DISTRICT	EVENT		
ALL DISTRICTS	Beginning on 11 November 2004, the Israeli army has imposed a total closure on the West Bank and Gaza Strip, preventing civilians and workers from crossing the Green Line, following the official announcement of the death of President Yasser Arafat.		

WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to impose strict restrictions at checkpoints set up at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and dispatched patrols to prevent civilians from other districts from entering the city. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks, completely preventing civilians from crossing. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat Al Aqbat, the villages of Hizma and 'Anata, the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya, near Al Quds University, the area of Ash Shayyah, and in the town of As Sawahira Ash Sharqiya. 	
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Al Mughayyir with dirt barricades. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Budrus, Midya, Ni'lin, Deir Qaddis, Bil'in, Beit Liqya, and Beituniya. Attack: At 08:00 on 10 February 2005, Israeli troops positioned at a checkpoint set up on 'Uyoun Al Haramiya junction along the Ramallah-Nablus road opened fire towards 1 civilian vehicle, claiming that the driver did not stop at the checkpoint, killing the driver and causing the vehicle to turn over. Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: (i) On 07 February 2005, the Israeli army raided Al Jalazun refugee cam and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Ramallah. (iii) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh. (iv) At 16:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Beituniya. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 1 civilian. (v) At 23:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah, took position near 1 Palestinian Police station, and prevented Police patrols from leaving the station to carry out their duties. (vi) At 05:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Jilijliya and arrested 1 Palestinian National Security officer. 	

	 Killing: The Israeli army killed Sa'ed Sadeq 'Afaneh at the checkpoint set up on 'Uyoun Al Haramiya junction. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested Nader Salah Sa'adat in Al Jalazun refugee camp. The Israeli army arrested Hassan Fahd 'Arar in the village of Jilijliya.
JENIN	 Closure: The Israeli army imposed a military closure over the area of the northern Jordan Valley east of the town of Tubas and prevented civilians from entering the area, claiming that it is a closed military zone. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in Jalbun towards Al Mutilla, Raba, Al Mughayyir, Bardala and 'Ein al Beida, and towards the Jordan River. Raid: At 03:00, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the village of Fahma and arrested 1 Palestinian National Security officer. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Hassan Jamal Nawasrah, a Palestinian National Security officer, in the village of Fahma.
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close 'Einav gate which controls the road between the cities of Tulkarem and Nablus, preventing civilian vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Flying Checkpoints: At 11:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Bal'a, searched civilian vehicles, and examined civilians' IDs. At 15:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area of Ras Rummana near the town of Baqa Ash Sharqiya, searched civilian vehicles, and examined civilians' IDs. At 18:30, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints at the entrances to the towns of Baqa Ash Sharqiya and Qaffin and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 11:35, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided Dahiyat Irtah in the city of Tulkarem and patrolled the area. At 20:30, an Israeli army tank raided the city of Tulkarem and patrolled several neighbourhoods. Air Patrols: At 11:05, and again at 13:35, 4 Israeli army helicopters patrolled the skies over the city of Tulkarem.

QALQILYA	 Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Flying Checkpoints: At 22:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Hajja and searched civilians and vehicles.
NABLUS	 Checkpoints: At 07:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction to the settlement of Yitzhar and detained 1 Palestinian Preventive Security officer. The Israeli army continues to detain the officer, along with his vehicle, as of 08:00 this morning. Raids: At 03:00, the Israeli army raided 'Askar refugee camp and arrested 2 civilians. At 03:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Al Quds (Jerusalem) Street in the city of Nablus. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in 'Askar refugee camp: Muhannad Hassan Bashkar; and Mohammed Mahmoud Abu Fakhri.
SALFIT	 Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the village of Deir Ballut along the Green Line, in the area southwest of the village of Kafr Ad Dik, west of the village of Iskaka, and north of city of Salfit. Raid: At 08:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the city of Nablus, set up a checkpoint between the city of Nablus and the village of Bruqin, and searched civilians and vehicles.
JERICHO	• <u>Closure</u> : The Israeli army set up dozens of checkpoints throughout the city, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and prevented civilians from crossing. The Israeli army only permitted residents of the city of Jericho to enter the city.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the only road leading to the village of Al Nu'man, northeast of the Bethlehem district, isolating the village and placing it, together with the adjacent village of Al Khas, under the jurisdiction of the Jerusalem municipality. The Israeli army considers the civilian presence in the villages illegal. Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall continues north of the district of Bethlehem, along 'Ayda refugee camp, along the tunnel road (Gilo), and west of the village of Husan. Raid: At 10:30, an Israeli army patrol raided the village of Dar Salah and the town of Al 'Ubeidiya. At 14:00, the Israeli army raided the town and village again and patrolled the area.

•	<u>Closure</u> : The Israeli army continues to close Al Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh in the area of H2 in the city of Hebron with cement
	blocks and barbed wire, denying civilians and vehicles access.
•	Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues west of
	the towns of Surif, Beit Ula, Idhna, and Beit 'Awwa, in the area extending
	from the village of Deir Samit, Beit 'Awwa, and towards the village of Al

• Flying Checkpoints:

Buri.

- (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area of Bir Al Mahjar and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 13:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of At Tabaga and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids/School Disruption:

- (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Adh Dhahiriya, searched a number of houses, and arrested 3 civilians, including 1 child.
- (ii) At 10:00, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Hebron and set up a checkpoint in the area of Bir Al Mahjar. At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the city again, set up a checkpoint at the entrance to Hebron University, and examined university students' IDs. At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the city again and opened indiscriminate fire while patrolling the area.
- (iii) At 17:30, the Israeli army raided the area of Khallet Al Ward in the town of Bani Na'im, set up several checkpoints in and at the entrances to the town, and searched a number of houses. The Israeli army also conducted a census of electrical equipment and vehicles.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the town of Adh Dhahiriya:

DAEAH	Point 10 along the Palestinian-Egyptian towards Palestinian houses in			
RAFAH	Tall as Sultan neighbourhood.			
	(iii) At 14:45, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its locations at			
	Point 20 towards civilian houses in Tall As Sultan neighbourhood,			
	killing 1 civilian.

	of Rafiah Yam. The Israeli army responded by opening fire towards			
	Palestinian territory.
