### **WEST BANK**

## ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

# • <u>Closure</u>: At 11:00, the Israeli army closed the city of Jerusalem completely for a number of hours. The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. Additionally, the Israeli army combed the area alongside the apartheid Wall as a result of heated alarms of a suicide attack in the city.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.

### **JERUSALEM**

### • Checkpoints:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) The Israeli army intensified restrictions at Ramot checkpoint and impeded traffic.
- **Flying Checkpoints**: At 14:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Beit Iksa, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- <u>House Demolition</u>: The Israeli army demolished a house unhder the pretext of unlicensed construction east of the village of Mikhmas. The house belongs to civilian Suleiman Salman Mleihat.

### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	• Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al-Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:
- (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.
- (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.
- (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.

### • Raids:

- (i) At 14:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Huwara and arrested 1 civilian.
- (ii) At 02:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Ein al-Ma', opened fire and fired sound bombs, searched 2 buildings, and arrested 8 civilians including a female civilian. The Israeli army withdrew at 04:40.
- (iii) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Osrin, searched a number of buildings and physically attacked their residents, and arrested 4 civilians including 1 child.

The Israeli army withdrew at 08:40.  • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ari'el.
JERICHO	<ul> <li>Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. BETHLEHEM	Closure:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.  (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number

07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahour and Bethlehem.

- <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 19:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area of al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and impeded traffic until 19:30.
- <u>Palestinian Security Measures</u>: At 12:40, the Palestinian security forces handed over to the Israeli side through the D.C.O. an Israeli soldier carrying an M16 gun after he was caught at the entrance to the town of al-Khader. It was found out that the Israeli soldier was trying to go into the city of Bethlehem.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

### • <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street

that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Beit Kahel. At 10:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron. The raid recurred (ii) at 02:00. At 11:15, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al'-Arroub and (iii) clashed with civilians during patrol. At 15:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area of al-Hasaka (iv) near the town of Beit Kahel. At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit 'Ummar and opened (v) fire indiscriminately after a suspicious object had been thrown towards an Israeli military watch tower that is set up at the entrance to the town. al-Nasr that is located to the north of the town of Beit Lahia, and opened
fire intensively towards civilian houses. In addition, the Israeli army
razed agricultural land and remains in the areas until the time this report
is being prepared.
(ii) In the evening of January 6, the Israeli army raided Palestinian areas
east of the town of Beit Hanoun and clashed with armed individuals.

(i) At 17:00, one (unidentified) mortar was fired towards the Green Line.

• Raids: Since the dawn of January 6, the Israeli army has been raiding
Palestinian areas east of the refugee camp of al-Breij and opened fire
intensively towards civilian houses. In addition, the Israeli army occupied
roofs of houses and converted them into military posts. Moreover, the

Israeli army clashed with armed individuals and killed 4 civilians, including one child and a female civilian and one armed individual, and injured 35 civilians, including 4 children, a umber of armed individuals and 8 civilians who were seriously injured, including toddler Ibrahim Hamdan and female civilian Rohiya Hamdan. Furthermore, the Israeli army a number of houses and detained 150 civilians and released them later after conducting filed investigation with them. Moreover, the Israeli army opened fire towards journalists and an ambulance, and incurred material damage of a civilian vehicle and to a number of houses. The Israeli army also razed agricultural land and then withdrew at 15:00. **Deaths**: The 4 civilians killed in the refugee camp of al-Breij are: (a) Ziyad Abu Rukbah, 16; (b) Mahmoud Rabbah Abed; (c) Ahmad Mohammad Khalaf; and (d) Female civilian Iman Mohammad Hamdan. **Palestinian Attacks:** (i) At 19:00, two (unidentified) mortars were fired towards the Green Line. (ii) At 01:00, 14 (unidentified) mortars were fired towards the Green Line. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (al-Awdah) Crossing is partially open (a number of pilgrims stuck on the Egyptian side in their return from Mecca were allowed into Gaza).
