| ALL<br>DISTRICTS | Since 22 March 2004, the Israeli army has imposed a total closure over the West Bank and Gaza Strip. The Israeli army prevented civilians from crossing the Green Line and entering Jerusalem and restricted movement between cities in the West Bank. |  |

The Israeli army considers the civilian's presence in the villages illegal.  • Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall was resumed north of the district of Bethlehem, west of Wadi Hilwa, along 'Ayda refugee camp, along the tunnel road (Gilo), along road # 60 towards the village of Husan, Bir 'Ona and the village of Al Walaja.  • Land Confiscation: The Israeli army distributed notices to evacuate 50 dunums (12.5 acres) of agricultural land belonging to 3 civilians in the village of Husan, claiming that the land is in close proximity to the Wall.  • Raids:  (i) At 14:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem. At 20:30, the Israeli army raided the village again, patrolled the area, and withdrew at 23:00.</li> <li>At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Ramin and arrested 2 civilians.</li> <li>At 19:10, and again at 22:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and its suburbs and opened indiscriminate fire. #### • Attacks:

- (i) At 23:10, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location at Point 6 on the Egyptian border towards civilian houses in Al Barazil neighbourhood, injuring 1 female civilian.
- (ii) At 07:00, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location at the Rafah Crossing towards the Gaza International Airport, injuring 1 employee working at the Airport.
- Raid: At 02:00, the Israeli army, including several tanks and bulldozers, raided 120 meters into Al Sha'ut neighbourhood and opened intensive fire. Israeli army helicopters patrolled the skies over the area. The Israeli army demolished 5 civilian houses and withdrew from the area at 07:15.
- <u>Arrest</u>: At 18:35, the Israeli army arrested Anis Mohammed Zalmat at the Rafah Crossing as he was returning home from Egypt.
- <u>House Demolition:</u> The Israeli army demolished 5 civilian houses in Al Sha'ut neighbourhood belonging to:
  - (i) Suleiman 'Ayyash;
  - (ii) Bassam 'Awwad;
  - (iii) Mohammed 'Adel Ar Rabi';
  - (iv) Yousef Ar Rabi'; and
  - (v) Kamal Abu Zahri.

#### **GENERAL**

#### West Bank: (i) The Israeli authorities renewed work permits to cross the Green Line for 4.639 workers. The total number of those allowed to cross is The Israeli authorities continue to refuse to renew work permits for (ii) workers in the district of Jericho to cross the Green Line. (iii) The Israeli authorities restricted the issuing of work permits to civilians over the age of 35, married and with children. WORK Gaza Strip: **PERMITS** (i) The Israeli authorities renewed work permits to cross into the Industrial Zones for 1,140 workers; however, only 115 workers, 11% of the total number of permits issued, were permitted to enter the area. The Israeli authorities renewed work permits to cross the Green Line (ii) for 4,330 workers; however, only 1,179 workers, 28% of the total number of permits issued, were permitted to cross the Green Line. The Israeli authorities permitted 1,862 workers to remain overnight (iii) inside the Green Line.
