WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army has intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and set up several checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and in the area surrounding Al Aqsa Mosque compound, preventing civilians under the age of 45 from accessing Al Aqsa Mosque to perform Friday prayers. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya checkpoint and to impede civilian access. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up at the entrance to the village of Beit Iksa and to impede civilian access. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, Beit Hanina, and around the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim. Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: An Israeli army patrol raided the town of Abu Dis and opened indiscriminate fire while patrolling the street adjacent to Al Quds University.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the 'Atara overpass checkpoint, impeding civilian access. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, and in the town of Beituniya. Demonstration: A mass demonstration, including international peace activists, took place in the village of Bil'in in protest against Wall construction. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and protestors, during which the Israeli army arrested 1 civilian protestor. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Ja'far Burnat in the village of Bil'in.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades As Suweitat road southeast of the city of Jenin. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and to impede civilian access.

• <u>Wall Construction</u>: Land levelling for Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the village of Immatin and east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access.
- (ii) At 16:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the western entrance to the village of 'Izbat at Tabib and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. The Israeli army also continues to force civilians to travel along an unpaved 1.5-km-long road, which branches off from the Nablus-Tulkarem road and intersects with the Nablus-Jenin road opposite the village of Sabastiya.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing Huwwara, Beit Iba, At Tur Mountain, and Beit Furik checkpoints around the city of Nablus. The Israeli army closes the checkpoints overnight and reopens them at various morning hours, with the exception of Huwwara checkpoint where civilians may exit the city of Nablus from 05:00 to 23:00 only, but entry is allowed around the clock.
- (ii) At 19:45, the Israeli army closed Beit Iba and Huwwara checkpoints, denying civilian access in both directions, and reopened them at a later time.

• Raids/Curfew/Medical Obstruction:

- (i) At 19:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Beita and imposed curfew. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 2 children. Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint south of the city of Nablus arrested the 2 injured children from an ambulance transporting them to hospital, after halting and searching the ambulance.
- (ii) At 21:45, Israeli Special Forces, disguised in civilian clothes and driving a civilian vehicle, raided the city of Nablus, took position on Al Quds Street, and withdrew at a later time.
- <u>Arrests</u>: Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint arrested 2 children injured in the village of Beita from an ambulance:
- (i) Qays Faze' Dawoud, 16 years old; and
- (ii) Tharwat Ribhi Dweikat, 16 years old.

SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current Intifada (Uprising). The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan with an iron gate. The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the towns of Jamma'in and Kafr ad Dik with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to close the western entrance to the village of Bruqin with dirt barricades. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the road connecting the town of Deir Ballut and the village of Rafat. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various morning hours, impeding civilian access. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.
JERICHO	 Closure: Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army prevents farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for Jerusalem and Jericho ID holders. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus. At 16:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the DCO checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and searched civilians and vehicles, impeding civilian access in both directions.
ВЕТНІЕНЕМ	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians' residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem. The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the villages of Husan and Nahhalin with cement blocks. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala.

• Raids/Physical Assault/Detentions/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:

- (i) At 17:10, the Israeli army raided 'Ayda refugee camp and detained 14-year-old Abdul 'Azeez Abu Srour after severely beating him.
- (ii) At 18:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Al Khadr and detained Ali Hasan Nawasrah, a Palestinian National Security officer on duty at a Palestinian National Security checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Al Khadr. At 23:15, the Israeli army raided the town again and patrolled the area.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and barbed wire Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh, and with an iron gate the old gold market, all in the H2 section of the city of Hebron, denying access to civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the only entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp with an iron gate.

• Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close Road # 60 that passes through the Gush 'Etzion settlement block on the road to the city of Hebron. The Israeli army also continues to force civilian vehicles travelling between the districts of Hebron and Bethlehem to take the eastern road that connects the town of Za'tara junction, located east of the city of Bethlehem, to the city of Hebron.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close Road # 35 between the towns of Tarqumiya and Idhna, denying access to civilian vehicles.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to the village of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa'.
- <u>Raid</u>: At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Adh Dhahiriya, set up a checkpoint in the town's centre, and searched civilians and vehicles.

HEBRON

• The Israeli army continues to impose a closure on Gaza Strip districts, after a Palestinian individual carried out a suicide attack in the city of Al Khudeira (Hadera) inside the Green Line, and to prevent civilians and workers from crossing the Green Line.

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to humanitarian cases and VIPs only.
- Attack: At 06:30, the Israeli army opened fire from its location inside the Green Line towards 1 civilian while he was present 100 meters away from the Green Line northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya.

	• <u>Palestinian Attack</u> : At 12:30, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Al Muntar (Karnei) Crossing is closed. Nahal 'Oz Crossing is closed. Attack: At 08:55, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from Point 70 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of Gaza city.
CENTRAL GAZA	• <u>Attack</u> : At 04:50, the Israeli army fired several tank shells from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory in Wadi Gaza east of Al Bureij refugee camp.
KHAN YUNIS	Activities not reported.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.
