WEST BANK

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. • In protest and denunciation of the massacre committed by the Israeli army on the dawn 08 November 2006 in the town of Beit Hanun, a 3-day official mourning was declared, a general strike was observed throughout the West Bank, and demonstrations took place. In the Beit Hanun massacre, the Israeli army had killed 18 civilians and injured over 40 civilians, including numerous women and children.

<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Land Confiscation: On 05 October 2006, the Israeli army issued Military Order # T/84/06 for the confiscation of 176.7 <i>dunums</i> (44.175 acres) of land belonging to the town of 'Anata for Wall construction north of the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud and the village of Beit Sira. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:50, the Israeli army, including 20 jeeps, raided the city of El Bireh, searched 1 house, and arrested 2 civilians (brothers). At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the city again and patrolled the area. (ii) At 02:35, the Israeli army, including 15 jeeps, raided Al Am'ari refugee camp in the city of El Bireh, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian. At 03:40, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the city of El Bireh: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) 'Imad Matar ad Duqmaq; and (ii) Mahmoud Matar ad Duqmaq. (iii) The Israeli army arrested Ala' Jamal Jabr in Al Am'ari refugee camp. • Demonstration: At 12:10, a demonstration, including students at Bir Zeit University, took place in the town of Bir Zeit in protest against the massacre perpetrated by the Israeli army in the town of Beit Hanun. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and protesters near the overpass to the town of 'Atara.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Flying Checkpoints: At 06:15, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one at the southern entrance to the city of Jenin and the other on the junction to the town of Az Zababida, and searched civilians and vehicles.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids/Attack/Injury/Detentions/Destruction of Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the area of Al Bugei'a near the town of Tammun and searched 1 commercial shop. (ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin, set up a checkpoint at its southern entrance, and patrolled the area until 13:00. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli Special Forces, supported by 30 Israeli army jeeps, raided Jenin refugee camp and opened intensive fire, injuring 1 child. After detaining residents outside, the Israeli army also searched a number of houses and damaged furniture. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 10 civilians, among whom are 3 brothers and 3 children, including the injured child. At 08:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (iv) At 03:00, the Israeli army, including 15 jeeps, raided the town of Tammun, searched a number of houses, and arrested 1 civilian. At 05:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 10 civilians in Jenin refugee camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mahmoud 'Afeef ad Damaj, a 17-year-old injured child; (ii) Ismai'l Mohammed ad Damaj, 16 years old; (iii) Mohammed Ali ad Damaj, 17 years old; (iv) 'Imad Khaled ad Damaj; (v) Mahmoud Khaled ad Damaj; (vi) Najeeb Khaled ad Damaj; (vii) Taher Mohammed ad Damaj; (viii) Ibrahim Mohammed ad Damaj; (ix) Mohammed 'Afeef Hussein; and (x) Fadi Mahmoud Abdullah. TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, and the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road as well as at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Bal'a, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:50, Israeli troops positioned at the DCO offices west of the city of Tulkarem opened indiscriminate fire towards civilian houses in the city. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Tulkarem, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 17:05, the Israeli

Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: At 02:15 on 08 November 2006, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians during its raid on the city of Tulkarem and the village of ‘Izbat al Jarad: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mohammed Isma’il Abu Leefeh; and (ii) Talal Hasan ‘Atallah.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to school students under 16 years unless accompanied by one of their parents. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun. • Raid: At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Jayyus and arrested 1 civilian. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Ahmed Ali Nofal in the town of Jayyus.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. (ii) Nablus-‘Asira ash Shamaliya checkpoint (set up at the northern entrance to city) is open from 06:30 to 20:00. (iii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (iv) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. (v) At 08:00, the Israeli army reopened Al Badhan road (the eastern entrance to the city of Nablus) and allowed access to civilian vehicles in both directions, after having removed the dirt barricades. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Badhan road and searched civilians and vehicles.

The Israeli army also opened indiscriminate fire, searched a number of houses, and arrested 3 civilians. In ‘Askar refugee camp, the Israeli army partially demolished 1 house. At 06:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) The Israeli army raided the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Nablus as well as in the refugee camps of ‘Askar, Balata, and ‘Ein Beit el Ma’: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Rami Ghazi Zahran; (ii) Sa’eed S’oud Khaled; and (iii) Ala’ Na’im as Sarkaji. (iv) The Israeli army arrested Mohammed ‘Izz ad Din Yaseen in the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya. • <u>House Demolition:</u> The Israeli army partially demolished 1 house in ‘Askar refugee camp belonging to Nasser Hilmi Burghal.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Marda. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (v) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (vi) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za’tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari’el. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Marda and patrolled the area until 03:10.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al ‘Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the Jericho-Nablus road, denying civilian access, except for farmers holding Jericho IDs.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the "Container") checkpoint and to deny access to civilian vehicles, except for those possessing access permits. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, north of 'Ayda refugee camp, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Tuqu' and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 01:50, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the city of Beit Jala and searched 1 commercial shop. • Arrests: At 02:25 on 08 November 2006, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians, including 2 brothers, during its raid on the village of Harmala: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Ibrahim Saleem az Zeer; (ii) Yasser Mohammed 'Awadh Allah; and (iii) Mohammed Mahmoud 'Awadh Allah. (iv) The Israeli army arrested Ameer Saleem al Badan in the town of Tuqu'.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; and the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street

	<p>that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta. • Raids/Injuries: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron and opened fire, while pursuing civilians during a demonstration in protest and denunciation of the massacre perpetrated by the Israeli army in the town of Beit Hanun. The Israeli army attack resulted in the injury of 5 civilians. At 14:15, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Sa'ir and the village of Beit 'Einun. While patrolling the area, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. (iii) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Adh Dhahiriya. (iv) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura and arrested 1 Palestinian Police officer. (v) The Israeli army raided the village of Karma, searched a number of houses, and arrested 3 civilians (brothers). • Arrests: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army arrested Bassam 'Abed Faqquseh, a Palestinian Police officer, in the town of Dura. <p>The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the village of Karma:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Fajr 'Izzo al 'Awawdeh; (iii) Bader 'Izzo al 'Awawdeh; and (iv) Saif 'Izzo al 'Awawdeh. • Curfew: At 13:50, the Israeli army imposed curfew over the old city of Hebron. • Demonstration/Injuries: At 11:30, a mass demonstration marched through the streets of the city of Hebron in protest against the massacre perpetrated by the Israeli army in the town of Beit Hanun. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and protestors in the area of Bab az Zawiya, during which the Israeli army injured 2 civilians, including 1 child.

Beginning on 28 June 2006, the Israeli army has also reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the eastern border of the district of Rafah. • In protest and denunciation of the massacre committed by the Israeli army on the dawn 08 November 2006 in the town of Beit Hanun, a 3-day official mourning was declared, a general strike was observed throughout the Gaza Strip, and demonstrations took place. In the Beit

	<p>Hanun massacre, the Israeli army had killed 18 civilians and injured over 40 civilians, including numerous women and children.</p>
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases. • Attacks/Injuries/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, the Israeli army fired 1 missile mortar from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards the village of ‘Izbat ‘Abed Rabbu east of the town of Jabalya. (ii) At 09:20, the Israeli army fired a number of artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards the area of Al ‘Atatira north of the town of Beit Lahiya. Of these, 1 artillery shell landed on the building housing the Palestinian General Intelligence offices, injuring a child who happened to be in the area. (iii) At 12:30, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near Tallet al Kashef east of the town of Jabalya, injuring 1 civilian. (iv) At 13:50, the Israeli army opened fire from its position on Palestinian territory towards civilian houses in the area of Sha’sha’a east of the town of Jabalya, killing 1 civilian. (v) At 21:05, Israeli navy boats opened fire towards As Sudaniya beach northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. • Raids/Attacks/Injuries/House Occupation/Land Levelling: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Beginning at 09:00 on 05 November 2006, the Israeli army has remained positioned on Palestinian territory in the area of As Sudaniya northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. The Israeli army also opened intensive fire towards civilian houses, injuring 1 child. (ii) Beginning at 10:40 on 07 November 2006, the Israeli army has remained positioned on Palestinian territory near the village of ‘Izbat ‘Abed Rabbu, near the area of Sha’sha’a, and on Salah ad Din main road east of the town of Jabalya. The Israeli army also occupied 1 house, converted it into a military post, and continued to open fire towards civilians and their houses near Hamuda junction east of the town of Jabalya, killing 1 child and injuring 2 civilians. In addition, the Israeli army levelled agricultural land. • Air Patrol: At 08:20, Israeli combat helicopters patrolled the skies over the town of Beit Hanun. • Killings: The 18 civilians reported yesterday to have been killed by the Israeli army in the Beit Hanun massacre included 9 children and 5 female civilians. Of these, 17 civilians were from the same family, including 3 brothers along with their wives and a number of their children. Regardless of those reported yesterday, the killed civilians were identified as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Fatima Mas’oud al ‘Athamneh, a 5-year-old female child; (ii) Manal Ahmed al ‘Athamneh, a 3-year-old female child; (iii) Malak Sameer al ‘Athamneh, a 3-year-old female child; (iv) Maysa’ Ramzi al ‘Athamneh, a 3-year-old female child; (v) Sa’d Majdi al ‘Athamneh, 8 years old; (vi) Mahmoud Amjad al ‘Athamneh, 12 years old;
