| RAMALLAH<br>&<br>EL BIREH | <ul> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Budrus, Midya, Ni'lin, Deir Qaddis, Bil'in, Saffa, Beit Liqya, and Beituniya.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoints: <ul> <li>At 12:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Ras Karkar and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along the Ramallah-Bir Zeit road, searched civilians and vehicles, and obstructed civilian movement in both directions. | NABLUS | <ul> <li>Raids/Destruction of Property/Curfew: <ol> <li>At 08:45, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus. At 23:50, the Israeli army raided the city again and removed the license plates of a number of vehicles parked along the city streets while patrolling the area. At 03:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> <li>At 12:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Burqa, opened indiscriminate fire, imposed curfew, and withdrew at 17:30.</li> <li>At 15:50, an Israeli army tank raided the town of Beit Iba, set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Zawata, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>At 01:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Furik and arrested 2 civilians, including 1 child.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the town of Beit Furik: <ol> <li>Yousef Hassan Hanani, 16 years old; and</li> <li>Samer Hassn Hanani.</li> <li>At 17:00, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up on Za'tara junction arrested Raja Mohammed Ighbariyyeh.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>   |
| SALFIT | <ul> <li>Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to open the iron gate set up at the entrance to the village of Yasuf from morning until 18:00 only.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the town of Deir Ballut and the village of Az Zawiya near the Green Line.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoints: <ol> <li>At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint between the town of Kafr ad Dik and the village of Bruqin and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Iskaka, searched civilian vehicles, and obstructed civilian movement.</li> <li>At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Jamma'in, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li>Arrest: Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up at the entrance to the town of Jamma'in arrested Jaber 'Aref Anis.</li> <li>Settlement Activity: The Israeli army invited tenders for the construction of 50 housing units for expansion of the settlement of Elkana.</li> </ol> </li></ul> |

#### Closure: The road between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja (Road # 90) is closed with cement blocks. At various times, the Israeli army prevented Palestinian civilians holding Israeli IDs from entering the city of Jericho, permitting only Jericho and Jerusalem ID card holders access to the city. Attack on Religious Sites: At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the Shrine of **JERICHO** the Prophet Moses, searched its rooms, and examined the IDs of civilians visiting the shrine. **Settler Violence:** At 22:15, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Niran burned car tyres along Road # 90 north of the village of Al 'Auja. Palestinian Security Measures: At 12:00, Palestinian security forces confiscated 12 illegal vehicles in the city of Jericho and handed them over to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO). **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to close the only road leading to the village of Al Nu'man, northeast of the Bethlehem district, isolating the village and placing it, together with the adjacent village of Al Khas, under the jurisdiction of the Jerusalem municipality. The Israeli army considers the civilian presence in the villages illegal. Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall continues north of the district of Bethlehem, along 'Ayda refugee camp, along the tunnel road (Gilo) north of the city of Beit Jala, west of the village of Husan, and in the village of Al Walaja. Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 09:30, an Israeli army patrol raided the town of Al Khadr and set up (i) a checkpoint in centre of the town. At 15:10, the Israeli army raided the town again and set up another checkpoint in the area of Al Balou'. At 17:25, the Israeli army raided the town again, set up a checkpoint near **BETHLEHEM** 1 Palestinian National Security checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, examined civilians' IDs, and patrolled the area. At 18:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. At 16:25, an Israeli army patrol raided the town of Al 'Ubeidiya and (ii) patrolled the area. At 22:20, Israeli army infantry forces raided and patrolled the village of (iii) Ash Shawawra. The Israeli army raided the village of Nahhalin and arrested 4 civilians. (iv) **Arrests:** The Israeli army arrested 4 unidentified civilians in the village of **Settler Violence:** Israeli settlers from the settlement of Daniel in the vicinity of the town of Al Khadr uprooted over 200 olive trees and grape vines on civilian land near the settlement.

- (ii) At 22:00, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the settlement of Rafiah Yam.

| WORK<br>PERMITS        | <ul> <li>West Bank: <ol> <li>Israeli authorities renewed 11,574 work permits to cross the Green Line. The total number of those allowed to cross is unknown.</li> <li>Israeli authorities restricted the issuing of work permits to civilians who are married with children and over the age of 30.</li> <li>Gaza Strip: <ol> <li>Israeli authorities renewed 808 work permits for workers to enter the Industrial Zones. However, only 671 workers (approximately 83% of those possessing work permits) were allowed access to the Industrial Zones.</li> <li>Israeli authorities renewed 5,160 work permits for workers in the construction and agriculture sectors to cross the Green Line.
