#### WEST BANK

#### ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. This Israeli measure aims to prevent civilian demonstrations against the Israeli army's levelling of Dung Gate (Bab Al Maghariba) old road, which leads to Al Aqsa Mosque compound.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

#### Raids:

- (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Biddu.
- (ii) At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit Duqqu. While searching 2 houses, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians.

#### **JERUSALEM**

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil as well as the road to the village of Ras Karkar
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. At 21:30, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint, claiming to be investigating a suspicious object. The checkpoint was reopened at a later time.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.

#### • Raids/Attack/Provocation of Palestinian Forces/Injury:

# (i) At 16:15, Israeli Special Forces raided the city of El Bireh and opened fire towards the offices of the Palestinian Preventive Security Headquarters, injuring 1 Palestinian Preventive Security officer. Israeli Special Forces troops also arrested 1 Palestinian Preventive Security officer.

- (ii) At 02:20, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided Al Jalazun refugee camp, arrested 2 civilians, and withdrew at 02:40.
- (iii) At 02:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Bir Zeit and arrested 1 university student.

#### • Arrests:

(i) The Israeli army arrested Naji Jamal 'Arar, a Palestinian Preventive Security officer, in the city of El Bireh.

The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in Al Jalazun refugee camp:

- (ii) Sa'eed Nakhleh; and
- (iii) Mahdi Salah Rasheed.
- (iv) The Israeli army arrested Farouq 'Ilayyan in the town of Bir Zeit.

#### • Palestinian Security Measures:

- (i) At 09:00, Palestinian security forces handed over 10 illegal vehicles, seized in the city of Ramallah, to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).
- (ii) At 12:35, Palestinian security forces handed over Ilyaho Abraham, an Israeli settler located in the city of Ramallah, to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).

#### • Closure of Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the detour roads around the town of Silat adh Dhahr.

• <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- (ii) Beginning on 29 March 2007, the Israeli army has continued to regulate times to open Al Jalama and Salim Wall gates between 06:30 until 10:00 and 17:00 until 21:00 respectively.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Rummana and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Al Kufeir, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian.
- (iii) The Israeli army set up 4 flying checkpoints: on the junction to the town of 'Arraba; at the entrance to the town of Az Zababida; in the area between the town of Qabatiya and the village of Misliya; and in the area of As Suweitat east of the city of Jenin. Israeli troops positioned at these flying checkpoints searched civilians and vehicles.

#### Raids:

- (i) At 01:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin and patrolled the area until 04:30.
- (ii) At 04:00, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided the town of Qabatiya and searched a number of houses. An armed confrontation also took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilian residents of the village of Kafr Dan, while they working in an area inside the Green Line:
- (i) 'Allam Ni'man Mar'i; and
- (ii) 'Imad Ibrahim al 'Umari.
- (iii) Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al Kufeir arrested Qussay Tal'at Sawaftah.

#### TULKAREM

- <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.
- <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain, the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa, and the road to the town of Deir al Ghusun's plain.

#### • Checkpoints:

(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Tulkarem along the Tulkarem-Nablus road.

- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:
- (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. The Israeli army also searches civilians using metal detectors at Beit Iba checkpoint, impeding their access.
- (ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only.
- (iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30.
- (iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.
- (v) At 12:50, the Israeli army closed Huwwara checkpoint, denied civilian access in both directions, and arrested 1 child, ostensibly for locating explosive devices in his possession. At 13:50, the Israeli army reopened the checkpoint.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction to the village of Beita, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian, allegedly for locating a large sum of money in his possession.
- (ii) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and searched civilians and vehicles.
- <u>Physical Assaults</u>: At 20:50, Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint severely beat 2 civilians, leaving them with injuries and contusions:
- (i) Ali Isma'il Sharay'ah; and
- (ii) Zakariyya Ali Hindawi.

Both civilians were transported to Nablus Public Hospital for medical treatment.

#### • Raids/Attacks/Detentions/Destruction of Property:

- (i) At 17:45, the Israeli army raided the village of Burqa. While patrolling the area, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians.
- (ii) At 20:20, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of 'Aqraba.
- (iii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the eastern quarters of the city of Nablus, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles. The Israeli army also patrolled the area and withdrew at 21:40.
- (iv) At 21:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Sarra, searched 1 house, and detained 2 children, allegedly for throwing stones. At 21:45, the Israeli army released the 2 children.
- (v) At 21:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Sharaf and opened indiscriminate fire, while patrolling the area.

	<ul> <li>(vi) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and Balata refugee camp as well as searched a number of buildings and houses, using a civilian as a human shield. As residents were outside, the Israeli army removed the doors and windows of a house and fired sound grenades inside, setting the house furniture on fire. In addition, the Israeli army prevented Palestinian Civil Defence fire trucks from accessing the area to extinguish the fire. #### **JERICHO** Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. Flying Checkpoint: At 08:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of 'Ein ad Duyuk and searched civilians and vehicles. <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the (i) city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the detour roads (ii) leading to the town of Tuqu'. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the **BETHLEHEM** town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat. Raid: At 03:40, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided the town of Al Khadr, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian. **Arrests:** (i) At 11:30, the Israeli army arrested Khalil Ali Ghuneim, while he was reporting to the Israeli Intelligence agency in the settlement of Kfar 'Etzion. (ii) The Israeli army arrested Anwar Mohammed al 'Assa in the town of Al Khadr. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with **HEBRON** an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access to and from the area. Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to (ii)

implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrance to the area of Yaqin leading to the town of Bani Na'im and Wadi al Quff road leading to the town of Tarqumiya.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area until 15:30.
- (ii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 female civilian.
- <u>Arrest</u>: The Israeli army arrested Amani Salameh ad Darabi', a female civilian, in the town of Dura.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# ALL DISTRICTS • The ceasefire agreement that entered into force at 06:00 on 26 November 2006 remains effective. However, the Israeli army and navy opened fire on 6 occasions, resulting in the killing of 1 civilian. The Israeli army also carried out 6 raids into Palestinian territory. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 13 civilians, including 4 fishermen. Moreover, armed Palestinian individuals fired 3 mortars towards the Green Line, of which 1 mortar landed on Palestinian territory.

From 11:00 until 12:30, the Israeli army closed the Crossing in both directions.</li> <li>Attacks: In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, the Israeli army opened fire towards Palestinian territory, as follows: <ol> <li>At 15:20, the Israeli army opened fire from the area near Point 6 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.</li> <li>At 02:25, the Israeli army opened fire from the area near Point 28 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the town of Beit Hanun.</li> <li>Raids/Attack: In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, the Israeli army raided Palestinian territory, as follows:</li> <li>At 11:30, the Israeli army raided Palestinian territory northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya and opened fire towards a number of farmers, killing 1 farmer. The Israeli army also arrested 6 civilians.</li> <li>At 16:50, the Israeli army, including 10 armoured vehicles, raided 500 metres into Palestinian territory near Point 51 on the Green Line in the area of Abu Safiya east of the town of Beit Hanun. At 04:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> <li>Killing: The Israeli army killed Mas'oud Rajab Subh northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya:</li> <li>Sa'd Rajab Subh;</li> <li>Mohammed Al Baddi;</li> <li>Mohammed Kamel Shihadeh;</li> <li>Yayesh Asad al Yousef; and</li> <li>Yayesh Asad al Yousef; and</li> <li>Mas'oud Asad al Yousef.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Palestinian Attack: At 17:20, in violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, armed Palestinian individuals attempted to fire 1 unidentified</li> </ul>

- (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.
- (ii) Rafah Crossing is closed.
- (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.
- (iv) Karm Abu Slim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
- <u>Attacks</u>: In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, the Israeli army and navy opened fire, as follows:
- (i) At 21:40, the Israeli army opened fire from the area near Point 207 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory north of Sufa Crossing east of the city of Rafah.
- (ii) At 22:50, the Israeli navy opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea opposite the beach of the city of Rafah. Israeli navy officers also arrested 4 fishermen.
- <u>Raids/Attack</u>: In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, the Israeli army raided Palestinian territory, as follows:
- (i) At 14:50, the Israeli army, including 3 armoured vehicles, raided 30 metres into Palestinian territory near Point 219 on the Green Line northeast of the area of Ash Shoka east of the city of Rafah and withdrew at 20:00.
- (ii) At 21:40, the Israeli army, including 4 armoured vehicles, raided Palestinian territory near 222 on the Green Line east of the area of Ash Shoka east of the city of Rafah and opened indiscriminate fire towards civilian houses.
- (iii) At 23:10, the Israeli army, including 4 armoured vehicles, raided Palestinian territory near Point 235 on the Green Line southeast of Yasser 'Arafat International Airport and arrested 3 civilians.
- Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians east of the city of Rafah:
- (i) Mohammed at Tawil;
- (ii) Ahmed as Soufi; and
- (iii) Mustafa Abu Qourah.
- (iv) Israeli navy officers arrested 4 unidentified Palestinian fishermen at sea opposite the beach of the city of Rafah.
