WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS

The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to (i) Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al (ii) Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt (iii) barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall (ii) gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction to the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim and searched civilians and vehicles.
- The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village (ii) of Rafat and searched civilians and vehicles.

Raids: At 17:30, Israeli army infantry forces raided and patrolled the village of (i) Kafr 'Aqab. At 23:45, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit Duqqu and (ii) searched 2 houses. **House Demolition:** On 19 June 2007, the Israeli army demolished a 2-storey house belonging to Ayman al Mu'agget in the Silwan neighbourhood in the city of Jerusalem, claiming that it was built without the required license. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. The Israeli army continues to close the settler bypass road connecting (iii) 'Assur Hill in the village of Kafr Malik to Alon settler bypass road. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Oaddis. Attack: At 17:15, Israeli troops guarding the Wall south of the city of El RAMALLAH Bireh opened fire towards a number of children, allegedly for throwing stones. **EL BIREH** Raids/Curfew: At 01:50, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided the town of Beit (i) Rima, imposed curfew, searched a gas station, and withdrew at 02:25. At 17:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of 'Atara. (ii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of An Nabi (iii) Salih. At 03:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bir Zeit. (iv) At 03:35, the Israeli army, including 25 jeeps, raided the city of (v) Ramallah and Al Am'ari refugee camp, arrested 2 civilians, and withdrew at 04:50. **Arrests:** The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the city of Ramallah and Al Am'ari refugee camp: Taha Anwar Abu Zeitoin; and (i) Hamzeh Saleh Burghal. (ii) Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour roads leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. **Checkpoint:** The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of **JENIN** the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

Flying Checkpoints: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one on the (i) junction to the village of Al Kufeir and the other near the village of Sir, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern (ii) entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles. At 20:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to (iii) the village of Ash Shuhada' and searched civilians and vehicles. At 05:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to (iv) the village of Al Kufeir and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: At 11:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the area of Al Batin near the village of Kafr Dan and patrolled the area until 14:00. Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat (i) Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain; the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa; the road to the town of Deir al Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamish. **TULKAREM** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road (ii) connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to Dahiyat Dhinnaba in the city of Tulkarem. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city). Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Raid: At 02:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the city of Tulkarem and patrolled the area until 02:30. Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun as well as the road connecting the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Izbat at Tabib. **Wall Gates:** Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special (i) Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal **QALQILIYA** detector. Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. Raids/Attack/Injury: At 19:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Qalqiliya. (i) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Sanniriya and patrolled (ii) the area until 21:45.

	 (iii) The Israeli army raided the town of 'Azzun. While patrolling the area, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 1 civilian. Settler Violence/Injury: At 14:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over 67-year-old Ahmed Dawoud 'Aqel along the main road near the village of Kafr Qaddum, leaving him with critical injuries. 'Aqel was transported to an Israeli hospital for medical treatment.
NABLUS	Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Al Lubban ash Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. The Israeli army also searches civilians using metal detectors at Beit Iba checkpoint, impeding their access. (ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. (iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. Raids/Medical Obstruction/Attack/Injury: At 23:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and Balat arefugee camp and took position in front of the Al Watani Hospital. In the city of Nablus, an armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals, during which the Israeli army injured 1 civilian. The Israeli army also searched 1 building and 2 houses.
SALFIT	Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik.

Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut (i) checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara (ii) junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. Raids: At 22:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the town of Deir Istiya and searched 1 house. At 00:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Kafr ad Dik and patrolled (ii) the area until 02:00. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan (iii) and arrested 2 civilians. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan: As'ad Ribhi Rayyan; and (i) Rizq Khadher Rayyan. (ii) **<u>Detentions</u>**: At 12:40, the Israeli army detained 3 children, while they were tending sheep along the Trans-Samaria Highway near the village of Marda, and released them at a later time. Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and **JERICHO** impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. Attack: At 23:30, the Israeli army fired flares over the entrance to the village of 'Ein ad Duyuk. Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the BETHLEHEM town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat. **Raids:** (i) At 11:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Sahur. At 03:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, searched 1 (ii) house, and withdrew at 05:50.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access to and from the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 17:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron. At 23:25, the Israeli army raided the city again and arrested 1 civilian.
- (ii) At 23:20, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the town of Dura and searched 1 house.
- (iii) At 23:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Nuba and opened indiscriminate fire towards the forested area near the town.
- <u>Arrest</u>: The Israeli army arrested Bilal Tahseen Abu Markhiyyeh in the city of Hebron.

HEBRON

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 Beginning on 15 June 2007, the Israeli army has continued to close until further notice all border crossing points into the Gaza Strip, including Beit Hanun (Erez) and Rafah Crossing Points. Following prior coordination, the Israeli army only allows access to certain humanitarian cases through Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is closed. Only humanitarian cases are allowed access, after prior coordination. Palestinian Attacks/Israeli Air Attack: At 09:45, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line. At 13:30, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line. Consequently, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards the area near the southern entrance to the town of Beit Hanun. At 14:00, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line. At 20:55, 4 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al Muntar (Karnei) Crossing is closed. (ii) Ash Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is partially open for transportation of fuel. Raid/Attack: At dawn on 21 June 2007, the Israeli army, including a number of armoured vehicles, raided 500 metres into Palestinian territory east of Gaza city and opened intensive fire.
CENTRAL GAZA	• Palestinian Attack/Israeli Attack: At 06:40, armed Palestinian individuals fired 1 anti-tank mortar towards an Israeli army armoured vehicle. Consequently, the Israeli army opened fire towards the area, from which the mortar was fired.
KHAN YUNIS	• Raid/Air Patrol/Attacks/Injuries/House Occupations/Medical Obstruction: At 01:00 on 20 June 2007, Israeli Special Forces, supported by a number of Israeli army tanks and armoured vehicles, raided the town of Al Qarara, whilst combat helicopters patrolled the skies over the area. The Israeli army also opened intensive fire and fired tank shells towards civilian houses. While searching a number of houses, an armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals, during which the Israeli army killed 4 armed individuals and injured 4 others. In addition, the Israeli army occupied the roofs of a number of houses, converted them into military posts, and detained civilians between 15 and 40 years of age in a yard in the town. The Israeli army also denied access to ambulances, levelled approximately 12 dunums (2.965 acres) of agricultural land, demolished the wall of a school, converted the school into a military post, and damaged an electricity transformer. At 06:00 on 21 June 2007, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.
