# ALL DISTRICTS

on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

# • <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. The Israeli army denied worshippers to hold prayer in al-Aqsa Mosque and celebrate the Night of al-Qader (Decree).

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (a) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (b) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (c) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.

# • Checkpoints:

#### **JERUSALEM**

- (a) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.
- (b) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Rafat and Ramot checkpoints, and the checkpoint set up near the village of Jaba'a, and impeded civilian access.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the settler bypass road connecting 'Assur Hill in the village of Kafr Malik to Alon settler bypass road.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 12:10, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of Surda, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 15:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of al-Nabi Saleh, and impeded traffic until 16:15.
- (iii) At 01:00. the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of Joljolya, and searched civilians and vehicles.

#### Raids:

- (i) At 22:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Surda.
- (ii) At 01:15, 4 Israeli military jeeps raided and patrolled the town of Abaween.
- (iii) At 01:30, 6 Israeli military jeeps raided the town of Aroura, searched one house, and arrested one civilian.
- (iv) At 01:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Birzeit, set up a checkpoint at the junction of Birzeit University. Additionally, confrontations broke out between Palestinian civilians and the Israeli army.
- <u>Attacks</u>: At 13:15, the Israeli army assigned with guarding the apartheid Wall fired tear gas bombs intensively towards civilian houses the city of al-Bireh.

#### • Arrests:

- (i) The Israseli army arrested civilian Ziyad Ahmad al-Fararjah in the city of Bethlehem while he was attending the trial of his brother at the investigation and detention center in Ophra detention camp near the town of Beitunia.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in the town of Aroura is Bakr Mahmnoud Bakr.
- <u>Detentions</u>: At 11:30, the Israeli army detained on the bridge of the town of Attara 2 Palestinian military officers claiming they had a knife in the vehicle they were driving. The officers were released at 13:00 after the intervention of the military liaison office.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.

#### **JENIN**

• <u>Closure of Main Road</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of

In addition, the Israeli army continued to occupy a house turning it into a military checkpoint. The Israeli army also searched a number of houses and incurred damage to furniture of 2 houses, arrested 2 civilian brothers, and demolished a store for agricultural equipment and the fence of a house. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> </ul>

town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrat; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to (ii) implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following (i) locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif **HEBRON** to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp. In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to (ii) prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. Flying Checkpoints: At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the bridge of the town of Halhoul, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Halhoul. At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Beit (ii) 'Ummar. At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, and arrested one (iii) **Arrests**: The civilian arrested in the city of Hebron is Wissam Khaireddin Abu Rajab. Settler Violence: At 14:00, a bunch of extremist settlers threw paint at Palestinian civilians in the old city of Hebron. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

GAZA	<ul> <li>Closure of Crossing Points:         <ol> <li>Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is partially open.</li> <li>Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is partially open to let in fuel.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Air Patrols: At 07:20, Israeli helicopters and surveillance aircrafts flew over northern Gaza.</li> <li>Palestinian Attacks: In the evening of October 11, 2007, armed individuals opened fire towards a control tower on the Green Line east of the city of Gaza, and at once the Israeli army opened fire intensively towards our areas.</li> </ul>
KHAN YOUNIS	<ul> <li>Raids: <ol> <li>In the morning of October 10, Israel military infantry, backed up by tanks and helicopters, raided the area of al-Fukhari east of the city of Khan Younis. The Israeli army opened fire intensively while searching a number of houses, engaged in armed confrontations with armed individuals and razed agricultural land. The Israeli army also occupied a number of houses and turned them into military posts.</li> <li>At 02:00, an Israeli special force unit, backed up by helicopters and surveillance aircrafts, raided our areas east of the town of al-Qarara, and engaged in armed confrontations with armed groups.</li> </ol> </li></ul>
RAFAH	<ul> <li>Closure of Crossing Points:         <ul> <li>Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.</li> <li>Rafah (al-Awdah) Crossing is closed.</li> <li>Sufa Crossing is partially open.</li> <li>Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Attacks: At dawn on October 10, 2007, Israeli navy opened fire and fired missiles towards Palestinian fishermen at the sea and the shore of the city of Rafah, and incurred material damage to property.</li> </ul>
