DISTRICT	EVENT
ALL DISTRICTS	 Beginning on 15 August 2005, the Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure over the district of Jenin and the Gaza Strip and declare them closed military zones. The Israeli army prevented civilians and workers from entering the city of Jerusalem or crossing the Green Line in order to evacuate 4 Israeli settlements in the district of Jenin and evacuate settlements and withdraw from the Gaza Strip.

WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and set up several checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and in the area surrounding Al Aqsa Mosque compound, preventing civilians under the age of 45 from accessing Al Aqsa Mosque to perform prayers. The Israeli army also used a surveillance balloon, equipped with cameras, to observe worshippers in Al Aqsa Mosque. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and An Nabi Samwil checkpoints, impeding civilian access. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the village of 'Anata checkpoint and prevent civilians from crossing in both directions. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, and in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina. Raid: The Israeli army raided the village of Hizma and fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades while patrolling the area. Settler Violence: On 18 August 2005, a group of Israeli settlers closed the main road between the town of Ar Ram and the village of Jaba' and threw vehicle oil on the road.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, and in the town of Beituniya. Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along the Ramallah-Bir Zeit road, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded access to vehicles leaving the city of Ramallah.

Closure of Settlement Evacuation Areas: (i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Israeli settlements slated for evacuation in the district of Jenin. The Israeli army also designated alternate roads, including detour routes, connecting towns and villages to the city of Jenin for civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the main entrance to the town of 'Arraba with cement blocks. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate set up in the vicinity of the village of Imreiha south of the town of Ya'bad along the road connecting the districts of Jenin and Tulkarem and to deny civilian access in both directions. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close Al Jalama Commercial Crossing, preventing civilians from crossing. The Israeli army opened Salim Crossing as an alternative, which will be open 3 days a week from 09:00 until 13:00. (v) The Israeli army continues to restrict civilian access (except for humanitarian cases) to Um ar Rihan (Shaked) gate to 3 hours daily from 07:00–08:00, 13:00–14:00, and 17:00–18:00. TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate set up at the junction to the settlement of 'Einav along the Tulkarem-Nablus road, preventing civilians from crossing in both directions. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces/House Occupation: At 08:40, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Tulkarem, took position in front of the city's Palestinian Police station, and examined the IDs of Palestinian Police officers. At 09:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area of 'Illar plain and the towns of Zeita and 'Attil. At 22:55, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bal'a. The Israeli army also combed the area surrounding the town. At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Deir al Ghusun, raided 2 houses, converted them into military posts, and searched another house. Arrests: On 17 August 2005, the Israeli army arrested Omar Khalil ash Shar'ab, a Palestinian National Security officer, during its raid on the city of Tulkarem. On 17 August 2005, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians during its raid on Nur Shams refugee camp: Mohammed Ahmed Muqbel; and Raed Fayez Sha'ban. Settler Violence: At 19:15, a group of Israeli settlers attempted to raid the town of 'Anabta and assaulted 2 civilians (husband and wife), along the road connecting the villages of Ramin and Bizzariya.
QALQILYA	 Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and search civilians with a metal detector. Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the village of Immatin and in the area east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Al Funduq and searched civilians and vehicles. Arrest: On 17 August 2005, Israeli troops positioned at a checkpoint set up along the Qalqiliya-Nablus main road arrested Ahmed Mahmoud 'Uweisat,

(i)	At 14:40, a group of Israeli settlers threw stones at a number of civilian vehicles travelling in the vicinity of the village of Jinsafut.
(ii)	At 15:30, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Kedumim threw stones at civilian vehicles travelling along the main road near the settlement, damaging vehicles.
(iii)	At 19:30, an Israeli settler, travelling on a motorcycle, threw a Molotov cocktail at Palestinian owned greenhouses in the vicinity of the village of An Nabi Elyas, setting fire to 1 greenhouse and damaging crops cultivated within it.
(iv)	At 20:30, a group of Israeli settlers gathered at the entrance to the village of 'Azzun 'Atma and threw stones and Molotov cocktails a civilian vehicles, setting fire to 1 vehicle.
• (Closure of Main Roads:
(i)	At 09:00, the Israeli army closed the detour route connecting the town of 'Anabta and the village of Bizzariya.
(ii)	At 22:30, the Israeli army closed the road between the junction to the village of Jit and the city of Tulkarem until further notice.
• <u>R</u>	Tying Checkpoints: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along A Badhan road east of the city of Nablus and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: At 22:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area of Khallet a Amud in the city of Nablus.

- (ii) At 21:40, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Bracha gathered in the vicinity of the village of Kafr Qalil, burned vehicle tyres, and opened fire towards the village. Israeli settlers also verbally assaulted civilians. The Israeli army evacuated the settlers.
- (iii) At 21:50, a group of Israeli settlers set fire to 5 civilian vehicles near the village of Burin.
- Palestinian Attack: At 21:10, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire from the village of Kafr Qalil towards 1 Israeli army patrol travelling along the main road between the city of Nablus and the town of Huwwara. The Israeli army responded by opening fire towards the village.

SALFIT	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the main northwestern entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current Intifada (Uprising). Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various times in the morning, impeding civilian movement. The Israeli army closed Za'tara checkpoint, preventing civilians from crossing in both directions. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat near the Green Line, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the villages of Marda and Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. Raids/Air Patrol/Detention: At 17:20, the Israeli army raided and combed the area between the town of Marda and the settlement of Ari'el. At 21:30, Israeli troops, dispatched from Israeli army helicopters, raided the area between the towns of Bruqin and Kafr ad Dik, set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Bruqin, and searched civilians and vehicles until 01:00. At 23:15, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the town of Marda, detained Sadeq al Khuffash, the Chairman of Marda Municipality, and released him at 01:00. Settler Violence: At 16:30, groups of Israeli settlers threw stones at civilian vehicles travelling along the Trans-Samaria Highway.
JERICHO	 Closure: The road between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja (Road # 90) is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to prevent farmers not holding Jericho IDs from reaching their agricultural land, forcing them to apply for access permits. At various times, the Israeli army also impeded civilian movement into the city of Jericho. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus, impeding civilian access. Arrests: Israeli troops positioned at Al Karamah (Allenby) Bridge arrested 2 civilians from the city of Tulkarem as they were returning from Jordan: Bara' ad Dadu; and Samer Di'bas.

The Israeli army considers civilians' residence in the village illegal. <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala.

- <u>Attack/Injury</u>: At 23:15, the Israeli army opened fire towards Palestinian territory near Point 27 on the Green Line northeast of the town of Beit

	 Hanun, critically injuring Isam'il at Tarabin. Palestinian Attack: At 00:05, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Roads: (i) Ash Shuhada' – Netzarim Junction remains closed. (ii) Ash Shuhada' Junction - Al Muntar (Karnei) Crossing road is closed.
CENTRAL GAZA	Activities not reported.
KHAN YUNIS	 Closure of Main Roads: Abu Al 'Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) is closed. Western road (Khan Yunis) is closed. Morag road, connecting Khan Yunis' eastern and western roads, is closed. Deir al Balah junction to Abu Holi checkpoint (Kfar Darom road) is closed. Abu Holi road is closed. At 22:00, the Israeli army closed Salah ad Din road between Al Matahin and Abu Holi checkpoints, preventing civilians from crossing. Curfew: At 14:20, the Israeli army imposed curfew over the area of Al Mawasi Khan Yunis. Raid/House Occupations: At 02:00, Israeli army infantry forces raided Palestinian territory near Point 6.5 in the city of Khan Yunis, occupied a number of houses, and converted them into military posts. Arrests: At 10:35, the Israeli army arrested Ala' Hasan al Lahham in the area of Al Mawasi/Khan Yunis. At 12:30, the Israeli army arrested 'Imad 'Ayesh ash Sha'er in the area of al Mawasi/Khan Yunis. At 11:00, 1 mortar was fired towards the settlement of Morag. At 11:10, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards At Tuffah checkpoint along Al Mawasi/Khan Yunis road. At 22:20, 2 mortars were fired towards an Israeli army military post west of Al Amal neighbourhood in the city of Khan Yunis. At 22:30, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the settlement of Ganei Tal.

• <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed.
- (ii) Rafah Crossing is closed to Palestinian civilians under the age of 35.
- (iii) Al Mawasi/Rafah road is closed.
- <u>Curfew</u>: At 14:20, the Israeli army imposed curfew over the area of Al Mawasi/Rafah.

POLITICAL PRISONERS

RAFAH

• Conditions of Political Prisoners: Political prisoners' cells in Ad Damon Prison are overcrowded and improperly ventilated. Over 12 prisoners are held in 1 cell designed to hold only 8 prisoners. The Israeli Prison administration reduced the period of time political prisoners are permitted to go out into the prison yard from 1 hour to half an hour. The Prison administration also supplies prisoners with contaminated water. Additionally, ill prisoners have not received timely medical treatment.
