#### WEST BANK

#### ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

## • <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.
- Raids: At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Abu Dis, and set up a checkpoint.

#### • Arrests:

- (i) At 12 on April 28, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians during a raid into the town of al-Izariyyeh. The arrested civilians are:
  - (a) Mohammad Falah Khalaf;
  - (b) Mohammad Omar Abu Ziyad; and
  - (c) Hassan Khaled Mobarak Khalaf.
- (ii) At 13:00 on April 28, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians during a raid into the town of Abu Dis. The arrested civilians are:
  - (a) Mohammad Jamil Erekat;
  - (b) Abdel Karim Younis; and
  - (c) Mohammad Allan Shqeir.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (a) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (b) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the

- <u>Raids</u>: At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Askar, searched a number of civilian houses, arrested 29 civilians including 2 military officers, and then withdrew at 05:00.

HEBRON	Closure:     (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city

of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.

(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the town of Halhoul overpass, and searched civilians and vehicles
- (ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area of Abu Sneineh in the old city of Hebron.

#### Raids:

- (i) At 11:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron, and set up a checkpoint in the area of al-Hiriyyeh. The raid recurred at 01:20 during which the Israeli troops searched a sewing workshop affiliated with the Islamic Society and confiscated sewing machines, and issued n order to close the workshop for 3 years.
- (ii) At 11:55, the Israeli army raided the area of Zif east the town of Yatta and searched a number of civilian houses.
- (iii) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Sammou'.
- Arrests: At 02:30 on April 29, the Israeli army arrested during a raid into

- the town of Surif a civilian called Ahmad Mousa Abdallah Hmeidat.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 20:30, a bunch if extremist settlers in the old city of Hebron stoned civilian houses, damaged the windshields of 8 civilian vehicles and stole 15 car plates.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

#### Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access). Raids: Since 05:30 on April 28, the Israeli army has been raiding the town of Beit Hanoun and northeast the town of Beit Lahia, opened fire intensively and fired tank missiles towards civilian houses. Moreover, Israeli troops searched a number of civilian houses, clashed with armed individuals and arrested 30 civilians. The Israeli army also razed agricultural land and then withdrew at 11:00. Attacks: At 20:00, the Israeli army opened fire from its posts inside the Green Line towards north of the tow of Beit Lahia. Arrests: The 30 civilians arrested in the town of Beit Hanoun have not been **NORTHERN** identified. GAZA **Palestinian Attacks**: At 09:00, nine unidentified mortars were fired towards the (i) Green Line. At 13:00, one unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green (ii) At 17:00, three unidentified mortars were fired towards the (iii) Green Line.
