ALL DISTRICTS	Beginning at 23:55 on 12 July 2005, the Israeli army continues to impose a total closure on the West Bank and Gaza Strip, preventing civilians and workers from crossing the Green Line, following the suicide attack carried out in the Israeli city of Netanya.	

WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: Israeli troops positioned at checkpoints set up at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem continue to prevent civilians from other districts from entering the city. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and An Nabi Samwil checkpoints and impede civilian access. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, and in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina. Destruction of Property: The Israeli army destroyed 1 civilian vehicle (using explosives), while it was parked near the Wall, in the city of Jerusalem.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, and in the town of Beituniya. Flying Checkpoints: At 09:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Jifna, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded access to civilians in both directions. At 03:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the villages of An Nabi Salih and Kafr 'Ein and searched civilians and vehicles until 05:10. The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and at the entrance to the town of 'Abud, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian movement. Physical Assault/Detention: The Israeli army detained and severely beat a number of international peace activists in the village of Bil'in. Raids/Detention: At 11:15, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Mazari' an Nubani.

NABLUS	 Checkpoint: At 15:25, the Israeli army closed Huwwara checkpoint south of the city of Nablus, preventing civilians from crossing, arrested 1 civilian, and reopened the checkpoint at a later time. At 17:00, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint again. Flving Checkpoint: At 14:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area of Al Maslakh (the 'Slaughterhouse') at the eastern entrance to the city of Nablus and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: At 23:55, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Nablus. Arrest: Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint arrested 1 unidentified civilian. Settler Violence: At 15:30, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Shilo assaulted with knives 2 children from the village of Qaryut north of the settlement. Israeli settlers killed 1 child as a result of several stab wounds. Killing: Israeli settlers killed Yazan Mohammed Johar, 12 years old, in the vicinity of the village of Qaryut. Palestinian Attack: At 17:00, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire from a vehicle towards an Israeli army patrol near the village of Kafr Qalil south of the city of Nablus. 		
SALFIT	• Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the north-eastern entrance to the city of Salfit through the village of Yasuf with cement blocks. The		

	Israeli army opens the road from 06:00 until 18:00 only. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). • Checkpoints:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various times in the morning, impeding civilian movement.
	 (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access in both directions. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the town of Deir Ballut
	near the Green Line, in the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, north of the city of Salfit, and between the village of Marda and the settlement of Ari'el.

The Israeli army continues to prevent farmers not holding Jericho IDs from reaching their agricultural land, forcing them to apply for access permits. At various times, the Israeli army also impeded civilian movement into the city of Jericho.

BETHLEHEM	 <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man, in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers civilians' residence in the village illegal. <u>Checkpoint</u>: At 09:30, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint, impeding civilian access.

- (ii) At 13:30, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided 'Ayda refugee camp. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. At 03:10, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp again and searched 1 house, after detaining residents.
- (iii) At 14:45, the Israeli army, including 4 tanks, raided the town of Al Khadr and took position near schools in the town.
- (iv) At 15:15, the Israeli army, including 14 jeeps, raided Al 'Aza refugee camp, opened indiscriminate fire, searched 2 houses, and arrested 1 Palestinian National Security officer.
- (v) At 01:00, Israeli army infantry forces raided and patrolled Ad Duheisha refugee camp.

• Arrests:

- (i) The Israeli army arrested Hasan Mousa Hamdan in the city of Bethlehem.
- (ii) The Israeli army arrested Sami Mohammed Khalil, a Palestinian National Security officer, in Al 'Aza refugee camp.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh in the H2 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks and barbed wire, denying civilians and vehicles access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shallala Street with cement blocks.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and as Samoa'.

• <u>Flying Checkpoint/Physical Assault</u>: At 02:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit 'Awwa, searched civilians and vehicles, and severely beat 1 taxi driver.

• **Physical Assault:** At 18:20, an Israeli soldier ran over 79-year-old Ahmed Younes al Jawabreh in the vicinity of Al 'Arrub refugee camp.

• Raids:

- (i) At 10:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Adh Dhahiriya and searched 1 house.

- Palestinian Security Measure: At 16:25, a Palestinian security patrol blocked an attempt by armed Palestinian individuals to fire 1 mortar from the area east of the village of 'Abasan towards the Green Line. Palestinian security forces confiscated the mortar.

POLITICAL PRISONERS

• Torture of Female Political Prisoner: 'Abeer Mohammed 'Odeh, a female political prisoner, has been subject to torture during the initial phase of her interrogation at Hasharon Prison. Israeli interrogators severely beat 'Abeer on the head, poured cold water on her, pulled her by the hair, and subjected her to position abuse (Shabeh) on a bed for over 20 days. 'Abeer suffers from severe breathing difficulties, backache, infections in the urinary tract, and a swollen abdomen.
