on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. The Israeli army prevented worshippers from holding Friday prayer in al-Aqsa Mosque.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (a) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (b) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (c) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.

• Checkpoints:

JERUSALEM

- (a) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.
- (b) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Rafat and Ramot checkpoints, and the checkpoint set up near the village of Jaba'a, and impeded civilian access.
- <u>Attacks</u>: At 00:40, the Israeli army stationed at Qalandia military checkpoint opened fire towards civilian houses in Qalandia.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

Flying Checkpoints: At 18:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Ein al-Dyouk, arrested on civilian after attacking passengers in a bus, and withdrew at 23:00. Arrests: The civilian arrested in Ein al-Dyouk has not been identified.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Flying Checkpoints: At 20:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of al-Nashash area (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and searched civilians and vehicles until 21:00. Raids: At 16:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Khader. At 17:00, 4 Israeli military jeeps raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala. The raid recurred at 00:10 during which the Israeli army searched a number of houses. At 20:05, the Israeli army raided the town of Teqoa, and engaged in confrontations with civilians during patrol. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.
HEBRON	• Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless

they possess access permits.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the bridge of the town of Halhoul, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 19:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the refugee camp of al-Fawwar, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 24:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the villages of Kharsa and al-Tabaqa.
- (iv) At 01:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area of al-Sahla in the old city of Hebron.

• Raids:

- (i) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided the area of Ras al-'Aroud in the town of Sa'ir and engaged in confrontations with civilians. As a result, damage was incurred to the electrical transformer. In addition, the Israeli army searched one house, arrested one civilian and withdrew at 01:00.
- (ii) At 23:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura, searched one house, and handed a civilian a notice to see the Israeli intelligence.
- (iii) At 14:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron.
- (iv) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Thahiriyyeh.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The civilian arrested in Ras al-'Aroud in the town of Sa'ir is Anwar Mohammad Jaradat.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta. The part of the Wall located near the village of Arab al-Ramadin has been completed.

Attacks: At 17:30, Israeli navy boats fired a missile towards a fishing boat near Gaza city shore resulting in the death of 2 civilians including an armed individual, and the destruction of the fishing boat. Deaths: The 2 civilians killed in Gaza shore Ra'ed Shamlakh and Nizar Abu Arab.
KHAN YOUNIS	• Raids: On October 20, the Israeli special force unit raided our areas by 100 in depth north of the town of al-Qarara, and engaged in armed confrontations with armed individuals. At once, Israeli helicopters and surveillance aircrafts flew over the area.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (al-Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
