<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ALL DISTRICTS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JERUSALEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was resumed in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 01:55, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Qalandiya refugee camp.</li> <li>(ii) At 02:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bir Nabala.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Demonstration:</b> At 12:00, a mass demonstration took place near Qalandiya refugee camp in protest against Wall construction.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RAMALLAH &amp; EL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the settler bypass road connecting 'Assur Hill in the village of Kafr Malik to Alon settler bypass road.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was resumed in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the villages of An Nabi Salih, Qarawat Bani Zeid, and Mazari' an Nubani.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh.</li> <li>(iii) At 00:10, the Israeli army raided the village of Rafat and searched a number of houses.</li> <li>(iv) At 01:30, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Beituniya.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrest:</u></b> At 18:00, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara arrested Usama Mahmoud Makhoulf, a Palestinian Police officer.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JENIN</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour roads leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up 4 flying checkpoints: 3 on the junctions to the town of Az Zababida as well as the villages of Rummana and Al Kufeir and 1 in the area between the town of Qabatiya and the village of Misliya. Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Rummana arrested 2 civilians.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Az Zababida and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 07:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one between the town of Kafr Ra'i and the village of Fahma and the other between the town of Qabatiya and the village of Misliya, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin. At 02:00, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps and 1 bulldozer, raided the city again and patrolled the area.</li> <li>(ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Az Zababida as well as the villages of Al Kufeir and ‘Aqqaba.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Rummana arrested 2 civilians: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) ‘Izz ad Din Khaled Marahin; and</li> <li>(ii) Mohammed Khamis Ghuzeil.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.</li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal’a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to ‘Attil plain; the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa; the road to the town of Deir al Ghusun’s plain; and the entrance to the village of ‘Izbat Abu Khamish.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at ‘Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city).</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:00, and again at 00:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Bal’a and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Ramin and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 01:35, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 04:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:20, the Israeli army raided Dahiyat Dhinnaba in the city of Tulkarem, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 04:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrest:</u></b> The Israeli army arrested Mahir Ali ‘Azayzeh in Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem.</li> </ul>
<b>QALQILIYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun as well as the road connecting the town of ‘Azzun to the village of ‘Izbat at Tabib.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Land levelling for Wall construction was resumed in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Habla tunnel (the southern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya) and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance to the town of ‘Azzun and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Jayyus and searched 1 house.</li> <li>(ii) At 17:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Ras Tira, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> A group of Israeli settlers set fire to civilian land cultivated with wheat and olive trees in the villages of Far’ata and Kafr Qaddum near the settlement of Kfar Kedumim and the settlement outpost of Gilead.</li> </ul>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Al Lubban ash Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. The Israeli army also searches civilians using metal detectors at Beit Iba checkpoint, impeding their access.</li> <li>(ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only.</li> <li>(iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30.</li> <li>(iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.</li> <li>(v) At 09:30, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Al Badhan checkpoint and impeded civilian access.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint/Detentions:</u></b> At 15:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Talluza, searched civilians and vehicles, and detained a number of civilians.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Attacks/Palestinian Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 19:00, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Nablus.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:25, and after armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Qalil and opened indiscriminate fire, while patrolling the area.</li> <li>(iii) At 23:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Burqa and fired sound grenades, while patrolling the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On 08 June 2007, Israeli troops positioned at Beit Iba checkpoint arrested 17-year-old Hisham Hakam Abdul Wahhab.</li> <li>(ii) At 19:30, Israeli troops positioned at Beit Iba checkpoint arrested Anas Karkarawi, a university student.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>SALFIT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was resumed in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 20:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the village of Marda, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access until 21:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> At 00:50, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the town of Kifl Haris, claiming to be providing protection to a group of Israeli settlers on their visit to the Shrine of Prophet Thu al Kifl. At 04:00, the Israeli army and settlers withdrew from the area.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Arrests:</b> Israeli troops positioned at Al Hamra checkpoint arrested 2 brothers, including a Palestinian security officer: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Mahmoud Mustafa Bsharat, a Palestinian Police officer; and</li> <li>(ii) Majed Mustafa Bsharat.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Detentions:</b> At 15:30, the Israeli army detained 2 children near the settlement of Ma'ale Efrayim and released them at a later time.</li> </ul>
<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was resumed in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 21:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Al 'Asakira and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 18:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Al 'Ubeidiya.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, the town of Jannata, and the village of Harmala, set up 3 checkpoints, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area.</li> <li>(iii) At 01:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem as well as the villages of Beit Ta'mir and Khalayil al Luz.</li> <li>(iv) At 02:50, the Israeli army raided 'Ayda refugee camp and searched 1 house.</li> <li>(v) At 02:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar and arrested 1 civilian.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Arrest:</b> The Israeli army arrested Husam Kamel Taqatqah in the town of Beit Fajjar.</li> </ul>
<b>HEBRON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access to and from the area.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
    - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.
    - (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
  - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction was resumed in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
  - **Flying Checkpoints/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:**
    - (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Fawwar junction, searched civilians and vehicles, and detained a Palestinian Police vehicle, transporting 6 Police officers and 4 persons held in custody. At 11:40, Israeli troops released the detained officers and persons, after coordination with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).
    - (ii) At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul and searched civilians and vehicles.
  - **Raid:** At 11:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Idhna and searched 2 houses.
  - **Settler Violence:**
    - (i) At 18:50, a group of Israeli settlers severely 16-year-old Sa'di Nafez al Atrash near the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron, leaving him with injuries. Israeli settlers also broke the windshield of an ambulance, while it was transporting the injured child to hospital.
    - (ii) At 19:20, a group of Israeli settlers threw stones at civilian houses in Tal Rumeida neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Despite frequent violations, the ceasefire agreement that entered into force at 06:00 on 26 November 2006 remains effective.</li> </ul>
