ALL DISTRICTS	Beginning on 11 November 2004, following the official announcement of the death of Palestinian President Yasser Arafat, the Israeli army continues to impose a total closure on the West Bank, preventing civilians and workers from crossing the Green Line.

WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, deployed troops in the areas surrounding Shu'fat refugee camp, the village of 'Anata, and at the entrance to the old city of Jerusalem, and dispatched patrols, preventing civilians from other districts from accessing Al Aqsa Mosque compound due to Israeli settlers' threats to raid and attack Al Aqsa Mosque. The Israeli army also detained hundreds of civilians, allegedly for entering the city of Jerusalem without possessing the required permits. Checkpoints: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Qalandiya and An Nabi Samwil checkpoints and obstructed civilian movement. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close Ar Ram Junction leading to the town of Bir Nabala for Wall construction. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat Al Aqbat, the villages of Hizma and 'Anata, the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya, near Al Quds University, the area of Ash Shayyah, in the town of As Sawahira Ash Sharqiya, the village of Beit Surik, and in the section of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks, completely prohibiting civilians from crossing. Raid: The Israeli army raided the town of Ar Ram and searched 1 house.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Budrus, Midya, Ni'lin, Deir Qaddis, Bil'in, Saffa, Beit Liqya, and Beituniya. Flying Checkpoint: At 08:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Surda along the Ramallah-Bir Zeit road and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids/School Disruption/Physical Assault/House Occupation: At 10:05, the Israeli army raided the village of An Nabi Salih, raided the village's girl's school, beat female teachers and students, and destroyed the school gates, disrupting classes in the school. At 19:00, the Israeli army raided the city of El Bireh and detained a number of children.

Protestors demanded protection for Al Agsa Mosque. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 12:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along the Nablus-(i) Tulkarem road near the junction to the settlement of 'Einav and searched civilians and vehicles. At 15:20, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints at the entrances (ii) to the towns of Nazlat Issa and Baqa ash Sharqiya, searched civilian vehicles, and obstructed civilian movement. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Raids: (i) At 20:30, Israeli army infantry forces raided the area of Wadi al Massin between the towns of 'Illar and Kafr Ra'i and north of the village of Seida and searched the area. (ii) At 20:40, the Israeli army raided the villages of Far'un and 'Izbat Nasser and patrolled the area. At 20:40, the Israeli army raided Area (A) in the town of Bal'a, set up (iii) a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles until 21:15. TULKAREM (iv) At 22:50, Israeli army infantry forces raided Area (A) in the town of 'Illar and patrolled the area until 05:00. **Land Confiscation:** The Israeli army issued Military Order # C/77/05 confiscating 144.5 (i) dunums (36.15 acres) of land belonging to the villages of Kafr al Labad and Shufa for construction of a wall around the settlement of Avnei Hefetz. The Israeli army issued Military Order # 393 confiscating 134 dunums (ii) (33.50 acres) of land belonging to the town of Beit Lid and the villages of Kafr al Labad and Ramin for construction of a wall around the settlement of 'Einav. **Provocation of Palestinian Forces:** At 07:25, an Israeli army jeep approached the Palestinian National Security checkpoint south of the city of Tulkarem.

QALQILYA	 Flying Checkpoints: At 17:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles. At 21:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the Habla tunnel located under the Wall south of the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles. Wall Gates/School Disruption: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Wall gate to the village of 'Azzun 'Atma. Israeli troops positioned at the Wall gate searched civilians with a metal detector, delaying students and teachers from reaching their school on time. Demonstration: At 09:00, a mass demonstration and students' rally took place in the city of Qalqiliya in protest against Israeli settlers' calls to raid Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Protestors demanded protection for Al Aqsa Mosque.
NABLUS	 Flying Checkpoint: At 11:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern main entrance to the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya leading to the city of Nablus, searched civilian vehicles, and obstructed civilian movement until 13:05. Raid/House Occupation: At 05:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, occupied 1 house on the Northern Mountain, and converted it into a military post after detaining its residents. The Israeli army remains positioned in the house as of 08:00 this morning.
SALFIT	 Closure: At 17:30, the Israeli army closed the entrance to the village of Yasuf with an iron gate in place of a dirt barricade that had been erected earlier. Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the town of Deir Ballut and the village of Az Zawiya near the Green Line. Flying Checkpoints: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up several flying checkpoints along the Trans-Samaria Highway, searched civilian vehicles, and obstructed civilian movement until 14:00. Demonstration: At 09:00, a mass demonstration and students' rally took place in the city of Salfit in protest against Israeli settlers' calls to raid Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Protestors demanded protection for Al Aqsa Mosque.
JERICHO	• <u>Closure</u> : The road between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja (Road # 90) is closed with cement blocks. At various times, the Israeli army prevented civilians and Palestinians holding Israeli IDs from

	 entering the city of Jericho, permitting only Jericho and Jerusalem ID card holders access to the city. Palestinian Security Measures: On 10 April 2005, Palestinian security forces confiscated 10 illegal vehicles in the city of Jericho and handed them to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the only road leading to the village of Al Nu'man, northeast of the Bethlehem district, isolating the village and placing it, together with the adjacent village of Al Khas, under the jurisdiction of the Jerusalem municipality. The Israeli army considers the civilian presence in the villages illegal. Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall continues north of the district of Bethlehem, along 'Ayda refugee camp, along the tunnel road (Gilo) north of the city of Beit Jala, west of the village of Husan, and in the village of Al Walaja. Plving Checkpoint/Confiscation of Property: At 08:00 on 11 April 2005, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the settlement of Gush Etzion along the Hebron-Bethlehem road, detained 6 Palestinian National Security officers, and confiscated 1 military uniform. Raids/Air Patrol: At 13:00, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the town of Al 'Ubeidiya. At 00:25, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided the town again and patrolled the area. At 14:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem while Israeli army helicopters patrolled the skies over the city. At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the city again, fired sound grenades near the cemetery in 'Ayda refugee camp, and withdrew at 17:00. At 17:50, an Israeli army patrol raided the town of Al Khadr, set up a checkpoint in the centre of the town, and searched civilians and vehicles until 21:20. At 23:00, the Israeli army including 6 jeeps, raided the village of Ash Shawawra. At 00:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Ash Shawawra. At 16:00, a mass demonstration and students' rally took place in the civilian. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Ahmed Ibrahim Shakarneh in the village of Nahhalin. Demonstrations: At 14:00, a mass demonstration and students' rally took place in the city of Bethlehem in protest against Israeli settlers' cal

Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues west of the towns of Surif, Beit Ula, Idhna and Beit 'Awwa, in the area extending from the village of Deir Samit, the town of Beit 'Awwa, and towards the village of Al Burj. Demonstrations: At 10:00, a mass demonstration and students' rally took place in the city of Hebron in protest against Israeli settlers' calls to raid Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Protestors demanded protection for Al Aqsa Mosque. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians in the area of Bab az Zawiya. At 11:00, a mass demonstration took place in the town of Yatta in protest against Israeli settlers' calls to raid Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Protestors demanded protection for Al Aqsa Mosque. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians in the area of Zif, during which the Israeli army injured 1 child.
