Raid: At 01:00, the Israeli army, including several tanks and 2 bulldozers, raided Palestinian territory north of the city of Rafah, demolished 1 house, levelled 7 dunums (1.75 acres) of agricultural land, and withdrew at 01:35. House Demolition: The Israeli army demolished 1 house north of the city of Rafah belonging to Omar Abu Zayed. Palestinian Attacks: (i) At 02:00, 1 Qassam mortar was fired towards the settlement of Rafiah Yam. (ii) At 07:00, a gun battle took place between Palestinian fighters and the Israeli army near the settlement of Rafiah Yam, during which the Israeli army killed 2 fighters.
