a motorbike driven by an armed individual in al-Mansoura road in al-Shuja'iya neighborhood and injured him seriously.

• Palestinian Attacks:

- (i) At 13:30, armed individual perpetrated an armed attack against an Israeli military post near al-Shija'iya Nahal Oz Crossing on the Green Line east of the city of Gaza, and clashed with the Israeli army. The Israeli army fired tank missiles towards civilian houses and killed 5 civilians (2 brothers and 2 armed individuals, and injured 9 civilians, including 4 children and 2 armed individuals). In addition, the Israeli army incurred damage to civilian houses.
- (ii) At 18:00, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
- (iii) At 18:25, one unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
- (iv) At 19:45, one unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.

- The prisoners in the Negev detention camp pleaded human rights institutions to force the prison administration to implement an agreement with reached with the prisoners after the incidents during which prisoner Mohammad al-Ashqar died. The prisoners said that the prison administration resorts to the search policy and raids the prisons and mess up the belongings of prisoners.
- The military court at Salem detention camp issued a verdict sentencing prisoner Mahmoud Abdel Rahman Mohammad Khaled from the town of Jayyous in Qalqilya district to 38 months in jail and a fine of 2000 shekels equivalent to 560 dollars; prisoner Jamal Naji from the town of Allar in Tulkarem district to 14 months in jail and a fine of 2000 shekels equivalent to 560 dollars; prisoner Mustafa Amour from the village of Rumana for 40 days in jail and a fine of 500 shekels equivalent to 140 dollars. In addition the court extended the administrative detention of 10 prisoners.
- The Israeli military courts extended the administrative detention of 8 prisoners from Nablus, Tulkarem, Ramallah, Bethlehem, and Hebron districts for a period of tome between 3 and 6 months.
