WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 <u>Closure</u>: The city of Jerusalem remains closed to residents from other districts. The Israeli army continues to impose a strict closure on the West Bank and Gaza Strip. <u>Separation Wall Construction</u>: Construction of the separation wall continues in Al Shayyah, Abu Dis, and Al Sawahira.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 House Demolition: The Israeli army demolished a house and storehouse belonging to Mahmoud Zawahra. Attack: At 21:15, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from the area of Qalandiya airport towards civilian houses near El Bireh city. Raids: At 10:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr 'Ein, searched the house of Mahmoud Al Rifa'i and physically assaulted his wife, Amal Al Rifa'i, who is 8 months pregnant. She was later hospitalized. At 11:15, and again at 12:40, several Israeli jeeps raided the cities of Ramallah and El Bireh. At 11:30, Israeli jeeps raided the towns of Deir Ghassana, Beit Rima and the village of Kafr 'Ein. At 18:15, and again at 02:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Deir Ghassana. At 19:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Rima and fired sound bombs. The Israeli army raided the town of Silwad, demolished 1 house and 1 livestock barn. The Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Malik and imposed curfew. Settlement Activity: The Israeli authorities continue to fence the parameters of the settlement of Hallamish. The fence cuts into land belonging to residents of the neighboring village of Deir Nidham.
JENIN	 <u>Closure</u>: The city of Jenin remains a closed military area. <u>Separation Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits which are based on no specific criteria. This Israeli closure continues to harm the education process since teachers, amongst others, are not granted access through the gates, particularly in areas located behind the separation wall.

(i) At 10:30, the Israeli army opened fire towards school students in	the

• Raid: At 07:50, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided the area of	f Al
Rashayda, southeast Bethlehem, searched several houses and detained	

	civilians outside in the cold.
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army closed the Enav and Al Kafriyat separation wall gates, isolating Tulkarem from the districts of Qalqiliya and Nablus. Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits which are based on no specific criteria. This Israeli closure continues to harm the education process since teachers, amongst others, are not granted access through the gates, particularly in areas located behind the separation wall. Raids: At 11:35, and again at 18:30, the Israeli army raided the city, closed all main streets, opened fire and raided an elementary school. Air Patrol: Israeli reconnaissance aircraft continue to patrol the skies over Tulkarem city since early this morning.
NABLUS	 Closure: (i) Nablus remains a closed military area. (ii) The Israeli army sealed off the towns of Huwwara and Beit Furik and the villages of Beit Iba, Sarra and Till. Incursion: After partially withdrawing yesterday, the Israeli army reoccupied the city of Nablus and its refugee camps, imposed curfew over its western neighborhoods, used explosives to break through several houses in the old city, searched houses, arrested 2 civilians, including 1 child, occupied a male student dormitory and converted it into a military post after evacuating and arresting all students in the dormitory, and continue to detain women and children outside as of 08:00 this morning. Raids: (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Furik, imposed curfew, opened intensive fire near a school, evacuated students from the school, searched the houses of 2 martyrs from Al Hannani family, destroyed furniture and personal property in the houses and severely beat the occupants of the house. (ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Burqa, searched 2 houses and arrested 2 civilians. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians from Nablus city: (i) Mahmoud Al Zakari, 16 years old; and (ii) Ala Abu al Reesh, from 'Ein Beit Ma' refugee camp. The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians from the village of Burqa: (iii) Mahmoud Salah, 20 years old; and (iv) Tamer Dighlis, 18 year old. Destruction of Property: The Israeli army destroyed using explosives a vehicle belonging to Basil Hannani in the town of Beit Furik.

HEBRON	 Land Leveling: Israeli bulldozers continue to level land belonging to Palestinian civilians near the settlements of Kiryat Arba and Harsina in order to expand and build a wall around the two settlements. Raid: The Israeli army raided the village of Al Tabaqa, searched several houses and arrested 2 brothers. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 brothers from Al Tabaqa village: Fu'ad Al Hureibat, 23 years old; and his brother Muhammad Al Hureibat, 17 year old. Settler Violence: Israeli settlers severely beat Samir Issa Hunehin in the old city of Hebron.
QALQILYA	 <u>Separation Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits which are based on no specific criteria. This Israeli closure continues to harm the education process since teachers, amongst others, are not granted access through the gates, particularly in areas located behind the separation wall. <u>Raid</u>: At 19:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Jit and imposed curfew.
SALFIT	 Raid: At 00:50, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the city of Salfit, took position in the eastern neighborhood and remained there for 5 hours. Air Patrol: At 17:00, Israeli reconnaissance aircraft patrolled the skies over Salfit city. Detention: At 20:00, the Israeli army closed Al Zawiya bridge and detained dozens of civilians. The civilians were released and allowed to return to their villages at 22:00 after interventions from the US consulate.

GAZA STRIP

NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure</u>: The Erez crossing is partially open to workers. <u>Attack</u>: At 10:35, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from Point 34 to the east of the town of Beit Hanoun. <u>Air Patrol</u>: At 12:45, Israeli military aircraft patrolled the skies over the district.
GAZA CITY	Closure: Al Shuhada' junction remains closed.

House Demolitions: (i) The Israeli army demolished a house east of the city of Deir Balah. **CENTRAL** The Israeli army demolished a small house near Kfar Daroom. (ii) GAZA Land Leveling/Attack: At 16:15, Israeli bulldozers, supported by 1 tank, leveled lands near the settlement of Kfar Daroom in preparation for expansion north of the settlement, demolished a small house and opened intensive fire towards nearby houses. **Closure:** Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. (i) (ii) Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. Abu Holi road is partially opened. (iii) Land Leveling: At 11:30, Israeli bulldozers leveled land 10 meters into **KHAN YUNIS** Palestinian territory near Al Amal neighborhood. **Attacks:** At 11:10, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from Points 9, 10, and (i) 12 towards civilian houses in the neighborhoods of Al Amal and Al Namsawi and West Khan Yunis refugee camp. At 15:30, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from Points 8, 9,10,11 (ii) and 12 towards civilian houses in the neighborhoods of Al Amal and Al Namsawi and West Khan Yunis refugee camp. **Closure:** Sufa crossing remains partially open to merchants and workers. **Land Leveling/Destruction of Property:** The Israeli army leveled land near the village of Oraybe and demolished 2 green houses. **Raid:** At 04:00, the Israeli army, including several tanks and helicopters, **RAFAH** raided the area of Al Shoka near the Rafah border and arrested 4 civilians. **Air Patrol:** At 03:15, Israeli aircraft patrolled the skies over the district. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in Al Shoka: (i) Fathi Abu Jarrad; Iyadi Abu Jarrad; (ii) Sa'id Abu Shuluf; and (iii) Mustafa Abu Shuluf. (iv)
