| JERUSALEM | <u>Closure</u>: The city of Jerusalem remains closed to residents from other districts. <u>Separation Wall Construction</u>: Construction of the separation wall continues in Abu Dis, Al Eizariya and Al Sawahira. |

| RAMALLAH & EL BIREH | Closure: The Israeli army closed the village of Al Mughayyir. Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the western portion of the separation wall continues in Budrus and Rantis. Raids: At 19:30, an Israeli army jeep raided the towns of Deir Ghassana and Beit Rima. At 21:30, an Israeli army jeep raided the town of Deir Ghassana and the village of Kafr 'Ein. The Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Malik, opened indiscriminate fire and harassed civilian pedestrians who were outdoors when the raid began. |
| JENIN | Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits which are based on no specific criteria. The closure continues to negatively impact economic and livelihood activities and impedes access to health facilities. Separation Wall Construction/Land Leveling: (i) Israeli authorities continue to level land north of the village of Bardala, east of the village of 'Ein al Beida and near the villages of Al Mutilla and Raba on the Nablus mountain range for construction of the separation wall. (ii) Construction on the separation wall has begun on Al Buqe'a plateau east of the town of Tubas. (iii) The Israeli authorities confiscated 5 water containers in the area of Al Malih belonging to shepherds herding livestock in the area in preparation for construction the separation wall. Raid: At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Yamun, searched several houses and arrested 5 civilians before withdrawing at 04:00. |

| Closure: Entrances to the city in the north and south remain closed, cutting Bethlehem off from its southern villages and from Jerusalem. Raids: At 20:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Teqoa', imposed curfew, opened indiscriminate fire, fired sound grenades and searched pedestrians before withdrawing at 02:30. At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Za'tara, closed all entrances to the village and searched several civilian houses before withdrawing at 22:00. |
| Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the Enav iron gate and Al Kafriyat separation wall gate, separating Tulkarem from the districts of Nablus and Qalqiliya. Flving Checkpoints: At 07:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Lid, searched vehicles, examined passenger IDs and arrested 1 civilian. At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the Immatin junction, searched vehicles, examined passenger IDs and arrested 1 civilian. At 22:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Bal'a/Anabta, searched vehicles and examined passenger IDs. Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits which are based on no specific criteria. The closure continues to negatively impact economic and livelihood activities and impedes access to health facilities. Raids: At 19:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the village of Kafr Al Labad and opened indiscriminate fire. At 23:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the city from the Dahiyat Shuweika entrance and opened indiscriminate fire. At 23:50, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps and 1 APC and supported by helicopters, raided the city and took position near Nur Shams refugee camp. At 24:00, and again at 01:30, additional Israeli military forces were brought into the area. The Israeli army withdrew to the |

| NABLUS | Closure: Nablus remains a closed military area. Civilians are prohibited from leaving or entering the city. Raid: At 18:00, the Israeli army, supported by helicopters, raided Balata refugee camp and opened indiscriminate fire, injuring 4 civilians, including 1 child who was shot by live fire in the chest. The Israeli army withdrew at 09:00. Physical Assaults: The Israeli army, positioned at Huwwara checkpoint, beat Mahmoud Rayyan, causing injuries to the head. The Israeli army, positioned at Huwwara checkpoint, severely beat Fawwaz Mustafa, an ambulance driver, causing injuries to the head. Injury: The Israeli army injured 13-year-old Samih Qamhiyya in Balata refugee camp with live fire to the chest. |
| | • <u>Detention</u> : At 14:00, the Israeli army, positioned near the village of Till, detained dozens of civilians and confiscated their IDs. The civilians were released at 19:40 after intervention from the US Consulate. |

| CENTRAL GAZA | Attack: At 18:00, the Israeli army, including 10 jeeps, took position near Point 142 east of the settlement of Kfar Daroom and opened intensive fire towards the west. |
| KHAN YUNIS | Closure: (i) Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. (ii) Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. (iii) Abu Holi road is partially opened. |
| RAFAH | Closure: The Gaza International Airport remains closed. Sufa crossing remains partially open to merchants and workers. House Demolition: At 03:10, an Israeli bulldozer, supported by 1 APC, entered 100 meters near Point 5.5 and partially demolished the home of Samir Nasrallah in Al Salam neighborhood. |
