## WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.</li> <li>• Since 24:00 on April 17, the Israeli army has been imposing entire closure on the West Bank and denying laborers and civilian access to the city of Jerusalem, except for humanitarian cases. The closure will go on until April 27 midnight.</li> </ul>

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of Dahiyet Beit Hanina north of the city of Jerusalem, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:25, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the village of Hizma, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of Ma'ale Adumim settlement.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> At 09:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bir Nibala.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was resumed in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to ‘Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba’ road, the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.</li> </ul>

	<p>(v) At 23:15, the Israeli army raided and combed the area located between the town of Silet al-Harithiyyeh and al-Yamon. The Israeli army withdrew at 01:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Physical Assaults:</b> At 15:30, the Israeli army stationed at the checkpoint of the village of Barta'a attacked a civilian called Ali Mahmoud Fares and caused him serious injuries. Ali was taken to Jenin Hospital for treatment.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.</li> </ul>
<b>TOUBAS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Far'a and patrolled it until 02:00.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Tayasir.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamis.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the villages of Ramin and Bazaria with dirt barricades.</li> <li>(iii) At 17:00, the Israeli army closed the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun with barbed wires.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarem-Nablus road and at Jubaa checkpoint.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> At 16:05, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the towns of 'Atil – Zeita, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Baqa al-Shariqiyyeh.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Anabta.</li> <li>(iii) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and patrolled it until 02:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Arrests:</b> At 14:20, the isreil army arrested 2 civilians under the pretext of coming close to the apartheid wall. The arrested civilians are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Tareq Zuheri Abdel Razik; and</li> <li>(b) Naser Kamal Mohammad Abu Saadah.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of ‘Azzun to the village of ‘Asla.</li> <li>(iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army closed with dirt barriers the road connecting Azzun town to Izbat Tabib village.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access. At 14:10, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint because 2 veiled female civilians refused to take of the veil. The checkpoint was reopened at a later time.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of Izbet al-Tabib.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army set up 2 checkpoints on the entrances to the villages of Jaloud and Izbet Salman.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:05, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqilya and patrolled it until 12:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:40, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Qadoum, searched 5 civilian houses, and then withdrew at 02:30.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Land leveling for Wall construction was resumed in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun.</li> </ul>
<b>NABLUS</b>	<p><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. 	<p>(iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Aqraba.</li> <li>(ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the villages of Sebastia and Ignestya.</li> <li>(iii) At 18:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Ein Shibli.</li> <li>(iv) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, searched a number of civilian houses, and occupied 1 civilian house and converted it into a military post.</li> <li>(v) The Israeli army raided the village of Arraq Bourin and clashed with civilians during patrol.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. The Israeli army withdrew at 20:45.</p> <p>(iv) At 01:55, the Israeli army raided the village of Yassouf and fired sound and illumination bombs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Attacks:</b> At 22:30, the Israeli army opened fire towards Palestinian laborers who were on their way to work inside the Green Line near the town of al-Zawiyyeh and injured a 14-year-old child called Omar Nasrallah Anees.. In addition, the Israeli army physically assaulted and injured 2 civilians.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was resumed in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> </ul>
<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Salah, set up a checkpoint and impeded traffic.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:55, the Israeli army raided the city of Beit Sahour and patrolled it until 17:20.</li> <li>(iii) At 17:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Teqoa and clashed with civilians during patrol. The Israeli army withdrew at 19:10.</li> <li>(iv) At 22:20, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Khader and arrested 4 civilians, including 1 military officer.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(v) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem and patrolled it until 04:30.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> The 4 civilians arrested in the town of al-Khader are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Military officer Raed Mohammad Suleiman Salah;</li> <li>(b) Mahmoud Ali Mohammad Issa;</li> <li>(c) Khalil Aref Mohammad Salah; and</li> <li>(d) Majdi Marzouk Issa.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:00, a bunch of settlers from Bitar 'Illit settlement attacked 6 civilians, including 2 female civilians, from the village of Housan.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:00, a bunch of settler from Bitar 'Illit settlement attempted to stab a civilian called Awad Abdel Aziz Sabatin from the village of Housan.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was resumed in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.</li> </ul>
<b>HEBRON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.</li> <li>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.</li> <li>(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

The checkpoint was set up at second time at 15:40 and the Israeli army and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of al-Fawwar. The checkpoint was set up for a second time at 21:20 and the Israeli army searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron and set up a checkpoint in the area of Nimra. The raid recurred at 17:45 during which the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near Hebron University and arrested 1 military officer and confiscated a revolver from him.</li> <li>(ii) At 15:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Thahiriyyeh.</li> <li>(iii) At 18:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of al-Tabaqa.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> The civilian arrested in the city of Hebron is ‘Aref Hashem al-Hidmi.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was resumed in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.</li> </ul>

## GAZA STRIP
