DISTRICT EVENT

WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: At 11:00, the Israeli army closed the city of Jerusalem completely for a number of hours. The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. Additionally, the Israeli army combed the area alongside the apartheid Wall as a result of heated alarms of a suicide attack in the city.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (a) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (b) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (c) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.

JERUSALEM

Checkpoints:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 15:30, the Israeli army closed Qalandya military checkpoint and denied civilian access. In addition, the Israeli army opened fire towards armed individuals. The checkpoint was reopened at a later time.
- (iii) At 15:30, the Israeli army closed Rafat checkpoint and the checkpoint that is set up near the village of Jaba', and impeded traffic until 16:40.
- <u>Raids</u>: The Israeli army raided the suburb of Beit Hanina north of the city of Jerusalem, arrested a house and arrested a military officer from the Palestinian intelligence.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The military officer arrested in the city of Jerusalem is Hazem Abdeen.
- <u>House Demolition</u>: The Israeli army demolished a house in the village of Sur Baher that belongs to Ahmad Atwan, under the pretext of unlicensed coinstruction.

	 Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
RAMALLAH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. Checkpoints: At 10:00, the Israeli army closed the checkpoints set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and impeded civilian access. Flying Checkpoints: At 13:45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance of the city of Silwad, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 20:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Bitzeit, set up a checkpoint at the junction of Birzeit University and impeded traffic. At 01:50, the Israeli army raided the city of al-Bireh. In addition, the Israeli army searched one house and then withdrew at 03:00. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. Flying Checkpoints: At 07:00, the Israeli army set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances to the towns of Ya'bed and Mithelon, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Zababdeh. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Tayaseer checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.

	• Raids: At 02:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Iqaba, searched one civilian house and arrested one pupil.
	• <u>Arrests</u> : The pupil arrested in the town of Iqaba is Sameh Ibrahim Sawafta, 17.
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamish. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city). At 17:00, the Israeli army denied civilians between the age of 16 and 35 access through the 'Einav checkpoints: At 21:00, the Israeli army set up two checkpoints at the entrance of the suburb of Shweiki in the city of Tulkarem, and between the towns of Deir al-Ghusun and 'Ateel, and searched civilians and vehicles until 01:00. Raids: At 18:10, the Israeli army raided the suburb of Iktaba in the city if Tulkarem and patrolled it until 18:40. At 20:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the suburb if Shweiki in the city of Tulkarem and the village of al-Jaroushiyyeh. At 22:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Anabta Arrests: The Israeli army arrested university student Baha' Faheem Shamsneh at Jabara checkpoint. Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
QALQILYA	 Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun as well as the road that connects the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Izbat at Tabib. The Israeli army continues to close with cement barricades the entrances to the village of Kfar Qaddoum, Hijjeh, Imatin, Baqa al-Hatab, al-Fundoq, and Izbat al-Tabib that connects them to the main Qalqilya-Nablus road. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun with an iron gate. Checkpoints: Since 09:00 on December 2, the Israeli army has been closing restrictions at the checkpoint set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya, denying civilian access and impeding traffic. The checkpoint was reopened at 16:20 on December 3.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 17:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun.
- (ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the village of al-Nabi Elias, and searched civilians and vehicles until 20:30.

• Raids:

- (i) At 17:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqilya, and patrolled it until 18:15.
- (ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Nabi Elias and searched a number of houses.
- (iii) At 20:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Droum and imposed curfew until 05:00.
- (iv) The Israeli army raided the village of Jinasaphot and searched a carpentry workshop.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 2:35, a bunch of settlers tried to enter the village of Kafr Qaddoum and attack civilian houses. At once the Israeli army intervened and evacuated the settlers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Land leveling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al-Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.

• <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:

- (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.
- (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.
- (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.

NABLUS

	 Flying Checkpoints: At 12:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of Yitzhar settlement and impeded traffic under the pretext of finding a suspicious object until 13:20. Raids: At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, besieged and searched one building, and arrested one civilian. The raid recurred at 06:00 and the Israeli remains there until the time this report is being prepared. Arrests: On December 2, the Israeli army arrested 2 university students during a raid in the city of Nablus. The students are: Majdi Muntaser Daoud; and Mahmoud Ghanem The civilian arrested in the city of Nablus is Mohammad Qanaze'.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr al-Dik. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tarah checkpoints and to deny civilian access. At 13:10, the Israeli army closed Za'tarah checkpoint and opened it at 13:40. Flying Checkpoints: The Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Kafl Hares, and searched civilians and vehicles. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ari'el.
JERICHO	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. Raids: At 22:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Jericho and patrolled it until 23:30.
BETHLEHEM	• Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing

civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahour and Bethlehem.

- <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: At 18:00, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at al-container checkpoint and impeded traffic.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the north-western entrance to the city of Beit Jala.
- (ii) At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area of al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem), detained a police officer and released him at a later time. The checkpoint was set up again at 23:10 and the Israeli army searched civilians and vehicles until 01:30.

Raids:

- (i) At 09:45, the Israeli army raided the village of Marah Barah and arrested 3 civilians.
- (ii) At 10:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar and arrested three civilian brothers.

• Arrests:

- (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army arrested at al-container checkpoint civilian Khaled Fouad Mahmoud al-Barbari.
- (ii) The 3 civilians arrested in the village if Marah Rabah are:
- (a) Malek Ahmad Omar al-Sheikh;
- (b) Baker Ali Qassem al-Sheikh; and
- (c) Ibrahim Youssef Ibrahim al-Sheikh.
- <u>Attacks on Property</u>: On November 29, the Israel army handed an order to stop the construction of an unlicensed house in the village of Nahalin. The house belongs to Saadi Abdel Rahman Najajreh.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

• Closure:

(i)

HEBRON

The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.

(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the area of al-Nabi Younis.
- (ii) At 12:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit 'Ummar, and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided the refuge camp of al-Arroub and arrested 4 civilians.
- (ii) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided the area of al-Fahs in the city of Hebron, dismantled water pipelines, and arrested 2 civilian brothers.
- (iii) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the areas of the suburb of al-Zaytoun and Wadi Abu Kteileh in the city of Hebron, set up a number of checkpoints at junctions of internal roads, searched a number of houses, and arrested one civilian in the area of Abu Kteileh.
- (iv) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Thahiriyyeh.
- (v) The Israeli army raided the town of Edna and arrested one military officer.

Prisoners' Conditions

- The Israeli military court at Salem detention camp issued a verdict sentencing against 9 Palestinian prisoners for terms of 14 to 56 months as well as the payment of 2000 NIS to 4000 NIS each. Ion addition, the court delayed looking into 13 prisoner cases.
- The Israeli Central Court in Jerusalem issued a verdict sentencing Hamdi Qaraan for life imprisonment term and charged him of killing minister Rehavan Zeevi.
- The Israeli military court in the Negev extended the administrative detention of Muath Ziyad Hamed for three more months. In addition, the court is still detaining his father whose detention has been extended four times.
