| ALL DISTRICTS | Since 22 March 2004, the Israeli army has imposed a total closure over the West Bank and Gaza Strip. The Israeli army prevented civilians from crossing the Green Line and entering Jerusalem, closed crossing points to workers, and restricted movement between cities in the West Bank. | |

WEST BANK

| JERUSALEM | Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the city, closing all roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Al Eizariya, Abu Dis, Al Sawahira al Sharqiya, Sur Bahir, Qatanna, Biddu, along the main road between Dahiyat Al Bareed checkpoint and Qalandiya checkpoint, and near Qalandiya airport. House Demolition: The Israeli army demolished a 2-storey house belonging to Rami Shamasna in the village of Qatanna, claiming that it was in close proximity to the Wall, despite the fact that it was constructed several months ago. | |

Wall Construction: Construction of the western portion of the Wall continues in Budrus, Deir Qaddis, Rantis, Ni'lin, Beit Liqya, Beituniya and near the village of Midya. Physical Assault: At 16:30, the Israeli army severely beat Osama Hasan Barghouti, who was hospitalised for injuries sustained during the attack. Raids: At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Qaddis and arrested 1 college student. At 13:30, the Israeli army raided the city of El Bireh and arrested 2 civilians. At 23:40, the Israeli army raided the cities of Ramallah and El Bireh, detained 1 vehicle and arrested 3 civilians. At 00:25, the Israeli army raided the towns Beit Rima and Deir Ghassana and patrolled the area. | |

| JENIN | Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall continues south of Jalbun towards Al Mutilla, Raba, Al Mughayyir, Bardala and 'Ein al Beida and towards the Jordan River. Raid: At 02:35, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin, opened intensive fire, killing 1 civilian, searched several houses, arrested 2 civilians and detained 2 others. Killing: The Israeli army killed Ma'mun Hussein Al Zar'ini in the city of Jenin. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the city of Jenin: (i) Fadi Muhammad Yusif Iram; and (ii) Mu'tasim Hussein Al Za'bari. |
| JERICHO | Closure: The Israeli army set up dozens of checkpoints throughout the city, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and prevented civilians from crossing. Arrest: At 12:50, the Israeli army arrested Nizar Mahmoud Abul Rub, a Palestinian National Security officer, at a checkpoint set up in the village of Al Duyuk. |

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing civilians from crossing.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the only road leading to the village of Al Nu'man, northeast of the Bethlehem district, isolating the village and placing it under jurisdiction of the Jerusalem municipality.
- Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall continues north of the district of Bethlehem, west of Wadi Hilwa, near the Armenian monastery, on the Jerusalem-Bethlehem road and along the tunnel road (Gilo) and road #60- Husan.

BETHLEHEM (i)

- (i) At 05:00 on 9 June 2004, the Israeli army raided the city of Beit Jala and arrested 1 civilian.
- (ii) At 05:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Khadr and opened indiscriminate fire, injuring 1 civilian.

TULKAREM

- <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing.
- <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities.

Raids:

- (i) At 12:00, an Israeli army jeep raided the village of Izbat Al Jarrad and patrolled the area. At 18:45, the Israeli army fired sound bombs towards civilians.
- (ii) At 17:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Qaffin and opened intensive fire.
- (iii) At 22:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and patrolled the area. At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the area and arrested 1

| | civilian. (iv) At 02:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Bal'a and patrolled the area. Arrests: (i) At 16:00, the Israeli army arrested Abdul Rahman Bassis, a Palestinian National Security officer, at a checkpoint near the village of Al Funduq. (ii) The Israeli army arrested Shadi Riyad Al Jizmawi in the city of Tulkarem. |

| NABLUS | Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Raid/Curfew: At 13:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, occupied 1 building, converted it into a military post, and opened fire, injuring 1 civilian. At 21:30, the Israeli army, including 8 jeeps, raided the area again, destroyed street lamps, and detained worshipers in Salah ad Din mosque following evening prayers. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the area again, fired sound bombs, arrested 2 civilians, and searched and destroyed the contents of 1 house. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the city of Nablus, including Basim Arafat. On 8 June 2004, the Israeli army arrested Ammar Yaqoub Aqra', a college student, at Huwwara checkpoint. |
| HEBRON | Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Curfew: At 12:15, the Israeli army imposed curfew over the neighbourhood of Bab Al Zawiya and the old city of Hebron. The curfew remains in effect as of 08:00 this morning. Raids: At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Idhna and searched several houses. At 12:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Kharas and arrested 1 Palestinian Police officer. At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, searched several houses and arrested 3 civilians. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 1 officer in the village of Kharas: Ibrahim Abdul Halim Halahla, a Palestinian Police officer. Suleiman Al Hureizat; |

| QALQILYA | Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. |
| SALFIT | Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing dozens of entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Construction: The Israeli authorities continue to level cultivated land west of the village of Al Zawiya for construction of the Wall. Raid: At 22:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Salfit and patrolled the area. Demonstration: At 11:00, a demonstration took place in the village of Al Zawiya against construction of the Wall in the village. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 6 civilians and several others due to tear gas suffocation. |
