ALL DISTRICTS	• In accordance with military order # 5766/06 and effective on 03 February 2006, the Israeli army continues to designate the following passage points for the use of Palestinian civilians holding West Bank identity cards, including those who hold permits, "who exit the area to Israel and those who enter from Israel into the area," though most of these are located inside Occupied Palestinian Territory. All are located along the path of the Wall or its approved route:  1. Gilboa (Al Jalama); 2. Reihan; 3. Eyal (northern Qalqilya); 4. Sha'ar Efrayim (Irtah); 5. Makabim (Beit Sira); 6. Atarot (Qalandiya); 7. Shuafat Refugee Camp; 8. Hasidim (Az Zayem); 9. Rahel (Bethlehem); 10. Tarkumia; 11. Meytar (Shim'a)

# WEST BANK

<ul> <li>Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and has set up checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound.</li> <li>Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to Dahiyat Bir Nabala northwest of the city of Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and Beit Iksa checkpoints and to impede civilian access.</li> <li>Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, around the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim, and west of the village of Al Jib.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to 'Atarot Industrial Zone in Dahiyat ar Ram and searched civilian vehicles.</li> <li>Raids: <ol> <li>The Israeli army raided Qalandiya refugee camp, opened indiscriminate fire, and searched a number of houses.</li> <li>The Israeli army raided the village of Qatanna and arrested 2 civilians.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Qatanna:</li> </ul>

#### • Wall Land Confiscation:

- (i) The Israeli army issued Military Order # T/21/06 to confiscate 128.7 *dunums* (32.175 acres) of land belonging to the village of Beit Hanina for Wall construction.
- (ii) The Israeli army issued Military Order # T/20/06 to confiscate 29.5 dunums (7.375 acres) of land belonging to the village of Bir Nabala for Wall construction.
- Palestinian Attack: At 14:00, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards Israeli troops positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint. Consequently, the Israeli army opened indiscriminate fire and closed the checkpoint, denying civilian access. At 14:30, the Israeli army reopened the checkpoint.

# • <u>Closure of Main Road</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil with dirt barricades.

• Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud.

#### • Raids:

- (i) On 05 February 2006, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Mughayyir and arrested 2 civilians.
- (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh.
- (iii) At 13:40, the Israeli army, including 20 jeeps, raided the town of Silwad, searched a number of houses, and arrested 13 civilians, including 1 child. At 04:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.
- (iv) The Israeli army raided the village of 'Ajjul and arrested 1 civilian.
- Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Al Mughayyir:

JENIN	<ul> <li>Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and to impede civilian access.</li> <li>Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoints: The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints at the northern entrances to the town of Tubas and the village of 'Aqqaba and searched civilians and civilians.</li> <li>Raids/Detention: <ol> <li>Beginning at 20:00 on 05 February 2006, the Israeli army has remained positioned in the village of Kafr Dan and continues to close its entrances with checkpoints, preventing civilians from entering or exiting the village. The Israeli army also searched a number of houses, arrested 4 civilians (members of 1 family), occupied Ar Rabi' Park, and converted it into a military post. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.</li> <li>At 10:05, and again at 02:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin, searched 1 building after detaining residents outside, and withdrew at 05:00.</li> <li>Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in the village of Kafr Dan:</li> <li>Mustafa 'Ashour;</li> <li>Mohammed Mustafa 'Ashour;</li> <li>'Ameed Mustafa 'Ashour; and</li> <li>Nour Mustafa 'Ashour.</li> </ol> </li></ul>
TULKAREM	<ul> <li>Closure: The Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure on the district of Tulkarem and to declare it a closed military zone following a suicide attack carried out on the junction to the village of Far'un. The Israeli army continues to impede civilian access to and from the district.</li> <li>Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the town of Bal'a to Dahiyat Iktaba with dirt barricades.</li> <li>Checkpoints: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up near the settlement of 'Einav on the road connecting the districts of Tulkarem and Nablus and to deny access to civilian vehicles.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint south of the city of Tulkarem and to impede civilian access.</li> <li>Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>Flving Checkpoints:</li> <li>At 13:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Bal'a and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Beit Lid and the village of Kur and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one on the junction to the town of Beit Lid and the other on the northern junction to the village of Ramin, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

	• Raid: At 24:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Tulkarem and Dahiyat Shuweika.
	• Arrest: At 10:00, the Israeli army arrested 'Ammar Mustafa Badawi, while he was reporting to the Israeli Intelligence Service.
QALQILIYA	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Roads: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the town of 'Azzun with dirt barricades.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the unpaved detour road connecting the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Izbat at Tabib with dirt barricades.</li> <li>Wall Gates: <ol> <li>Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the village of Immatin and east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Hajja and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>Raid: At 22:00, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided the town of 'Azzun and searched a number of houses.</li> </ol> </li> </ol></li></ul>
NABLUS	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. Instead, the Israeli army has forced civilians to travel along an unpaved 1.5-km-long road, which branches off from the Nablus-Tulkarem road and intersects with the Nablus-Jenin road opposite the village of Sabastiya.</li> <li>Checkpoints: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing Huwwara, Beit Iba, At Tur Mountain, and Beit Furik checkpoints around the city of Nablus. The Israeli army closes the checkpoints overnight and reopens them at various morning hours.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up at the entrance to the town of Beit Furik and to deny access to civilians between 15 and 30 years of age.</li> <li>Flving Checkpoint: At 15:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Badhan road east of the city of Nablus, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access.</li> <li>Raid/Detention/Medical Obstruction/School Disruption: At 05:00, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided the city of Nablus and opened fire, while surrounding and searching 1 building. An armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals, during which the Israeli army killed 1 wanted individual. 2 Israeli soldiers were also injured during the armed confrontation. Additionally, the Israeli army detained the killed individual's wife and 2 sons (3 and 4 years of age) and</li> </ol> </li></ul>

	prevented ambulances and fire trucks from accessing the area, after a fire erupted on the 1 <sup>st</sup> floor in the surrounded building. Classes were also disrupted in Kamal Junblat and Fadwa Touqan Schools. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.  • Killing: The Israeli army killed Ahmed Suleiman Raddad in the city of Nablus.  • Arrests: At 02:20 on 06 February 2006, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians, including 1 child, during its raid on Balata refugee camp, in addition to those reported yesterday:  (i) Saleh Mousa al Jeetan, 15 years old; and  (ii) Mousa Rashed al Jeetan.
SALFIT	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the main northwestern entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current Intifada (Uprising).</li> <li>Checkpoints/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various morning hours, impeding civilian access.</li> <li>At 12:30, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint, impeded civilian access, and detained 1 vehicle belonging to the Palestinian National Security forces, while it was travelling to the city of Nablus.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.</li> <li>Flving Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the village of Haris, searched civilian vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li>Raid: At 13:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Haris until 14:00.</li> <li>Arrest: Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up near the village of Haris arrested Ahmed Subhi Farraj.</li> </ol> </li></ul>
JERICHO	<ul> <li>Closure: Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army prevents farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for Jerusalem and Jericho ID holders.</li> <li>Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus, impeding civilian access.</li> <li>Palestinian Security Measure: At 06:30, Palestinian security forces accompanied and provided protection to a number of Jewish worshippers, while they were visiting a synagogue in the city of Jericho.</li> </ul>
BETHLEHEM	Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. The Israeli army considers the

- civilians' residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem.
- Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala and in the Everest area, northwest of the city of Beit Jala.
- Raid: The Israeli army, including 1 armoured vehicle and 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Al 'Asakira.
- Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 13:20, the Israeli authorities refused to coordinate for Palestinian security forces to dispatch a Palestinian Police force to the village of Al Fureidis to settle a fight between 2 families. 2 civilians were killed during the fight.

#### **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and barbed wire Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh and with an iron gate the old gold market, all in the H2 section of the city of Hebron, denying access to civilians and vehicles.
- The Israeli army continues to implement a military order to close (ii) civilian commercial shops on both sides of the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron from 06 November 2005 until 07 May 2006. Civilian vehicles are prohibited from travelling along the road unless they possess access permits. Only Israeli settler vehicles are allowed unrestricted access on the road.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with a dirt barricade the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino in the old city of Hebron, in addition to the iron gate that has been set up in the area.
- The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the area of Al Khan (iv) in the old city of Hebron with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrances to (i) the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul, the village of 'Arab ar Ramadin, and the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron. The Israeli army has also continued to close with dirt barricades the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron and the entrance to the town of Idhna.
- The Israeli army continues to close all entrances to Al 'Arrub refugee (ii) camp with cement blocks.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to the village of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Buri, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa'.

#### **HEBRON**

- **Flying Checkpoint:** The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul and searched civilians and vehicles.
- <u>Attack</u>: At 20:50, the Israeli army opened fire towards and injured Mohammed Lu'ay al Ja'bari in the old city of Hebron.
- Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces/Detentions/House Occupations:
- (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, set up 2 checkpoints in area of Al Hawuz ath Thani and near Al Haras Palestinian Police station, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area.
- (ii) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Bani Na'im, raided 1 café, detained civilians inside, and examined their IDs.
- (iii) At 21:25, the Israeli army raided the towns of Bani Na'im and Adh Dhahiriya and searched a number of houses.
- (iv) At 00:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Burj, occupied 1 house, and converted it into a military post after detaining residents.
- (v) At 02:25, the Israeli army raided the area of Wadi al Khiyam in the town of Dura, occupied 1 house, and converted it into a military post after detaining residents. The Israeli army also prevented civilians from transporting a sick female child to hospital. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.
- <u>House Occupation</u>: The Israeli army continues to implement Military Order #T/02/05 to seize control of the roof of 1 house in the city of Hebron and to use it as a military point from 29 December 2005 until 11 February 2006.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# ALL DISTRICTS

 Beginning on 16 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a complete closure on the Gaza Strip, ostensibly due to Palestinian individuals' firing of mortars towards the Green Line. The Israeli army has prevented civilians from crossing the Green Line, only allowing access to 4,307 workers.

# NORTHERN GAZA

#### • Closure:

- (i) Beginning at 18:00 on 28 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a buffer zone (through artillery and air attacks) in the area near the Green Line, including the area of the debris of evacuated settlements, in the district of Northern Gaza. The Israeli army has also warned that civilians would put their lives in danger if they enter the designated area.
- (ii) At 11:30, the Israeli army renewed its warning that civilians are prohibited from entering the buffer zone and demanded that Palestinian security forces coordinate in advance with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO) when they change shifts of security forces in the area.

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open. At 15:20, Israeli troops positioned at the crossing point impeded the access of humanitarian cases and VIPs.
- Air Attacks/Destruction of Property/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:
- (i) At 09:50, an Israeli army UAV fired 1 missile towards an uninhabited area north of the Beit Hanun Industrial Zone.
- (ii) At 20:15, an Israeli army UAV fired 1 missile towards a civilian vehicle east of the town of Jabalya, extra-judicially killing 2 civilian passengers and destroying the vehicle.
- (iii) At 01:50, an Israeli army UAV fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory near Ash Shayma' School north of the town of Beit Lahiya, injuring 1 child.
- (iv) At 03:00, an Israeli army F16 combat aircraft fired 4 missiles towards the southern entrance to the town of Beit Hanun, cutting off electricity in the town.
- (v) At 03:40, an Israeli army F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory near 1 Palestinian National Security location east of Ash Sheikh Zayed city, but it did not explode.
- (vi) At 04:00, an Israeli army F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory near an asphalt factory, located on the Eastern Road east of the town of Jabalya.
- (vii) At 04:20, an Israeli army F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (viii) At 04:25, an Israeli army F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory near 1 Palestinian National Security location in the area surrounding the debris of the evacuated settlement of Nisanit north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (ix) At 05:10, an Israeli army F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory near 1 Palestinian National Security location in the area surrounding the debris of the evacuated settlement of Dugit northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- Assassinations: The Israeli army extra-judicially killed 2 civilians east of the town of Jabalya:
- (i) Hasan 'Asfour; and
- (ii) Rami Khamis Abdul 'Azeez.

#### • Attacks/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army fired 2 artillery shells from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near 1 Palestinian National Security location north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (ii) At 11:15, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 32 on the Green Line towards a number of shepherds northeast of the town of Beit Hanun.
- (iii) At 11:55, the Israeli army fired 4 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory in the area between 2 Palestinian National Security locations north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (iv) At 06:15, the Israeli army fired 15 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory in

	the area surrounding 3 Palestinian National Security locations northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.  (v) At 08:00, the Israeli army fired 5 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory near 2 Palestinian National Security locations north and northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	Activities not reported.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul> <li>Attacks: <ol> <li>At 15:40, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 119 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of Al Bureij refugee camp.</li> <li>At 15:50, the Israeli army opened fire from the area surrounding Kessufim gate on the Green Line towards shepherds west of the gate.</li> <li>At 20:10, the Israeli army opened fire and fired 2 artillery shells from its location on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory south of Kessufim gate.</li> </ol> </li></ul>
KHAN YUNIS	Palestinian Attack: At 21:00, armed Palestinian individuals failed to fire 1 unidentified mortar towards the Green Line. The mortar exploded in the area where it was launched.
RAFAH	<ul> <li>Closure of Crossing Points:         <ul> <li>Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed.</li> <li>Rafah Crossing is partially open in both directions to passengers holding Palestinian IDs, humanitarian cases, and Arab and foreign diplomatic missions.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Attacks: At 15:35, and again at 02:25, Israeli naval boats opened fire towards the beach of the city of Rafah.</li> </ul>

# **GENERAL**

WORK PERMITS	<ul> <li>West Bank: The Israeli authorities renewed 4,712 work permits for crossing the Green Line.
