ALL DISTRICTS	• Since 15 August 2005, the Israeli army has continued to impose a complete closure over the West Bank and Gaza Strip and declare them closed military zones. The Israeli army prevented civilians, including workers, from entering the city of Jerusalem or crossing the Green Line in order to complete the demolition of settler houses in 4 Israeli settlements in the district of Jenin and in all evacuated settlements in the Gaza Strip.

• <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint, connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus, and to impede civilian access.

## • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 13:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along Al Mu'arrajat road, connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah, and searched civilians and vehicles until 14:00.
- (ii) At 18:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of 'Ein ad Duyuk, prevented civilian vehicles leaving the city of Jericho from crossing, and thoroughly searched vehicles entering the city, impeding civilian access until 00:30.
- Raid/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 20:30, an Israeli army patrol raided Palestinian Authority controlled territory in the area of Adh Dahiyat in the city of Jericho, patrolled the area 50 meters away from 1 Palestinian National Security checkpoint, and withdrew at a later time.
- <u>Palestinian Security Measure</u>: At 05:00 on 31 August 2005, Palestinian security forces provided protection to a number of Jewish worshippers while they were visiting a synagogue in the city of Jericho.
- <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man, in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers civilians' residence in the village illegal.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along Wadi an Nar road between the town of Al 'Ubeidiya and the village of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and searched civilians and vehicles until 11:45.
- (ii) At 22:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Fajjar and searched civilians and vehicles.

#### Raids:

- (i) At 01:15, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala.
- (ii) At 01:15, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Beit Fajjar.
- <u>Air Patrol</u>: At 11:15, Israeli army helicopters patrolled the skies over the city of Bethlehem and its suburbs.
- Palestinian Attack/Raid: At 21:15, an armed Palestinian individual threw 1 handmade explosive device at the entrance to Gilo tunnel along Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army closed the DCO checkpoint and prevented civilians from crossing. The Israeli army also raided the city of Beit Jala, set up 2 checkpoints at the entrance to the Beit Jala housing project and on the junction to the settlement of Kfar 'Etzion, between the districts of Bethlehem and Hebron, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian movement until 22:30.

#### **BETHLEHEM**

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh in the H2 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks and barbed wire, denying access to civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shallala old and new streets in the H1 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks located 300 meters inside the H1 section.
- Closure of Main Road: At 23:40, the Israeli army closed Road # 60 between the town of Beit Ummar and Al 'Arrub refugee camp, claiming to be investigating a suspicious object along the road. The road was reopened after the suspicious object was removed.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to the village of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa'.

## • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 21:40, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints at the entrance to the town of Dura and in the area between the villages of As Sikka and Al Majd and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul and searched civilians and vehicles.

### • Raids/House Occupation:

- (i) At 11:40, the Israeli army raided the area of Bab az Zawiya in the city of Hebron, occupied 1 building, and converted it into a military post.
- (ii) At 15:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Beit Kahil and served summons to a number of civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence Service.
- <u>Detention</u>: At 16:00, the Israeli army searched 1 building in the old city of Hebron and detained 1 Palestinian National Security officer and 1 Palestinian Police officer.
- <u>House Occupation</u>: At 14:00, the Israeli army occupied 1 house near the settlement of Kiryat Arba' in the old city of Hebron and converted it into a military post.

## • Land Confiscation:

- (i) The Israeli army issued Military Order # T/92/05 to confiscate 15 m<sup>2</sup> of civilian land in the area between the villages of Um al 'Abed and Karma in order to install security equipment in the area surrounding the settlement of 'Otni'el.
- (ii) The Israeli army issued Military Order # T/94/05 to confiscate 7 m<sup>2</sup> of civilian land in the area of Al Harayeq near the settlement of Hagai south of the city of Hebron in order to install security equipment in the area surrounding the settlement.
