## WEST BANK The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West **ALL** Bank. **DISTRICTS** At 24:00 on May 5, the Israeli army imposed an entire closure on the West Bank on the occasion of the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary for the establishment of the state of Israel, and denied civilian access into the city of Jerusalem and the Green Line, except for previously arranged humanitarian cases. The closure will continue until April 9. Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Agsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to (i) Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya **JERUSALEM** checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. **Flying Checkpoints**: (i) At 12:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of

- Beit Hanina.
- (ii) At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of Hizma, and searched civilians and vehicles.

At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the village of 'Azout, (iii) searched a number of civilian houses, arrested 1 civilians, and detained 1 military officer but released him later. Arrests: (i) The 4 civilians arrested in the town of Beita are: (a) Ammar Ahmad Bani Shamsa; (b) Qusay Bassem Bani Shamsa; (c) Mojahed Mohammad Dhiab; and (d) Ayman Ihsan. (ii) The civilian arrested in the village of 'Azmout is called Saleh Ibrahim Samara. **Demonstrations**: At 12:00, a public march set out in the city of Nablus in solidarity with Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current *Intifada* (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. In addition, the Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Yassouf and the **SALFIT** southern entrance to the village of Deir Istiyya with dirt barricades, as well as the southern entrance to the town of Kafl hares and the 2 northern entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Qarawa Bani Hassan. **Checkpoints:** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tara checkpoints and prevent civilian vehicles from traveling towards the town of Kafr al-Dik. At 17:00, the Israeli army closed Za'tara checkpoint and impeded traffic upon the arrest of a civilian under the

- (i) At 00:40 on May 5, the Israeli army arrested during a raid into the town of Beit Fajjar a civilian called Nader Mahmoud Taqatqa.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in the city of Bethlehem is called Mohammad Atallah al-Taamreh.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

## • Closure of Main Roads:

The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi

- neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of al-Fawwar and detained a number of civilians but released them at a later time.

- (iii) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Yatta. The raid recurred at 16:30 during which the Israeli army set up post in front of the national security forces quarters. In addition, the Israeli army clashed with civilians.
- (iv) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Sammou' and searched 1 civilian house.
- (v) at 20:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit 'Ummar, searched a number of civilian houses, and arrested 2 children.

- <u>Raids</u>: At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the area near Arafat International Airport east of the city of Rafah.
- Palestinian Attacks:
- (i) At 09:15, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
- (ii) At 13:00, two unidentified mortars were fired towards Sufa Crossing onn the Green Line.
- (iii) At 15:00, two unidentified mortars were fired towards Sufa Crossing on the Green Line.

## PRISONERS CONDITIONS

- The Israeli military court at Salem detention camp sentenced prisoner Mahmoud Ghaleb Mahmoud Jaradat from the town of Silet al-Harithiyyeh in Jenin district to 24 months in jail and a fine of 2000 shekels equivalent to 5600 US dollars, and prisoner 'Aladdin Mohammad Youssef Kamil from the town of Qabatia in Jenin district to 16 months in jail. In addition, the court extended the administrative detention of 9 prisoners from Jenin and Tulkarem districts.
- The Israeli military court I al-Jalama jail extended the administrative detention of 8 prisoners from Jenin, Qalqilya and Nablus disdtricts.
