#### WEST BANK

## The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West ALL Bank. **DISTRICTS** Since 24:00 on April 17, the Israeli army has been imposing entire closure on the West Bank and denying laborers and civilian access to the city of Jerusalem, except for humanitarian cases. The closure will go on until April 27 midnight. Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to (i) Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-(ii) Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt (iii) barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special **JERUSALEM** crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of Ma'ale (i) Adumim settlement. At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of Ramot (ii) settlement, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: (i) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Jeeb. At 00:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Anata. (ii) At 00:40, the Israeli army raided the village of Qatannah, opened fire (iii) intensively during patrol, and injured 1 civilian called Imad Mohammad Sa'id Hoshiyyeh. At 01:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Abu Dis and (iv)

#### **BETHLEHEM**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.
- Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 13:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of al-Khader and arrested 2 civilians.
- (ii) At 13:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem), and searched civilians and vehicles.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 20:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Housan and opened fire intensively during patrol.
- (ii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem and the refugee camp Dheisheh, clashed with civilians during patrol, and inured 5 civilians, including 4 children.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The 2 civilians arrested in the town of al-Khader have not been identified.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

# HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

#### Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the road of Wadi Joz, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 16:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Bani Na'im, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 01:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the town of Beit Awwa and fired illumination bombs.

#### • <u>Raids</u>:

- (i) At 08:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Yatta.
- (ii) At 10:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron. The raid recurred at 16:40 and 19:40 during which the Israeli troops occupied 1 civilian house in the area of Ras al-Jora and converted it into a military post.
- (iii) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura.
- (iv) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Majd, searched a number of civilian houses and arrested 4 civilians, including a university student.
- Arrests: The 4 civilians arrested in the village of al-Majd are:
  - (a) Bashir Ibrahim Suleiman al-Masharqa;
  - (b) Tayseer Ahmad Mahmoud Amro;
  - (c) Fadi Mohammad Mahmoud al-Shahatit; and
  - (d) Ismail Abdel Karim Amro.
- Attacks on Religious Sites: At 22:00 on April 20, the Israeli army closed the al-Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron and denied access to Moslem worshippers until the pretext of providing settlers with security on the Passover. The mosque will reopen on April 23.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 18:00, a settler ran over a child called Ahmad Ra'fat al-Titi, 6, on Bethlehem – Hebron road alongside the refugee camo of al-

- Arroub. The child was taken to an Israeli hospital for treatment.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
