# The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up **ALL** on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the **DISTRICTS** northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to al-Agsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to (a) Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-(b) Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt (c) barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. **JERUSALEM** Flying Checkpoints: At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the road of al-Nabi Samuel, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 09:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Qatannah. (i)

- (ii) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Anata, searched one house, arrested a female civilian, and withdrew at 15:00.
- (iii) At 02:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of al-Obeibeh.

Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. **Flying Checkpoints**: **BETHLEHEM** At 09:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the (i) town of Tegoa, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 19:30, the Israeli army set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances to the (ii) town of Za'tarah and the village of al-Shawawreh, and at the junction of the town of Jinata, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: (i) At 15:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Khalayel al-Loz. At 19:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Dar Salah and set up a (ii) checkpoint. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja. **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city (i) of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in **HEBRON** the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to (ii) implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.
