WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the town of al-Izariyyeh, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Anata. The checkpoint was set up a second time at 24:00, and the Israeli army searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of al-Nabi Samuel.

• Raids:

- (i) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Abu Dis.
- (ii) At 01:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Izariyyeh, and set up a checkpoint.
- (iii) The Israeli army raided the village of al-Sawahreh al-Sharqiyyeh and arrested one civilian.

• Arrests:

- (i) At 24:00, the Israeli army arrested in the village of Sur Baher civilian Jihad Mohammad 'Atoon.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in the village of al-Sawahreh al-Sharqiyyeh is

Mohammad Nabil Zahaykeh.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the western entrance to the village of Safa with cement blocks.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and impede civilian access
- <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 19:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the town of Beit Luqya and the village of Kharbatha al-Misbah.

Raids

- (i) At 20:25, the Israeli army raided the city of al-Bireh, set up a checkpoint, detained a number of civilians and damaged one ID of one civilian and confiscated another ID, and arrested one civilian.
- (ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Rantis and arrested one university student
- (iii) The Israeli army raided the town of Beit Rima and arrested on military officer from the Palestinian Security Forces.

• Arrests:

- (i) The Israeli army arrested on the passageway of Atara civilian Dheeb Mohammad Abdallah.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in the city of al-Bireh is Younis Mahmoud Hawamdeh.
- (iii) The civilian arrested in the village of Rantis is Amjad Fahed Abdel Jalil Ballout.
- (iv) The civilians arrested in the village of Beit Rima is military officer Bassam Mteir Youssef al-Asmar.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.

Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the (iii) checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. Raids: At 03:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Askar in the city, and searched one building and detained its resident in the open. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the village of Beita (the place of detention is unknown). The arrested civilians are: (a) Imad Muhib Hamayel; (b) Munjed Suleiman Hamayel; (c) Yousseh al-Shurafa. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to (i) the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current Intifada (Uprising). The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western (ii) entrance to the village of Marda. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the agricultural road connecting the

- village of Iskaka and the bypass road (trans-Samaria) near Ariel settlement.
- **Checkpoints:** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tara checkpoints and to deny civilian access.

Raids:

SALFIT

- (i) At 16:40, the Israeli army raided the village of Marda and detained 2 civilians during patrol. In addition, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the town and then withdrew at 17:30.
- (ii) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Deir Ballout.
- (iii) At 02:20, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Zawiyyeh, searched one civilian house, arrested one military officer, and then withdrew at 02:50.
- Arrests: The civilian arrested in the town of al-Zawiyyeh is military officer Johad Abdel Hamid Moqadi.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.

JERICHO	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road. (ii) The Israeli army closed the only entrance to the village of al-Dheeb with dirt barricades and cement blockades. Flving Checkpoints: At 20:25, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the area of al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem), and searched civilians and vehicles until 22:15. Raids: (i) At 10:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Khirbet al-Deir and the Israeli military jeep capsized over the house of Mahmoud Hussein Suleiman. (ii) At 11:20, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Khader and patrolled it until 12:00. (iii) At 22:25, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Khader and patrolled it until 22:55. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the villages of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the villages of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the villages of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east o

The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at al-Fawwar junction, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Arab al-Ramadin.
- (iii) At 12:55, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the passageway of the town of Halhoul and denied civilian access. The checkpoint was set up a second time at 15:10.

Raids:

- (i) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron, and set up a checkpoint in the area of Ras al-Jora. The raid recurred at 19:10 during which the Israeli army searched one civilian house and arrested 2 university students.
- (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Halhoul.
- (iii) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al-'Arroub, clashed with civilians, detained a number of

civilians and released them later.

- (iv) At 23:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura
- Arrests: The 2 civilians arrested in the city of Hebron are:
 - (a) 'Aref Salameh Rashed al-Hreibat; and
 - (b) Hisham Ismail Abu Hawash.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

GAZA DISTRICTS

• On February 28, Israeli F16 warplanes, combat helicopters and reconnaissance crafts flew over the district of Gaza.

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access).

- Raids: At 24:00, the Israeli army raided north and east of the town of Beit Hanoun and the area of Abu Bourah Abu Samra in the town of Beit Lahia, and opened fire intensively towards civilian houses.
- Attacks:

(i) At 09:00, the Israeli army fired 1 missile from its post on the Green Line towards the area of al-Boura in al-Amal neighborhood east of the town of Beit Hanoun, injured 5 civilians, 9ncluding 3 children, and incurred heavy material damage to a number of civilian houses.

- (ii) At 13:20, the Israeli army fired one missile from its post on the Green Line towards armed individuals near the city of al-Sheikh Zayed north-East of the town of Beit Lahia.
- (iii) At 07:30, the Israeli army fired a number of missiles from its post in the Green Line towards agricultural land east of the town of Jabalia.

Air Attacks:

- (i) At 13:00, an Israeli unmanned drone fired 2 missiles towards armed individuals in Damra neighborhood east of the town of Beit Hanoun and near Abu Obaidah School in the town of Beit Lahia, resulting in the death of 2 civilians, including one armed civilians, and the injury of 5 civilians.
- (ii) At 15:00, and Israeli unmanned drone fired one missile near al-Salam Mosque east of the town of Jabalia, resulting in the death of 4 children, including 3 children from the same family, and the serous injury of one child.
- (iii) At 15:40, an Israeli unmanned drone fired one missile targeting a civilian vehicle carryiong armed individuals neas

NORTHERN GAZA

- Omar Ben al-Khattab Mosque in al-Qarman street in the town of Beit Hanoun, resulting in the death of one armed individual and the injury of 2.
- (iv) At 18:00, an Israeli unmanned drone fired one missile towards al-Nawras Tourist Resort in the area of al-Soudaniyyeh west of the town of Beit Lahia and killed one civilian.
- (v) At 19:30, Israeli F16 war planes fired 2 missiles towards agricultural land in the area of Tel al-Za'tar and damaged window panes of nearby civilian houses.
- (vi) At 22:40, Israeli F16 war planes fired one missile towards a civilian house in the area of al-Saftawi in the town of Jabalia, damaged the house and incurred damage to neighboring civilian houses.
- (vii) At 23:00, Israeli F16 war planes fired 3 missiles targeting the Palestinian Laborers General Union Building in the area of al-Saftawi in the town of Jabalia, injured 7 civilians, including a toddler 6 months old and damaged the building.
- Air Patrols: At 12:00, Israeli F16 war planes flew over the city of Gaza.
- Deaths:
- (i) At 16:15 on February 27, civilian Hamad Murshed Masalha, 60, south-east of the town of Jabalia.
- (ii) The 2 civilians killed in Damta street east of the town of Beit Hanoun and near Abu Obaidah School in the town of Beit Lahia are: Awad al-Banna and Abdallah al-Zweidi.
- (iii) The 4 civilians killed near al-Salam Mosque east of the town of Jabalia are:
