DISTRICT	EVENT		
ALL DISTRICTS	Since 22 March 2004, the Israeli army has imposed a total closure over the West Bank and Gaza Strip. The Israeli army prevented civilians from crossing the Green Line and entering Jerusalem and restricted movement between cities in the West Bank.		

WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in Abu Dis, Al Eizariya, Al Sawahira al Sharqiya, Sur Bahir, along the main road between Jerusalem and Ramallah (Dahiyat Al Bareed, Ar Ram), the villages of Qatanna and Biddu, the area surrounding Qalandiya Airport and the village of Anata. Physical Assault: Israeli army soldiers physically assaulted and injured a Palestinian civilian at a checkpoint set up near the town of Ar Ram. The civilian was handcuffed and left bleeding on the road for 1 hour, after which he was taken to hospital.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Closure: The Israeli army set up dozens of flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in Rantis, Budrus, Midya, Ni'lin, Deir Qaddis, Beit Liqya and Beituniya. Raids/Curfew: At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit Ur at Tahta and imposed curfew. At 15:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah, took position near a Palestinian National Security location, and searched 1 house. At 21:45, an Israeli army patrol raided and patrolled the city of Al Bireh. At 23:30, an Israeli army patrol raided and patrolled the village of Kafr Ein.

JENIN	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact economic and livelihood activities and impedes access to health facilities. Wall Construction: Land levelling for wall construction was resumed in Jalbun towards Al Mutilla, Raba, Al Mughayyir, Bardala and 'Ein al Beida and towards the Jordan River. Raids: The Israeli army raided the village of Salim and arrested 1 civilian. The Israeli army raided the village of Silat Al Harithiya, searched 1 civilian house, and arrested 1 civilian. Arrests: At 15:00, the Israeli army arrested Samer Abd Al Qader Samara at a checkpoint set up at the entrance to the village of Jaba'. The Israeli army arrested Basem Samih Amarna in the village of Salim. The Israeli army arrested Khaled Jaradat in the village of Silat Al Harithiya. Demonstration: Women from the city of Jenin demonstrated near the Israeli military court in Salim in solidarity with Palestinian political prisoners. The Israeli army fired tear gas and sound bombs towards the protestor, injuring several civilians as a result of tear gas inhalation.
JERICHO	Closure: The Israeli army set up dozens of checkpoints throughout the city, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and prevented civilians from crossing. The Israeli army declared the city of Jericho a closed military zone.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing civilians from crossing. The Israeli army continues to close the only road leading to the village of Al Nu'man, northeast of the Bethlehem district, isolating the village and placing it together with the adjacent village of Al Khas under the jurisdiction of the Jerusalem municipality. The Israeli army considers the civilian's presence in the villages illegal. Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall was resumed north of the district of
	Bethlehem, west of Wadi Hilwa, near the Armenian monastery, on the

	Jerusalem-Bethlehem road and along the tunnel road (Gilo) and road #60 towards the village of Husan. (ii) The Israeli Supreme Court ruled for the cancellation of construction of a portion of the Wall in the area parallel to 'Ayda refugee camp. • Attack: At 20:40, the Israeli army opened indiscriminate fire towards civilian houses in the town of Al Khadr. • Raid: At 20:40, the Israeli army raided Ayda refugee camp and searched 1 house. • Injury: At 09:00, a bomb left by the Israeli army exploded in the area of Arab ar Rashayida, severely injuring Naief Mohammad ar Rashayida, 11 years old.	
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact economic and livelihood activities and impedes access to health facilities. Raids: At 21:40, an Israeli army patrol raided the village of Anabta and set up a checkpoint in the centre of the village. At 23:00, the Israeli army raided Tulkarm refugee camp and withdrew from the camp at 05:00. At 23:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarm and its suburbs and withdrew from the area at 05:00. 	
NABLUS	 Closure: The Israeli army set up dozens of flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Raid: At 19:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Nablus, Balata refugee camp, and the village of Kafr Qalil. Detention: At 15:30, the Israeli army detained dozens of civilians until 17:00 at Huwwara checkpoint. 	
HEBRON	 <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. <u>Physical Assault</u>: Israeli army soldiers physically assaulted and severely injured 1 civilian in the old city of Hebron. 	

Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. **QALQILYA** Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact economic and livelihood activities and impedes access to health facilities. Raid: At 13:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Qalqiliya. **Closure:** The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Construction: Land levelling for construction of the Wall west of the **SALFIT** village of Iskaka, north of the city of Salfit (surrounding the settlement of Ariel) and in the villages of Al Zawiya and Deir Ballut was suspended following an Israeli Supreme Court order to halt construction in the area pending hearing of the case before the court. **Raid:** At 23:25, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Salfit.

GAZA STRIP

Closure: The junction of Nitsareem remains closed. Attack: At 17:20, the Israeli army fired 1 tank shell from its location surrounding the settlement of Nitsareem towards 1 civilian vehicle travelling along Salah ad Din road south of the city of Gaza, destroying the car and killing 4 civilians. Raid: At 15:25, the Israeli army, including 1 tank and 2 bulldozers, raided the area north of Nitsareem and east of Ash Sheikh 'Ajlin road, opened intensive fire, and fired 3 tank shells towards 1 civilian building south of the city of Gaza. At 17:15, the Israeli tank opened fire again towards an **GAZA CITY** ambulance and injured its driver. Killings: The Israeli army killed 4 civilians on Salah ad Din road: Mohammad Mahdi Abu Zir; Mahmoud Abu Namos: (ii) Hasan Nafiz Abu Dalal: and (iii) Abdel Rahman Ayesh. (iv) **Palestinian Attacks:** At 16:00. 1 mortar was fired towards the settlement of Nitsareem. (i) (ii) At 02:10, 1 Qassam Mortar was fired towards the Green Line. **Attack:** At 01:00, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location **CENTRAL** surrounding the settlement of Kfar Daroom towards civilian houses in GAZA Abu Arif Street, east of the city of Deir Al Balah. **Closure:** (i) Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. (ii) Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. **KHAN YUNIS** Al Mawasi/Khan Yunis road (Al Tuffah checkpoint) is partially open. (iii) (iv) Abu Holi road is partially open. **Attack:** At 01:00, the Israeli army tank fired 1 tank shell from its location at Point 12 towards civilian houses in Al Namsawi and the cemetery area. **Closure:** (i) The Gaza International Airport remains closed. The Rafah crossing is closed for 24 hours. (ii) **Attacks**: **RAFAH** At 09:10, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location at (i) Point 6 on the Egyptian border towards civilian houses in Al Shabora neighbourhood in the city of Rafah, killing 1 female child. At 10:40, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location at the (ii) military checkpoint in Tal Zo'rob towards civilian houses, injuring 2 civilians, including 1 child.

- (iii) At 01:00, the Israeli army opened intensive fire towards civilian houses in Al Barazil and As Salaam neighbourhoods.
 - <u>Killing</u>: The Israeli army killed Halima Awda Abu Samhadana, 16 years old, in Al Shabora Nieghbourhood in the city of Rafah.
 - <u>Palestinian Attack</u>: At 07:40, 1 Qassam Mortar was fired towards the settlement of Rafah Yam.

GENERAL

POLITICAL PRISONERS • Prison Conditions: (i) 150 political prisoners in Section 9 of Bir al Sab'e Prison continue their hunger strike for the 6th consecutive day in protest against their inhumane prison conditions and their isolation from the outside world. (ii) Palestinian political prisoners in all Israeli prisons held a 1 day hunger strike on 11 July 2004 in solidarity with prisoners in Galbo'a Prison and in protest against the physical assaults by the prison administration against them last week, during which 20 prisoners were injured.
