WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Rafat and Ramot checkpoints, as well as the checkpoint set up near the village of Jaba'
- <u>Attack on religious sites</u>: A bunch of settlers accompanied by the Affairs of the Retired Minister in the Israeli government, backed up by the Israeli army, stormed into the courtyards of the al-Aqsa Mosque and the eastern part of the Marwani shrine.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit

JERUSALEM

	Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
RAMALLAH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. Flving Checkpoints: At 14:00, the Israeli army set up two checkpoints between the towns of Beit Rima and Deir Ghassanah, and at the entrance to the village of al-Nabi Saleh, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 00:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of al-Bireh, set up a checkpoint, and withdrew at 01:30. Demonstrations: At 12:00, a public march set out in the town of Beit Liqya and the villages of Beit Sira, Beit 'Ur al0tahta, 'Beit 'Ur al-Foqa, al-Tira, Safa, Kharbatah al-Misbah which is located to the west of Ramallah district, with the participation of international supporters and peace activists, towards the bridge between the villages of Beit 'Ur al-Tahta and Kharbatah al-Misbah, in protest of the Israeli policy of discrimination which has been preventing Palestinian vehicles for seven years from driving on Road 443 that connects the villages with the city of Ramallah. Only Israeli vehicles are allowed to drive of this road. The Israeli army attacked protestors. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Tayaseer checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. Flying Checkpoints: At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the town of Arraba and the village of Fahma. At 19:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the town of al-Zababdeh, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 12:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area of Khilet Ghassan that is located between the villages of al-Far'a and al-Badhan. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a

- closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.
- Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamish.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city). At 17:00, the Israeli army denied civilians between the age of 16 and 35 access through the 'Einav checkpoint.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:35, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the town of Bal'a, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 16:10, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem, and searched civilians and vehicles until 16:55.
- <u>Arrests</u>: at 18:10, the Israeli army arrested at Jbara checkpoint civilian Saleh Ziyad al-Zeitawi.
- <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.

• Closure of Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun as well as the road that connects the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Izbat at Tabib.
- (ii) The Israeli army continued to close the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun with an iron gate.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of Habla, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 18:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of Imatin, and searched civilians and vehicles.

• <u>Raids</u>:

- (i) At 12:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqilya, and opened fire and fired sound bombs during patrol.
- (ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Hijjeh, imposed curfew and opened fire and fired sound bombs under the pretext of stone throwing.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 15:00, a bunch of settlers stoned civilians vehicles on Nablus-Qalqilya road near the village of Kfar Qaddoum. At once the Israeli army intervened and evacuated the settlers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal

	Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.		
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al- Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.		
	(iv) The Israeli army continues to block the roads leading to the town of al- Jama'een with dirt barricades.		
	• <u>Checkpoints</u> : The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:		
	(i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on		
	Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other		
	days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.		
	(ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit		
NABLUS	Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.		
	(iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close		
	the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing,		
	only allowing access to humanitarian cases.		
	(iv) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the checkpoints		
	around the city of Nablus and impeded traffic.		
	(v) The Israeli army razed land in the area near Beit Iba checkpoint that is		
	set up at the western entrance to the city of Nablus. In addition, the		
	Israeli army set up 3 metal gates at the checkpoint for civilian access.		
	• Flying Checkpoints: At 18:25, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on		
	Nablus-Jenin main road, and searched civilians and vehicles.		
	• Raids: At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Nablus.		
	• Arrests: At 14:00, the Israeli army stationed at Huwara checkpoint arrested		
	civilian Abdel Karim Ibrahim al Saga.		
	• Settler Violence: A settler dumped large amounts of expired juice towards		
	civilians near the village of Burqa. At once the Palestinian police arrived		
	and got rid of the juice.		
	Closure of Main Roads:		
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to		
	the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current		
SALFIT	Intifada (Uprising).		
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western		
	entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western		
	entrance to the town of Kafr al-Dik.		

Checkpoints: (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tarah checkpoints and to deny civilian access. At 13:10, the Israeli army closed Za'tarah checkpoint and opened it at 13:40. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the junction of the town of Za'tarah and impede traffic. (iii) At 08:00, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the towns of Deir Ballout and Kafr al-Dik and impeded traffic in both directions. Raids: At 17:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the villages of Amouriyyah and Khirbet Qais. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ari'el. Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. **JERICHO** Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahour and Bethlehem. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to **BETHLEHEM** Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Raids: (i) At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, searched a number of houses and arrested 3 civilians. In addition, the Israeli army handed one civilian a notice to report to the Israeli intelligence. The raid recurred 1t 02:55 during which the Israeli army arrested one civilian, and then withdrew at 03:50. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala. (ii) At 02:40, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al-Dheisheh, (iii) searched a number of houses, arrested one civilian, and withdrew at

03:50.

• Arrests:

- (i) The 4 civilians arrested in the city of Bethlehem are:
- (a) Hassan Mohammad al-Wirdyan;
- (b) Adel Fawzi Nawawreh;
- (c) Ayesh ibrahim Nawawreh; and
- (d) Fathi Awad al-Hreimi.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in al-Dheisheh refugee camp is Tareq Ibrahim al-Effendi.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- (iii) At 13:00, the Israeli army closed the entrance to the town of Beit 'Ummar with an iron gate after clashes with civilians.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 13:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the area of al-Nabi Younis.
- (ii) At 20:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the road of Wadi al-Qaf that leads to the town of Tarqumia and fired illumination bombs.

• Raids:

- (i) At 03:00 on October 15, the Israeli army raided the town of Edna, and arrested 2 civilians.
- (ii) At 08:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron. The raid recurred at 23:00.
- (iii) At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Tafouh, and arrested one civilian.
- (iv) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Halhoul and set up a checkpoint.
- (v) At 00:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura.

• Arrests:

- (i) At 15:00, the Israeli army arrested near the al-Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron civilian Ahmad Mousa al-Toubasi under the pretext of possessing a knife.
- (ii) The two civilians arrested in the town of Edna are:
 - (a) Rizek Shafik Abu Mreizek; and
 - (b) Taled Abdallah al-Nattah.
- (iii) The civilian arrested in the town of Tafouh is Ahmad abdel Rahman Izreikat.
 - **<u>Detentions</u>**: At 14:00, the Israeli army detained at the entrance to al-Shuhada' Street in the old city of Hebron a civilian who was carrying a gas cylinder to his house and denied him access except after the intervention of the military liaison at 14:30.
 - <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

- (i) At 13:00, Israeli combat helicopters fired missiles at armed individuals west of the town of Beit Hanoun as they were trying to fire mortars towards the Green Line, resulting in the death of two armed individuals and the injury of four, one called Mohammad Ribhi Shabat who was seriously injured.
- (ii) At 13:20, Israeli combat helicopters fired two missiles towards Palestinian areas near the town of Beit Hanoun. One missile hit an electric transformer and damaged it.
- **Deaths**: The two armed individuals who were killed in the town of Beit Hanoun
