WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints near the junctions to the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim and the area of Al Khan al Ahmar and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Dahiyat Bir Nabala and denied civilian access in both directions.

Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western (ii) entrance to the village of Saffa. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank. **RAMALLAH** Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to & Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in **EL BIREH** the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud and the village of Beit Sira. Flying Checkpoint: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Rantis and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: At 16:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Mazra'a al Gharbiya. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. Palestinian Attack/Raid: At 01:30, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards the Israeli army forces positioned at 'Ofar military post. Consequently, the Israeli army, including 1 armoured vehicle and 10 jeeps, raided the town of Beituniya, searched 2 buildings, and withdrew at 03:00. Closure of Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. **Checkpoint:** The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 17:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area (i) between the town of Tubas and the village of 'Aggaba and searched civilians and vehicles. **JENIN** At 19:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints at the entrances to (ii) the towns of 'Arraba and Ya'bad and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid/Air Patrol: At 13:30, Israeli troops, dispatched by a combat helicopter, raided and (i) combed an area near the village of Kashda. At 20:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Mirka. (ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Deir Abu Da'if and arrested 2 (iii) civilians. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Deir Abu Da'if: Mus'ab Ziyad Yaseen; and (i) Basem Khalil Mahameed. (ii)

Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, and the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain. **Checkpoints/Detentions:** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav (i) checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road as well as at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem). At 09:20, the Israeli army closed 'Einav checkpoint and denied civilian (ii) access. Until 12:00, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint also detained hundreds of civilians, including students from An Najah University in the city of Nablus. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. TULKAREM **Flying Checkpoints:** At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to (i) the village of Al Jarushiya and searched civilians and vehicles. At 12:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to (ii) the town of Bal'a and searched civilians and vehicles until 13:50. At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area (iii) between the town of Beit Lid and the village of Kafr Sur and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 16:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Baqa (i) ash Sharqiya, set up a checkpoint in the town's centre, and searched civilians and vehicles. The Israeli army also patrolled the area. At 00:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Tulkarem. (ii) Arrest: At 05:00 on 03 November 2006, the Israeli army arrested Amjad Ribhi Safaqah during its raid on the city of Tulkarem, in addition to those reported on 03 November 2006. Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. **Wall Gates:** Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special (i) Israeli permits. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma (ii) Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal **QALQILIYA** detector. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to school students under 16 years unless accompanied by one of their parents. Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.
	 Raids/Attack: (i) At 01:30, the Israeli army, including 8 jeeps, raided the city of Salfit, fired sound grenades, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian. At 02:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Iskaka, searched 2 houses, and withdrew at 04:00. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Bilal Tayseer Shaheen in the city of Salfit.
JERICHO	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the Jericho-Nablus road, denying civilian access, except for farmers holding Jericho IDs. At 18:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the DCO checkpoint set up at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and prevented civilians from exiting the city, only allowing access to those holding Jericho- and Jerusalem-issued IDs.
ВЕТНІЕНЕМ	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the "Container") checkpoint and to deny access to civilian vehicles, except for those possessing access permits. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, north of 'Ayda refugee camp, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal.

• Raids:

- (i) At 01:55, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided the town of Al 'Ubeidiya and arrested 3 civilians.
- (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem.
- (iii) At 03:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the cities of Bethlehem and Beit Sahur.
- Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the town of Al 'Ubeidiya:
- (i) Bilal Younes al 'Assa;
- (ii) Hisham Mohammed Radaydeh; and
- (iii) Abdullah Hasan Radaydeh.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; and the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

• Raids/School Disruption:

- (i) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kharsa as well as raided and searched the village's secondary school.

HEBRON

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- Beginning on 25 June 2006, the Israeli army has reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the northern and eastern borders of the district of Northern Gaza. Beginning on 28 June 2006, the Israeli army has also reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the eastern border of the district of Rafah.
- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases.
- Incursion/Air Patrol/Attacks/Medical **Obstruction/Injuries/Curfew:** Beginning at 01:20 on 01 November 2006, the Israeli army, covered by combat helicopters and reconnaissance aircraft, has continued to reinforce its presence in the town of Beit Hanun, the area of Abu Safiya, and Beit Hanun (Erez) Industrial Zone. Israeli armoured vehicles and combat helicopters also continued to open intensive fire and tanks continued to fire shells towards civilian houses, An Nassr Mosque, and Beit Hanun Public Hospital. The Israeli army's attacks resulted in the killing of 2 civilians, including 1 female child, and the injury of 5 other civilians. In addition, the Israeli army imposed curfew, searched a number of houses, and beat Nathmiyyeh al Kafarneh, a 60-year-old female civilian, inside the public hospital. Furthermore, the Israeli army detained 3 Palestinian National Security officers, demolished 3 houses, including a 4-storey house, and levelled agricultural land. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.
- House Demolitions: The Israeli army demolished 3 houses in the town of Beit Hanun belonging:

(i) Mohammed Ribhi Shabat, (the owner of the 4-storey house);

- (ii) Mohammed 'Atallah al Massri; and
- (iii) Sami Ibrahim Sa'adeh.

• Air Attacks/Destruction of Property:

- (i) At 13:00, an Israeli combat helicopter fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory near Al Ja'al gas station east of the town of Jabalya.
- (ii) At 13:25, an Israeli combat helicopter fired 2 missiles towards and damaged 1 house in the village of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu.
- (iii) At 14:00, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory near 1 house belonging to Rajab 'Abed Rabbu in the village of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu, causing damage to the house.
- (iv) At 14:25, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards 1 civilian vehicle near Al Qarm roundabout in the town of Jabalya, killing 1 civilian and destroying the vehicle. At 22:25, an Israeli UAV fired another missile towards the area, killing another civilian.

• Attacks/Air Patrols/Injuries:

- (i) At 12:25, the Israeli army fired 4 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory in the area surrounding the village of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu east of the town of Jabalya.
- (ii) At 16:40, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards civilian houses northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya, in the village of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu, and east of the town of Jabalya.

NORTHERN GAZA

- (iii) At 17:10, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards civilian houses northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (iv) At 18:50, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards civilian houses in the areas of At Tuwam and As Salatin as well as west of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (v) At 18:50, the Israeli army fired 4 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near the area of Al Hawuz north of the town of Beit Lahiya. Of those fired, 1 artillery shell did not explode.
- (vi) At 21:40, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards civilian houses in the area surrounding the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (vii) At 22:05, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards civilian houses in the area of As Sudaniya northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (viii) At 07:10, the Israeli army fired 1 missile mortar from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near Ash Sheikh Zayed city east of the town of the town of Beit Lahiya. The missile mortar landed near 1 bus transporting kindergarten pupils. As a result, 1 child present near the bus was killed and 10 children, several of whom are kindergarten pupils aboard the bus, were injured.

• Raids/Attacks/Injuries/Land Levelling/Destruction of Property:

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli Special Forces, supported later by 9 Israeli army armoured vehicles and 2 bulldozers, raided Palestinian territory and took position in the area of Al Waha, near the American School, and in the area of Al 'Atatira north and northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. The Israeli army also opened sporadic fire, killing 2 Palestinian security officers and injuring 4 civilians as well as 1 Palestinian Police officer. In addition, the Israeli army levelled agricultural land. The Israeli army remains positioned on Palestinian territory northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya as of 08:00 this morning.
- (ii) At 06:10, the Israeli army, including a number of armoured vehicles, raided Palestinian territory east of the village of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu as well as Al Qarm Street east of the town of Jabalya. The Israeli army also took position in the area surrounding Jabal ar Rayyes, opened intensive fire, and arrested 1 civilian. Additionally, the Israeli army destroyed a number of civilian houses along Al Qarm Street.
- Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Abdul Salam Hamdi Hasanat east of the town of Jabalya.
- **Killings:** The Israeli army killed 2 civilians in the town of Beit Hanun:
- (i) Wala' Abdul Kareem Nasser, a 13-year-old female child;
- (ii) Mahdi Khaled al Hamdein.

The Israeli air force killed 2 civilians near Al Qarm roundabout east of the town of Jabalya:

- (iii) Raed Sulh Abdul 'Aal: and
- (iv) An unidentified civilian.

The Israeli army killed 2 Palestinian security officers northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya:
