WEST BANK The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the ALL **DISTRICTS** northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. Closure: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, set up several checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound, and prevented civilians under 45 years of age from accessing Al Aqsa Mosque to perform Friday prayers. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al (ii) Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.

<u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
- <u>Raid</u>: The Israeli army raided the town of Al 'Eizariya, searched a number of houses, and arrested 2 civilians.
- Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the town of Al 'Eizariya:
- (i) Sami Ali al Asmar; and
- (ii) Raed Fayez Mteir.

Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern (i) entrance to the village of Sinjil. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western (ii) entrance to the village of Saffa. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the area west of the town of 'Abud, in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin, Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis, and in the town of Beituniya. **RAMALLAH** Raids: (i) At 15:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Ramallah. At EL BIREH 02:00, the Israeli army, including 9 jeeps, raided the city again. While surrounding and searching a building, an armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals. At 03:50, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. At 03:10, the Israeli army, including 9 jeeps, raided the village of (ii) 'Arura, searched 1 house, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 04:15. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Kamal Mohammed Dawoud in the village of 'Arura. **Demonstration/Attack/Injuries:** A demonstration, mass including international peace activists, took place in the village of Bil'in in protest against Wall construction. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and protestors, during which the Israeli army injured 7 civilians, including 1 child. Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan as well as the road connecting the town of Qabatiya to the village of Misliya. **Checkpoint:** The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted **JENIN** special Israeli permits. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 08:20, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints near the village of (i) 'Aggaba, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian. At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to (ii) the town of Az Zababida and searched civilians and vehicles. At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to (iii) the town of 'Arraba and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the villages of Siris and Al Far'a and searched civilians and vehicles.

Raids/Attacks: At 01:00, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the town of Al (i) Yamun, opened intensive fire, searched 1 house, and withdrew at At 01:30, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the town of Tubas. (ii) While patrolling the area, the Israeli army opened intensive fire. At 05:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. Arrests: At 14:20, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians, including 1 child, near the settlement of Shaked: Muntasser Nader Kmeil, 17 years old; and (i) Yasser Mustafa Kmeil. (ii) (iii) Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up near the village of 'Aggaba arrested 'Aadel Hamdan Abu 'Arrah. Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain, and the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city) and Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city). Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. **Raids/Air Patrols: TULKAREM** (i) At 08:15, the Israeli army, including 2 armoured vehicles and 4 jeeps, raided the town of 'Anabta and patrolled the area until 12:25. At 08:15, Israeli troops, dispatched by a combat helicopter, raided and (ii) combed the area between the towns of 'Illar and Bal'a. (iii) At 11:45, Israeli troops, dispatched by a combat helicopter, raided and combed the area between Dahiyat Dhinnaba in the city of Tulkarem and the town of Kafr al Labad. At 23:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the (iv) city of Tulkarem. Arrests: At 21:30, Israeli troops positioned at Jubara checkpoint arrested 1 civilian and 1 Palestinian Police officer: Ala' Mu'ayyad Shahrour, a Palestinian Police officer; and (i) Ali Ghazi al Hajj. (ii) Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. **Wall Gates:** Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special (i) **QALQILIYA** Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.

	• <u>Checkpoints</u> : The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing
	checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:
	(i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western
	entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The
	Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to
	cross these checkpoints.
	(ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed
	on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all
	other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit
	Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30.
	(iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close
	the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the

	(ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and 'Ein Beit el
	Ma' refugee camp, searched 7 houses, opened fire, and fired sound grenades. In the refugee camp, the Israeli army arrested 4 civilians and
	severely beat 'Adli Hmeidan, after which he was transported to hospital
	for medical treatment. At 06:15, the Israeli army withdrew from the
	area.
	• Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in 'Ein Beit el Ma' refugee
	camp in the city of Nablus:

	 (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. • Raids: (i) At 14:20, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan. While patrolling the area, confrontations took
	place between the Israeli army and civilians. At 16:00, the Israeli army withdrew form the area. (ii) At 14:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Kafr ad Dik. Confrontations took place between civilians and the Israeli army, while it was patrolling the area.
JERICHO	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. The Israeli army has also installed computers at the 2 checkpoints to examine civilians' IDs, thereby impeding civilian access.
ВЕТНІЕНЕМ	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat. Raids: At 02:15, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided the cities of Bethlehem and Beit Sahur and patrolled the area until 02:55. At 02:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Al Khadr and the village of Artas.

• <u>Demonstration</u>: At 12:00, civilian residents of the village of Um Salamuna performed Friday prayers on their land, which the Israeli army threatens to confiscate for Wall construction, thereby protesting construction of the Wall in the area.

• <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
- Flying Checkpoints: At 15:30, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one at the entrance to the area of An Nabi Yunis in the town of Halhul and the other on Al Fawwar junction, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- **Physical Assault:** The Israeli army severely beat Naji Abu Khalaf, while raiding and searching his house in the old city of Hebron.

• Raids/Attack:

- (i) At 13:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Idhna and arrested 1 civilian.
- (ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided Abu Sneineh neighbourhood in the city of Hebron and opened fire, while patrolling the area.
- <u>Arrest</u>: The Israeli army arrested Na'im Mohammed Sleimiyyeh in the town of Idhna.

ALL DISTRICTS	The ceasefire agreement that entered into force at 06:00 on 26 November 2006 remains effective. However, the Israeli army carried out 1 raid into Palestinian territory. In addition, the Israeli army and navy opened fire on 3 occasions.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases. Raid: At 14:55, Israeli army infantry forces raided and combed Palestinian territory near Beit Hanun (Erez) Industrial Zone north of the town of Beit Hanun, thereby violating the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement. Palestinian Security Measure: At 14:55, Palestinian security forces blocked an attempt by armed Palestinian individuals to fire 2 mortars towards the Green Line. Palestinian security forces also seized the 2 mortars along with their launching pads.
GAZA	Activities not reported.
CENTRAL GAZA	Attack: At 11:40, the Israeli army opened fire from the area near Point 114 on the Green Line towards a number of civilians, while they were tending sheep, east of Al Bureij refugee camp.
KHAN YUNIS	<u>Attack</u> : At 10:10, the Israeli army opened fire from the area near Point 158 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the area of Al Qarara.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. Attack: At 17:55, Israeli navy boats opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea opposite the beach of the city of Rafah.

	 Administrative Detentions: (i) The Israeli authorities renewed an order of administrative detention
POLITICAL PRISONERS	 (i) The Israeli authorities renewed an order of administrative detention (arrest without charge or trial) against Ghalib Ali 'Asakreh for a period of 4 months for the 6th consecutive time. (ii) The Israeli authorities renewed orders of administrative detention against 14 political prisoners held in An Naqab (Ketziot) Military Detention Camp for various periods of time.
