WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and has set up checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to Dahiyat Bir Nabala northwest of the city of Jerusalem with cement blocks. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and Beit Iksa checkpoints and to impede civilian access. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, around the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim, and west of the village of Al Jib.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil with dirt barricades. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud. Palestinian Security Measure: At 14:15, Palestinian security forces handed over 1 illegal truck, seized in the city of Ramallah, to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Jabriyat road connecting the area south of the city of Jenin to Jenin refugee camp. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and to impede civilian access. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Raid: At 22:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Jenin.
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure on the district of Tulkarem and to declare it a closed military zone following a suicide attack carried out on the junction to the village of Far'un. The Israeli army continues to impede civilian access to and from the district. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr al Labad and the village of Al Hafasa and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khmeish.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the towns of Bal'a and Deir al Ghusun with cement blocks.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads connecting the town of Bal'a to the village of Al 'Attara, to the town of 'Illar, and to Dahiyat Iktaba in the city of Tulkarem.
- (iv) At 17:20, the Israeli army closed the main road to the town of Baqa ash Sharqiya with dirt barricades.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: At 07:30, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint set up near the settlement of 'Einav on the road connecting the districts of Tulkarem and Nablus and denied civilian access.
- <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

Raids

- (i) At 14:20, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of 'Attil.
- (ii) At 14:40, the Israeli army raided the village of Seida and searched 1 house. Confrontations took place between civilians and the Israeli army while it was searching 1 house.
- (iii) At 01:45, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp, searched a number of houses, and arrested 11 civilians. At 04:40, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The Israeli army arrested 11 civilians in the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp:
- (i) Samer Ghanem;
- (ii) Raed Qawzah;
- (iii) Muhannad Mahmoud Salah ad Din;
- (iv) 'Imad Bdeir;
- (v) Ala' Salah Shaheen;

QALQILIYA

• Wall Gates:

- (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the village of Immatin and east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.
- Flying Checkpoints:
- (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles.

	 (ii) At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the villages of 'Azzun 'Atma and 'Izbat Salman and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 19:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 21:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the towns of 'Azzun and Jayyus, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access.
	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. Instead, the Israeli army has forced civilians to travel along an unpaved 1.5-km-long road, which branches off from the Nablus-Tulkarem road and intersects with the Nablus-Jenin road opposite the village of Sabastiya. Checkpoints:
	 (i) The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing Huwwara, Beit Iba, At Tur Mountain, and Beit Furik checkpoints around the city of Nablus. The Israeli army closes the checkpoints overnight and reopens them at various morning hours. (ii) The Israeli army limited the time for crossing Huwwara checkpoint to
NABLUS	the period between 06:00 and 23:00. • Raids: At 18:20, and again at 01:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the city of Nablus, arrested 4 civilians, and withdrew at 06:00. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in the city of Nablus: (i) Rami al Qaddumi, (ii) Iyad Abu Saleh;
	 (iii) Mahmoud al Hafi; and (iv) Mohammed al Hafi. • <u>Detention</u>: At 14:15, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up at the entrance to the town of Beit Furik detained Sami Mahmoud Khreishah, a Palestinian Customs Police officer, served him a summons to report to the Israeli Intelligence Service, and released him at 15:15. • <u>Attack on Property</u>: At 13:20, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Mekhora east of the town of Beit Furik buried approximately 10,000 birds infected with a disease on civilian land near the settlement.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik with cement blocks.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the western entrance to the village of Bruqin with dirt barricades. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan with an iron gate and cement blocks.

	 Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various morning hours, impeding civilian access. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Kafr ad Dik and the village of Bruqin and searched civilians and vehicles until 12:00.
JERICHO	 Closure: Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army prevents farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for Jerusalem and Jericho ID holders. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus and to impede civilian access. Detentions:
	 (i) At 08:50, Israeli troops positioned at the DCO checkpoint set up at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho detained 2 civilians until 09:30. (ii) At 18:40, the Israeli army arrested Usamah Abdul Raheem 'Awadh, a Palestinian Police officer, along the settler bypass road near the junction to the village of An Nuwei'ma.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians' residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the villages of Husan and Nahhalin with cement blocks. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala and in the Everest area, northwest of the city of Beit Jala. Raids: (i) At 11:30, and again at 16:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem. At 01:40, the Israeli army raided the city for the third time, searched 1 house, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 02:40.
	(ii) At 16:20, an Israeli army patrol raided the village of Dar Salah, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 02:40, an Israeli army patrol raided 'Ayda refugee camp and patrolled the area until 02:50.

	Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Ibrahim Mohammed al Khatib in the city		
	of Bethlehem.		
	• Closure:		
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and barbed wire Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh and with an iron gate the old gold market, all in the H2 section of the city of Hebron, denying access to civilians and vehicles.		
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to implement a military order to close civilian commercial shops on both sides of the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron from 06 November 2005 until 07 May 2006. Civilian vehicles are prohibited from travelling along the road unless they possess access permits. Only Israeli settler vehicles are allowed unrestricted access on the road.		
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with a dirt barricade the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino in the old city of Hebron, in addition to the iron gate that has been set up in the area.		
	(iv) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the area of Al Khan in the old city of Hebron with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.		
	• Closure of Main Roads:		
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrances to the village of Beit 'Einun, the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul, Al Fawwar refugee camp, the village of 'Arab ar Ramadin,		
HEBRON	and the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron. The Israeli army has also continued to close with dirt barricades the junction to the area of Farsh al Haw leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron.		
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp with an iron gate.		
	(iii) At 10:00, the Israeli army closed the entrance to the town of Idhna with an iron gate and cement blocks.		
	• <u>Wall Construction</u> : Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to the village of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa'.		
	 Flying Checkpoints: (i) At 12:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the road to the 		
	towns of As Samoa' and Yatta and searched civilians and vehicles.		
	(ii) At 15:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul and denied civilian access in both directions until 16:30.		
	• Raid: At 09:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Khirbet Salama and searched a number of houses.		
	• <u>Arrests</u> : At 10:00, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians while they were reporting to the Israeli Intelligence Service:		
	(i) Yousef Abdul 'Azeez Qazzaz;		
	(ii) Yousef Ahmed Abu Zarzour; and		

- (iii) Mohammed Zayed Ziyadat.
- (iv) At 12:45, the Israeli army arrested Hazem Abu Turki at the entrance to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron, claiming that he attempted to stab an Israeli soldier.
- <u>House Occupation</u>: The Israeli army continues to implement Military Order #T/02/05 to seize control of the roof of 1 house in the city of Hebron and to use it as a military point from 29 December 2005 until 11 February 2006.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

 Beginning on 16 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a complete closure on the Gaza Strip, ostensibly due to Palestinian individuals' firing of mortars towards the Green Line. The Israeli army has prevented civilians and workers from crossing the Green Line.

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure</u>: Beginning at 18:00 on 28 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a buffer zone (through artillery and air attacks) in the area near the Green Line, including the areas of evacuated settlements, in the district of Northern Gaza. Prior to imposing the buffer zone, Israeli army combat aircrafts dropped flyers warning that civilians would put their lives in danger if they enter the designated area.
- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases only.
- Attacks/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:
- (i) At 02:45, the Israeli army fired 3 artillery shells from Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory in the area between 2 Palestinian National Security locations north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (ii) At 03:15, the Israeli army fired 4 artillery shells from its location at Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory near 2 Palestinian National Security locations north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (iii) At 03:30, the Israeli army fired 5 artillery shells from its location at Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya towards Palestinian territory near 1 Palestinian National Security location north of the town of Beit Lahiya.

GAZA

- Closure of Crossing Points:
- (i) Al Muntar (Karnei) Crossing is closed.
- (ii) Nahal Oz Crossing is closed.
- Attack/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 21:45, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from Point 86 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near 1 Palestinian National Security location east of Gaza city.

RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah Crossing is partially open in both directions from 08:00 to 16:00 to passengers holding Palestinian IDs, humanitarian cases, and Arab and foreign diplomatic missions. Sufa Crossing is closed.
