### **Flying Checkpoints:** At 09:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area (i) between the town of Bal'a and the village of Al Atara and searched civilians and vehicles. At 09:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction to (ii) the settlement of Einav, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilians' movement. Raids: (i) At 08:45, an Israeli army helicopter dispatched nfantry troops near the At 21:00, Israeli Special Forces raided the town of 'Anabta and (ii) opened indiscriminate fire. At 24:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and its suburbs, (iii) raided 1 print shop, confiscated a large quantity of printing paper and folders, and withdrew at 03:00. Air Patrol: At 15:20, an Israeli army reconnaissance aircraft patrolled the skies over the city of Tulkarem and its suburbs. **Closure:** The Israeli army set up dozens of flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Raid/Curfews: Beginning at 04:00 on 16 August 2004, the Israeli army remains positioned in the city of Nablus and 'Ein Beit El Ma refugee camp and continues to impose curfew on the old city of Nablus and 'Ein **NABLUS** Beit El Ma refugee camp. The Israeli army searched civilian houses and remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning. Injuries as a Result of UXO: At 10:30, an Israeli army UXO exploded near an oil factory in the city of Nablus as 2 children were playing with the object, injuring and burning both children: (iii) Iyad Jamal Al Madani, 14 years old (in critical condition); and Baha' Isma'il Al Madani, 12 years old. (iv) **Closure:** The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. **HEBRON** Raid: The Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, occupied 1 civilian building under construction, and converted it into a military post. Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, **QALQILYA** and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact

#### **Closure:** (i) Abu Al 'Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) is closed. Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. (ii) Al Mawasi/Khan Yunis road (Al Tuffah checkpoint) is partially open (iii) to pedestrians only. Abu Holi road is partially open. At 15:00, the Israeli army closed (iv) Salah ad Din road at Abu Holi checkpoint and opened fire towards civilians, injuring 2 civilians. The road was reopened at 06:00. Attack: At 09:00, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from the Mahfutha military post towards civilian houses in the area of Al Qarara, injuring 1 civilian. Raids: (i) At 14:30, the Israeli army raided the area of Abu Al 'Ajin, north of the city of Khan Yunis, occupied several houses, and converted them into military posts. The Israeli army forced civilians between the ages of **KHAN YUNIS** 16 and 50 to evacuate their homes, assemble in a yard, and then interrogated them. At 23:20, the Israeli army, including several tanks and bulldozers (ii) supported by helicopters, raided the area of Al Barabkha in West Khan Yunis refugee camp, opened intensive fire, inuring 2 civilians, demolished 6 houses, and withdrew at 02:30. **House Demolitions:** The Israeli army demolished 6 houses in the area of Al Barabkha in West Khan Yunis refugee camp, belonging to: Ali Abu Shammaleh; (i) (ii) Hamdan Abu Al Luli: (iii) Abdullah Az Zarabi; Fat'hi Az Zarabi; (iv) Moahmmed Az Zarabi; and (v) (vi) Mousa Abu Rizq. **Closure:** (i) The Gaza International Airport remains closed. (ii) The Rafah Crossing is partially open to civilians under 16 years old and above 35 years old only. The Sufa Crossing is partially open to construction cargo only. (iii) Attack: At 14:30, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location at Point 8 on the Egyptian border towards civilian houses in the **RAFAH** neighbourhood of Yabna in Rafah refugee camp, killing 1 civilian and injuring 1 child. At 20:50, the Israeli army opened fire again, killing 1 elderly civilian. **Killings:** The Israeli army killed 2 civilians in the neighbourhood of Yabna in Rafah refugee camp: Mohammed Abdullah Al Hamayidah, 65 years old; and (i) Ahmed Abdul Fattah Al Hams. (ii)

### **GENERAL**

### Beginning on 15 August 2004, and for the 7<sup>th</sup> consecutive days, political prisoners in all Israeli prisons, including female prisoners in Ar Ramla and **HUNGER STRIKE IN** Nitsat Prisons and child prisoners in Telmond Prison, continue to conduct an **ALL ISRAELI** open-ended huger strike in protest against the harsh conditions of imprisonment imposed by the Israeli Prisons Services. 4,000 political prisoners **PRISONS** in Israeli central prisons continue to participate in the hunger strike. **Israeli Pressure on Political Prisoners:** The administration of the Nafha Prison confiscated all political (i) prisoners clothing, leaving each political prisoner with only one set of **POLITICAL** clothing. The prison administration also confiscated all kitchen **PRISONERS** utensils and transferred dozens of prisoners from one prison section and cell to another inside the prison. (ii) In an attempt to suppress and end political prisoner's open-ended hunger strike, the administration of Bir as Sabe' Prison isolated 20 political prisoners.
