WEST BANK The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West **ALL** Bank. **DISTRICTS** Since 24:00 on May 5, the Israeli army imposed an entire closure on the West Bank on the occasion of the 60th anniversary for the establishment of the state of Israel, and denied civilian access into the city of Jerusalem and the Green Line, except for previously arranged humanitarian cases. The closure will continue until April 9. Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Agsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to (i) Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.

JERUSALEM

- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.
- Wall Gates:
 - (a) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
 - (b) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west

	of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

JERICHO	(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.
	 (ii) At 13:00, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the D.C.O. checkpoint that is set up on the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and impeded traffic. Flying Checkpoints: at 16:45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the Dead sea junction, and searched civilians and vehicles.
BETHLEHEM	• Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An

- Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.
- (ii) At 12:50, the Israeli army closed the road that connects the city of Beir Sahour and the area of 'Ush Ghurab with dirt barricades.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:35, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem), and searched civilians and vehicles until 10:20
- (ii) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of al-Khader, and searched civilians and vehicles until 13:50.
- (iii) At 12:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Zaatara, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 13:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Jenata, and searched civilians and vehicles.

Raids

- (i) At 09:15, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Khader, physically attacked a number of civilians, and handed notifications to demolish 4 civilian houses under the pretext of unlicensed construction. The houses belong to Ahmad Mousa Abu al-Hatab, Ahmad Saleh Mousa, Mohammad Suleiman Salah, and Mahmoud Suleiman Salah. The raid recurred at 18:30 during which the Israeli army raided the town until 02:55.
- (ii) At 11:55, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Salah, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles until 13:50.
- (iii) At 22:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Teqoa, clashed with civilians, and patrolled the town until 22:35.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

Closure:

HEBRON

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with

- an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the area of al-Nabi Younis.
- (ii) At 12:00, the Israeli army set up 2 checkpoints on the entrance to the town of Dura and on the junction of al-Fawwar.
- (iii) At 15:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the town of Halhoul overpass and detained a civil police vehicle carrying 2 police officers. The vehicle was released at 19:40 upon the intervention of the military liaison.
- (iv) At 16:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Sa'ir, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (v) At 20:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the village of Deir Samet, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (vi) At 21:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the town of Sa'ir and the village of al-Adiseh, and arrested 1 civilian.

Raids:

(i) At 19:30, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al-Arroub, clashed

with civilians and injured a child called Mohammad Majed al-Raie, 12, with as bullet in his back. The Israeli army withdrew at 20:10.

- (ii) At 19:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura.
- (iii) At 19:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bani Na'im, and set up a checkpoint.
- (iv) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron. The raid recurred at 00:45 during which the Israeli army searched 1 mosque and o1 civilian house.
- (v) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Halhoul and clashed with civilians during patrol.
- (vi) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Yatta.

• Arrests:

- (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army arrested a child called Jihad Abdel Mohsen Jihad Daana, 15, in the city of Hebron and took him to the investigation center at Opher detention camp.
- (ii) The civilian arrested between the town of Sa'ir and the village of al-Adiseh is called Talaat Zeidan Jaradat.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

CENTRAL GAZA	Palestinian Attacks: At 18:05, armed individuals detonated a 50 kilogram explosive near an Israeli military jeep on the Green Line near the area of Abu Mandil east of the refugee camp of al-Maghazi.
KHAN YOUNIS	 Attacks: At 13:00, the Israeli army opened fire from its posts inside the Green Line towards civilian houses in the area of al-Farrahin east of the town of Abassan al-Kabira. Deaths: in the evening of May 8, a civilian called Sami Jamil Abu Anza died of injuries sustained during an Israeli raid into the village of Abassan al-Saghira on May 7.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: (All closed) (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (al-Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (i) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) is closed. Attacks: At 24:00, Israeli navy boats fired missiles towards fishing boats on the shore of Rafah.
