WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and has set up checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to Dahiyat Bir Nabala northwest of the city of Jerusalem with cement blocks. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and Beit Iksa checkpoints and to impede civilian access. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, around the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim, and west of the village of Al Jib.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil with dirt barricades. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud. Flying Checkpoint: At 02:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the Ramallah-Bir Zeit main road and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 08:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Beit Rima, searched 1 house, and served a summons to 1 civilian to report to the Israeli Intelligence Service. At 19:30, and again at 02:20 and at 06:30, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh. At 06:40, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Ramallah. Palestinian Security Measure: At 10:30, Palestinian security forces handed over 3 illegal vehicles, seized in the city of Ramallah, to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Jabriyat road connecting the area south of the city of Jenin to Jenin refugee camp. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and to impede civilian access. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

• Raids/House Occupation/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:

- (i) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin, occupied 1 house, and converted it into a military post. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city of again and opened indiscriminate fire while patrolling the area, injuring 1 child. At 05:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.
- (ii) At 17:00, Israeli Special Forces, accompanied by 5 jeeps, raided the town of Tubas, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian. An armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals. The Israeli army also took position near 1 Palestinian National Security location and withdrew at 22:00.
- (iii) At 21:00, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Rummana until 22:00.
- <u>Arrest</u>: The Israeli army arrested Nour ad Din Hafeth Sawaftah in the town of Tubas.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure on the district of Tulkarem and to declare it a closed military zone following a suicide attack carried out on the junction to the village of Far'un. The Israeli army continues to impede civilian access to and from the district.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr al Labad and the village of Al Hafasa and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khmeish.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the towns of Bal'a and Deir al Ghusun with cement blocks.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads connecting the town of Bal'a to the village of Al 'Attara, to the town of 'Illar, and to Dahiyat Iktaba in the city of Tulkarem.

• Checkpoints:

(i) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the checkpoint set up near the settlement of 'Einav on the road connecting the districts of Tulkarem and Nablus, impeding civilian access in both directions.

- (ii) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint south of the city of Tulkarem, impeding civilian access.
- <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of 'Illar, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access until 17:00.
- <u>Physical Assault</u>: At 13:40, Israeli troops positioned at Jubara checkpoint severely beat 15-year-old Mohammed Sakhr Sati, after which he was transported to hospital for treatment of injuries sustained.
- Raid: At 19:50, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Attil, searched 4 houses, and withdrew at 02:00.

TULKAREM

QALQILIYA	 Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the village of Immatin and east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. Flying Checkpoints: At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Habla tunnel south of the city of Qalqiliya, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access until 21:00. At 19:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles until 21:00.
NABLUS	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. Instead, the Israeli army has forced civilians to travel along an unpaved 1.5-km-long road, which branches off from the Nablus-Tulkarem road and intersects with the Nablus-Jenin road opposite the village of Sabastiya. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing Huwwara, Beit Iba, At Tur Mountain, and Beit Furik checkpoints around the city of Nablus. The Israeli army closes the checkpoints overnight and reopens them at various morning hours. The Israeli army limited the time for crossing Huwwara checkpoint to the period between 06:00 and 23:00. Arrest: At 20:30, Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint arrested Malek Omar 'Umran, a Palestinian security officer.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current Intifada (Uprising). The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to close the western entrance to the village of Bruqin with dirt barricades. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan with an iron gate and cement blocks. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various morning hours, impeding civilian access. The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint, impeding civilian access.

	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. Raid: At 13:00, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Kifl Haris until 14:20.
JERICHO	 Closure: Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army prevents farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for Jerusalem and Jericho ID holders. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus and to impede civilian access. Flying Checkpoints: At 11:15, and again at 16:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians' residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the villages of Husan and Nahhalin with cement blocks. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala and in the Everest area, northwest of the city of Beit Jala. Raids: (i) At 01:30 on 09 January 2006, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Bethlehem, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 university student. (ii) At 02:00 on 09 January 2006, the Israeli army raided 'Ayda refugee
	 (ii) At 02:00 on 09 January 2006, the Israeli army raided 'Ayda refugee camp and arrested 1 Palestinian National Security officer. (iii) At 14:25, the Israeli army raided the village of Dar Salah, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles until 15:00. (v) At 18:30, an Israeli army patrol raided 'Ayda refugee camp and patrolled the area. • Arrests: (i) The Israeli army arrested Hadi Ali Abdul Hafeth in the city of Bethlehem.

	• Detention: At 22:50, Israeli troops positioned at Gilo checkpoint detained

	• Flying Checkpoints:
	(i) At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the road leading
	to the town of Beit Kahil and searched civilians and vehicles.
	(ii) At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to
	the town of Halhul and searched civilians and vehicles until 22:30.
	• Raids/Detentions/Provocation of Palestinian Forces/House Occupation:
	(i) At 18:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, raided the offices
	of 2 local radio stations, and detained 3 employees in 1 radio station. At
	07:40, the Israeli army raided the city again, set up a checkpoint near 1
	Palestinian National Security location in the area of Farsh al Hawa,
	i alesuman iyanonan security locanon in the area on raish al flawa,

searched civilian vehicles, and detained a number of civilians. The Israeli army also searched 1 building near Al Ahli Hospital.

- (ii) At 07:30, the Israeli army raided the village of At Turrama, occupied 1 house, and converted it into a military post after detaining residents in 1 room.
- House Occupation: The Israeli army continues to implement Military Order #T/02/05 to seize control of the roof of 1 house in the city of Hebron and to use it as a military point from 29 December 2005 until 11 February 2006.
- <u>Settler Violence/Physical Assault</u>: At 13:30, an Israeli settler severely beat 1 elderly civilian in the old city of Hebron.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

 Beginning on 16 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a complete closure on the Gaza Strip, ostensibly due to Palestinian individuals' firing of mortars towards the Green Line. The Israeli army has prevented civilians and workers from crossing the Green Line.

Closure: Beginning at 18:00 on 28 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a buffer zone (through artillery and air attacks) in the area near the Green Line, including the areas of evacuated settlements, in the district of Northern Gaza. Prior to imposing the buffer zone, Israeli **NORTHERN** army combat aircrafts dropped flyers warning that civilians would put their **GAZA** lives in danger if they enter the designated area. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases only. **GAZA** Activities not reported. **CENTRAL** Activities not reported. **GAZA** Activities not reported. **KHAN YUNIS Closure of Crossing Points:** Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed. (i) **RAFAH** (ii) Rafah Crossing is partially open in both directions from 08:00 to 16:00 to passengers holding Palestinian IDs, humanitarian cases, and Arab and foreign diplomatic missions.
