# **WEST BANK**

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.</li> <li>Since 24:00 on May 5, the Israeli army imposed an entire closure on the West Bank on the occasion of the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary for the establishment of the state of Israel, and denied civilian access into the city of Jerusalem and the Green Line, except for previously arranged humanitarian cases. The closure will continue until May 17.</li> </ul>
JERUSALEM	Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.  Closure of Main Roads:  The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.  The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.  The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.  Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.  Attacks: At 17:10, the Israeli army stationed at Qalandia military checkpoint opened fire and fired tear gas bombs towards civilians under the pretext of stone throwing.  Wall Gates:  (a) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.  (b) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.  Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish

	weekend in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Safa.

	the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current
	Intifada (Uprising).
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western
	entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. In addition, the Israeli army
	continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Yassouf and the
	southern entrance to the village of Deir Istiyya with dirt barricades, as
	well as the southern entrance to the town of Kafl hares and the 2
	northern entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Qarawa
	Bani Hassan.
	(iii) At 21:50, the Israeli army removed the dirt barricade set up at the
	western entrance to the village of Marda.

JERICHO	<ul> <li>Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> <li>Arrests: At 12:15, the Israeli army arrested at al-Karama (Allenby) Crossing a civilian called Ghaleb Abdel Jalil Ideis from the city of Hebron while he was on his way to Jordan.</li> </ul>
BETHLEHEM	<ul> <li>Closure: <ul> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.</li> <li>Closure of Main Roads: <ul> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>(ii) At 12:50, the Israeli army closed the road that connects the city of Beir Sahour and the area of 'Ush Ghurab with dirt barricades.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Flving Checkpoints: <ul> <li>(i) At 08:55, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of al-Shawawreh, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on al-Nashash junction (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem), and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 20:05, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the debris of Ush Ghurab military camp east of the city of Beit Sahour, and searched civilians and vehicles until 21:40.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Raids: <ul> <li>(i) At 13:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:25, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Salah and set up a checkpoint. The raid recurred at 23:00 during which the Israeli army set up a checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Khader.</li> <li>(iv) At 00:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Beit</li> </ul> </li> </ul></li></ul>

Fajjar.

• <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 10:05, a bunch of settlers entered the debris of Ush Ghurab military camp east of the city of Beit Sahour and raised the Israeli flag. The Israeli army evacuated the settlers.

### • <u>Demonstrations</u>:

- (i) At 11:30, a public march set out with the participation of international peace activists and supporters in the village of al-Maasara in protest of the apartheid wall construction.
- (ii) At 12:30, a public c march set out in the town of al-Khader and marchers held Friday noon prayer on land threatened with confiscation.
- (iii) At 13:15, a public march set out with the participation of international peace activists and supporters in the city of Beit Sahour and civilian marchers headed towards the debris of the previously evacuated Ish Gurab military camp.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

## • Closure of Main Roads:

The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.

# **HEBRON**

(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

#### Raids:

- (i) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron. The raid recurred at 21:30.
- (ii) At 00:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Tafouh
- (iii) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Beit Kahel.
- (iv) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Halhoul.
- <u>Attacks</u>: At 12:00, the Israeli army fired on Hebron Bethlehem main road alongside the refugee amp of al-Arroub rubber coated bullets and tear gas bombs toward children under the pretext of stone throwing.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

• <u>Raids</u>: At dawn May 17, the Israeli army has been raiding east of the town of Jabalia. The Israeli army opened fire intensively and fired tank bombs towards civilian houses. In addition, Israeli troops raids agricultural land, and green houses.

#### • Attacks:

# (i) At 23:30, the Israeli army fired tank missiles from its posts inside the Green Line towards armed individuals near the town of Sheikh Zayed east of the town of Beit Lahia.

(ii) At dawn on May 17, the Israeli army opened fire towards fishing boats in the area of al-Soudaniyyeh north-west of the town of Beit Lahia.

#### • Air Attacks:

- (i) At 13:30, an Israeli drone fired 1 missile towards armed individuals east of the city of sheikh Zayed north-east of the town of Beit Lahia.
- (ii) At 15:40, an Israeli drone fired 1 missile towards armed individuals in the area of Tel Qleibo east of the town of Beit Lahia and seriously injured 2 armed individuals.

#### • Palestinian Attacks:

(i) At 18:20, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the

Green Line.  (ii) In the evening of May 17, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.  (iii) At dawn on May 17, one unidentified mortar was fired
towards the Green Line.
