WEST BANK

| JERUSALEM | <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to prevent civilians from other districts from entering Jerusalem unless they are granted permits. <u>Religious Obstruction</u>: The Israeli army prevented many civilians from reaching al Aqsa Mosque. As a result, thousands of Palestinian Muslims were forced to pray in the streets, near the Old City gates and at Israeli checkpoints. |

| RAMALLAH & EL BIREH | Closures: Ramallah and El Bireh remain closed areas. The Israeli army closed the single entrance to the villages of Shuqba and Deir Abu Mash'al. Checkpoints: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Abud. At 12:15, the Israeli army removed the checkpoint of 'Ein Arik, which leads to all western villages. Raids: At 04:20, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and imposed curfew on the towns of Deir Ghassana, Beit Rima and Kafr 'Ein. Arrests: At 21:00, the Israeli army arrested Hasan Al Zaban, 28 years old, in Mazari' an Nubani. The Israeli army arrested Khalid Ibrahim Al Rimawi from the town of Beit Rima. Destruction of Property: At 19:40, the Israeli army set fire to the carpentry workshop belonging to Zahi Al Rimawi in the town of Beit Rima. Detention: At 18:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, detained a Colonel and other Palestinian Authority officials, as well as their vehicle and official jeep. |
| JENIN | Closure: Jenin remains a closed military area. Curfews: Between 03:00 and 18:00, the Israeli army imposed curfew over the town of Meithalun. At 22:30, the Israeli army lifted the curfew imposed on the city of Jenin, in place since 02:00 the previous day. |

- (iii) At 05:30, the Israeli army imposed curfew over the city and its refugee camp.
- Raid on School: The Israeli army raided the elementary school in the town of Meithalun, breaking doors and vandalizing other property.
- <u>Death</u>: At 16:30, the Israeli army opened fire from a tank in the eastern neighborhood in Jenin killing Muhammad Mustafa Abu Najma, a 20 year old resident.
- Raids:
- (i) At 04:30, the Israeli army, heavily reinforced, raided and imposed curfew on the town of Al Yamun, surrounded a house of a resident and arrested the brother of the man who was sought.
- (ii) At 05:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin.

• Arrests:

The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians from Meithalun:

- (i) Osama Nu'eyrat, 22 years old, from the Palestinian Police; and
- (ii) Muhammad Rabay'a, 38 years old.

The Israeli army arrested 5 civilians from the eastern neighborhood in the city of Jenin:

- (iii) Amjad Obeidi;
- (iv) Ali Muhammad Sa'di, 18 years old;
- (v) Ibrahim Ahmad Al Sa'di, 38 years old; and his brother,
- (vi) Yasin Ahmad Al Sa'di, 35 years old; and
- (vii) Isam Abu Ja'as, 22 years old.

The Israeli army arrested 1 civilian from his house in Al Yamun:

(viii) Anwar Mahmoud Abahra.

• House Demolition:

During their raid on Jenin city, the Israeli army completely destroyed 5 houses belonging to:

- (i) Yasin Al Sa'di (the house was 130m²);
- (ii) Ibrahim al Sa'di (the house had 3 rooms);
- (iii) Taleb Al Sa'di (the house was 120 m²);
- (iv) Ghaleb Al Sa'di (the house had 3 rooms); and
- (v) Ahmad Al Sa'di (the house had 3 rooms).

The Israeli army partially destroyed 4 other houses belonging to:

- (vi) Owni Ahmad;
- (vii) Muhammad Al Sa'di;
- (viii) Lailya Al Sa'di; and
- (ix) Kayid Al Sa'di.

• <u>Injuries</u>:

As a result of random firing in the city of Jenin, the Israeli army injured 2 boys and a young man:

- (i) Ala' Ighbariya, 14 years old, who was shot in the foot;
- (ii) Loay Al Sagheir, 15 years old, who was shot in the leg; and
- (iii) Rivad Al Jazara, 18 years old.

| JERICHO | Activity not yet reported. |

| BETHLEHEM | Closures: (i) Bethlehem is a closed military area. (ii) The DCO checkpoint on the DCO/Beit Jala road has been closed completely. (iii) The Bethlehem/ Eizariya road (Wadi Nar) was opened. (iv) All other roads remain closed. Raid: The Israeli army entered Palestinian territory (Area A) in Al Khadr and Beit Jala. |
| TULKAREM | Closures: The city of Tulkarem remains a closed military area. Checkpoints: At 08:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Bizzariya, where they detained and searched pedestrians and vehicles. At 09:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Iktaba, where they searched pedestrians and vehicles. At 08:30, the Israeli army allowed pedestrians to pass Al Kafriyat checkpoint. Raids: At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Shuweika, where they opened fire and fired tear gas grenades at civilian houses. At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Anabta, where they opened fire and fired tear gas grenades at in civilian areas. |
| NABLUS | Closure: Nablus remains a closed military area. Raid: At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the center of Nablus city as well as the old city. The Israeli force withdrew at 04:00. Attack: At 18:00, the Israeli army opened fire randomly from their locations around Balata refugee camp towards the camp. Killing: At 18:15, Muhammad Mahmoud Hashash, a 23 year old civilian and resident of Balata refugee camp, was shot and killed by the Israeli army during their raid on Balata refugee camp. |
| HEBRON | Closures: H1 and H2 areas remain closed military areas. The Israeli army continues to prevent civilians from opening their shops in H2 area of Hebron. |

| | Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Ibrahim Dabasa from the village of Khirbet Karmel, east of the town of Yatta. Settler Violence: (i) A settler physically assaulted students of the Ibrahimiya School. (ii) Settlers allowed their children to enter the Abraham Mosque and play with the holy books. |

| QALQILYA | Activity not yet reported. |
| SALFIT | Closure: The city of Salfit is a closed military area. Curfew: At 17:10, the Israeli army raided the village of Marda and imposed curfew. Air Patrol: At 18:30, Israeli helicopters patrolled over the city. Checkpoints: At 16:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the road between Qarawat Bani Zeid and Al Mazari'. At 16:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the road between Qarawat Bani Zeid and Farkha. Raids: At 15:15, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Qarawat Bani Zeid. At 15:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Iskaka, where they arrested 2 civilians. At 17:45, the Israeli army raided the village of Khirbet Qeis and the city of Salfit. The Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the village of Marda. Arrests: At 15:00, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians from Qarawat Bani Zeid: Ahmad Ata Bujeiri, originally from Gaza, and a member of Palestinian National Security located in Salfit; and Firas Al Manukh. Firas Al Manukh. At 15:50, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians from the village of Iskaka: Muhammad Muneer Ahmad Harb, 19 years old; and Bilal Ahmad Awad, 30 years old. The Israeli army arrested a civilian from Al Zawiya town on grounds that he has a Jordanian passport and not a Palestinian one. He will therefore be soon deported to Jordan. |

| NORTHERN GAZA | Activity not yet reported. |

| GAZA CITY | Closures: Al Shuhada' junction (Nitsareem) remains closed. Al Mintar crossing is closed. Attacks: At 09:29, the Israeli army fired shells from Point 71 towards the Palestinian Energy Authority, killing a child and injuring 3 others. At 22:35 and again at 23:20, the Israeli army opened fire and fired shells from the settlement of Nitsareem towards Al Zahra' city. Killing: The Israeli army killed Muhammad Hasan Al Qayid, a 10 year old, as a result of their attack at 09:29. |
| CENTRAL GAZA | <u>Attack</u> : At 22:30, the Israeli army opened fire from the settlement of Kfar Daroom towards the south and east. |
| KHAN YUNIS | <u>Closure</u>: Abu Ajin road and the western road remain closed. <u>Attack</u>: At 23:55, the Israeli army opened fire at civilian houses in Al Nimsawi neighborhood. |
| RAFAH | Closures: Sufa crossing is closed. The Gaza International Airport remains closed. Attack: At 20:00, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 5.5 towards Al Salam neighborhood, injuring 2 civilians including a baby. Injuries: The 3 civilians injured in Al Salam neighborhood included: Musa Sabah, 4 years old; and Musa Al Qadi. |
