JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and has set up checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to Dahiyat Bir Nabala northwest of the city of Jerusalem with cement blocks. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and Beit Iksa checkpoints and to impede civilian access. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, around the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim, and west of the village of Al Jib. Flving Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to 'Atarot Industrial Zone in Dahiyat ar Ram and searched civilian vehicles. Raid: The Israeli army raided the village of 'Anata, searched 1 house, and arrested 3 civilians (2 brothers and their mother). Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the village of 'Anata: (i) Fatima Mahmoud Salameh, a female civilian; (ii) Mohammed Mahmoud Salameh, and (iii) Amjad Mahmoud Salameh.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil with dirt barricades. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud and the village of Beit Sira. Raids: At 12:35, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the area of Tallet at Tout in the vicinity of the village of Kafr 'Ein and withdrew at 14:30. At 00:20, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Qarawat Bani Zeid. The Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Burqa. Palestinian Security Measure: At 17:00, Palestinian security forces handed over 1 illegal truck and 1 motorcycle, seized in the city of Ramallah, to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).

JENIN	 Closure of Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and to impede civilian access. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Flving Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to town of 'Arraba and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 11:00, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the village of Rummana, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 12:30. At 21:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Yamun, opened indiscriminate fire, and patrolled the area until 23:00. At 02:00, the Israeli army, including 8 jeeps, raided the town of Qabatiya, searched a number of houses, and arrested 3 civilians. At 03:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. At 03:30, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Jenin and Jenin refugee camp until 04:00. Arrests: At 09:30, Israeli troops positioned at Salim checkpoint arrested 15-year-old Mahmoud Ahmed al Qadi, claiming that he was in possession of a knife. The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the town of Qabatiya: Sam Mahmoud Nazzal; Ahmed Omar Abu ar Rub; and Fu'ad Nassri Kmeil.
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure on the district of Tulkarem and to declare it a closed military zone following a suicide attack carried out on the junction to the village of Far'un. The Israeli army continues to impede civilian access to and from the district. Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the town of Bal'a to Dahiyat Iktaba with dirt barricades. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up near the settlement of 'Einav on the road connecting the districts of Tulkarem and Nablus, denying access to civilian vehicles. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint south of the city of Tulkarem, impeding civilian access. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Flving Checkpoint/Detention: At 13:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Qaffin, searched civilians and vehicles, detained 1 civilian, and released him at a later time. Raids/Detention: At 12:30, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Illar and arrested 2 civilians. The Israeli army also detained another civilian and released him at a later time.

NABLUS	(i) Beginning at 00:05 on 19 February 2006, the Israeli army has remained			
	positioned in the city of Nablus and Balata refugee camp have whilst			
	Israeli army reconnaissance aircrafts have patrolled the skies over the			
	area. The Israeli army also continues to impose curfew over Balata			
	refugee camp, thereby disrupting classes in schools for the 2 nd			
	consecutive day. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army			
	and civilians, during which the Israeli army killed 2 civilians, including			
	1 child, and injured 24 others, including 13 children. Additionally, the			
	Israeli army denied access to ambulances to transport the injured			
	civilians, arrested 8 civilians, including an injured civilian, occupied a			
	number of houses in the city of Nablus and Balata refugee camp, and			
	converted them into military posts. The Israeli army also converted 1			
	school into a military post. In addition, an armed confrontation took			
	place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals in the			
	old city of Nablus, during which the Israeli army killed 1 civilian. The			
	Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.

JERICHO	 Closure: Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army prevents farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for Jerusalem and Jericho ID holders. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus, impeding civilian access. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up at the entrance to the village of 'Ein Ad Duyuk on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah and to deny civilian access in both directions between 20:00 and 05:00 on a daily basis. Flying Checkpoints: At 10:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja on Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah and searched civilians and vehicles travelling in both directions. At 13:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the settlement of Vered Yericho and searched civilians and vehicles. Arrests: At 20:15, Israeli troops positioned at the DCO checkpoint set up at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho arrested 2 civilians: Dawoud Burghol; and Mohammed Tayseer Barahmeh.
ВЕТНІЕНЕМ	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians' residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala and in the Everest area, northwest of the city of Beit Jala. Raids/Land Levelling/Destruction of Property: At 11:30, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps and 1 bulldozer, raided the area of Ash Shi'b ar Rafi' in the village of Wadi Fukin, levelled 3 dunums (0.75 acres) of land cultivated with olive trees, and withdrew at a later time. At 11:35, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Al Khadr. At 21:30, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided the village of Al 'Asakira and searched 1 house.

At 22:15, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the village of Abu (iv) Nujeim and searched the village's cemetery. At 00:50, the Israeli army, including 14 jeeps, raided the city of (v) Bethlehem and Al 'Aza refugee camp, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian in the camp. At 02:05, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Malek Harb al 'Azzah in Al 'Aza refugee camp. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and barbed wire Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh and with an iron gate the old gold market, all in the H2 section of the city of Hebron, denying access to civilians and vehicles. The Israeli army continues to implement a military order to close (ii) civilian commercial shops on both sides of the road connecting the settlement of Kirvat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron from 06 November 2005 until 07 May 2006. Civilian vehicles are prohibited from travelling along the road unless they possess access permits. Only Israeli settler vehicles are allowed unrestricted access on the road. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with a dirt barricade the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino in the old city of Hebron, in addition to the iron gate that has been set up in the area.

The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul, the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron, and the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron. The Israeli army also continues to close with dirt barricades the entrances to the town of Idhna and the village of 'Arab ar Ramadin.

The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the area of Al Khan

• The Israeli army partially eased the closure it has imposed on the Gaza Strip since 16 December 2005 ostensibly due to Palestinian individuals' firing of mortars towards the Green Line.

Closure: Beginning at 18:00 on 28 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a buffer zone (through open fire as well as artillery and air attacks) in the area near the Green Line, including the area of the debris of evacuated settlements, in the district of Northern Gaza. The Israeli army has also warned that civilians would put their lives in danger if they enter the designated area. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to foreign nationals, VIPs, civilians holding special permits, and humanitarian **NORTHERN** cases. GAZA **Attacks/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:** At 10:15, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 23 on the Green Line (i) towards Palestinian territory north of the town of Beit Hanun. At 11:10, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 64 on the Green Line (ii) towards Palestinian territory east of the town of Jabalya. At 22:10, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from its location inside (iii) the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near 1 Palestinian National Security location northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. **GAZA** Activities not reported. **CENTRAL** Activities not reported. **GAZA**

KHAN YUNIS	 Attack: At 12:30, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 176 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the village of 'Abasan al Kabira. Killing: With reference to the 2 civilians killed by the Israeli army yesterday, the unidentified killed civilian was identified as Usamah Fawzi Breiss. Palestinian Attack: At 22:35, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah Crossing is partially open in both directions to passengers holding Palestinian IDs, humanitarian cases, and Arab and foreign diplomatic missions.
