ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.</li> </ul>

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound.</li> <li><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li><b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.</li> <li><b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Qalandiya and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li><b>Raids/Injuries/Physical Assault:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 03:15, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided Qalandiya refugee camp and searched 1 house belonging to Ra'fat Ahmed as Sar'awi, a political prisoner, after having brought As Sar'awi from prison along with it. At 02:10, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 6 civilians.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army raided the town of 'Anata and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army raided Dahiyat ar Ram in the city of Jerusalem, searched 1 house, beat 1 female civilian, and served a summons to 1 civilian to report to the Israeli Intelligence.</li> <li>• <b>Arrest:</b> The Israeli army arrested Mu'tassem Shams ad Din al Qawasmi in the town of 'Anata.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RAMALLAH &amp; EL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the area between the town of Silwad and the village of Yabrud on the Ramallah-Jericho road as well as the western entrance to the village of Saffa.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud and the village of Beit Sira.</li> <li>• <b>Raids/Detention:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:00, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the town of Deir Ghassana and searched 1 house.</li> <li>(ii) At 19:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Beit Rima.</li> <li>(iii) At 01:35, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the town of Beituniya and searched 1 building after detaining residents. The Israeli army also arrested 1 civilian and withdrew at 02:10.</li> <li>(iv) At 03:30, the Israeli army, including 8 jeeps, raided the villages of Kafr 'Ein and the Qarawat Bani Zeid and patrolled the area until 05:30.</li> <li>(v) The Israeli army raided the town of Turmus'ayya, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Arrest:</b> The Israeli army arrested Yasser Khalayleh in the town of Beituniya.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JENIN</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Road:</b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. The Israeli army also continues to operate a surveillance camera in order to observe the area surrounding the checkpoint.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints/Detention:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the village of Sanur, searched civilian vehicles, and detained Sami Ali as Souss, a Palestinian National Security officer. At 19:40, Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint released As Souss, after having served him a summons to report to the Israeli Intelligence.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one in the area between the town of Az Zababida and the village of Al Kufeir and the other on the junction to the village of Fahma, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following roads: the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the Dahiyat Dhinnaba-Kafr al Labad road; the Kafr al Labad-Shufa road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the Kafr Sur-Wadi at Tin road; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain; and the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to the village of Al Masqufa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the road connecting the town of Beit Lid to the village of Kur.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road as well as at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem). At 'Einav checkpoint, the Israeli army has confined crossing times to the period between 07:00 and 17:00 every day.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b>Raids/Injuries:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 17:00, Israeli Special Forces, supported by 14 Israeli army jeeps and 2 trucks, raided the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp. While raiding a commercial shop in the refugee camp, the Israeli army opened intensive fire, injuring 3 civilians, including 1 child. At 17:50, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:40, an Israeli army patrol raided Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem and patrolled the area.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>QALQILIYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to school students under 16 years of age unless they are accompanied by one of their parents.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and prevented civilian vehicles from entering the city, only allowing access to civilians holding Qalqiliya-issued IDs. At 12:30, Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint denied civilian access in both directions until 14:30.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the settlement of Karnei Shomron on the Qalqiliya-Nablus main road and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Detentions:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:30, the Israeli army raided the area surrounding the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and combed plant nurseries in the area. The Israeli army also detained 2 civilians and released them at 16:50.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Hajja. Confrontations took place between civilians and the Israeli army while it was patrolling the area.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Badhan road, which is the north-eastern entrance to the city of Nablus, as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00.</li> <li>(ii) Al Badhan checkpoint (set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Nablus) remains closed with dirt barricades.</li> <li>(iii) Nablus-'Asira ash Shamaliya checkpoint (set up at the northern entrance to city) is open from 06:30 to 20:00.</li> <li>(iv) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only.</li> <li>(v) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> At 14:45, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one at the entrance to the village of Beita and the other on the junction to the settlement of Yitzhar. Claiming to be investigating a suspicious object, Israeli troops positioned at the 2 flying checkpoints denied civilian access in both directions until 16:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Qalil, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided Balata refugee camp in the city of Nablus and arrested 2 civilians, including 1 child.</p> <p>(iii) At 03:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and ‘Askar refugee camp, searched a number of houses, and arrested 1 civilian in the refugee camp.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> <p>(i) At 12:15, Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint arrested Yousef Ziyad Zeid, a Palestinian National Security officer.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army arrested Fadi Nayef ‘Amer in the village of Kafr Qalil. The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in Balata refugee camp:</p> <p>(iii) Omar Bassam ‘Qar’awi, 17 years old; and</p> <p>(iv) Hussein Darweesh Qar’an.</p> <p>(v) The Israeli army arrested Fadi Khaled Abu Kishek in ‘Askar refugee camp.</p> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> At 12:15, Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint detained Zeid Rizq Hamdiyyeh, a Palestinian National Security officer, and released him at 13:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence/Destruction of Property:</u></b> At 13:15, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Yitzhar set fire to civilian land cultivated with trees in the north-western area of the town of Huwwara.</li> <li>• <b><u>Palestinian Attack:</u></b> At 01:40, armed Palestinian individuals threw an explosive device at an Israeli army jeep near Huwwara checkpoint, but it did not explode. Consequently, the Israeli army combed the area surrounding Huwwara checkpoint.</li> </ul>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <p>(i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Marda. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik.</p> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za’tara junction checkpoint and to deny access to civilians under 35 years of age. The Israeli army also denied access to the district of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank.</p> <p>(iii) At 14:45, the Israeli army closed the Za’tara junction checkpoint and denied civilian access in both directions until 16:00.</p> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari’el.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 19:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Kafr ad Dik.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the city of Salfit and took position near 1 Palestinian National Security checkpoint until 03:25.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrest:</u></b> At 13:00, Israeli troops positioned at the Za'tara junction checkpoint arrested Mohammed S'oud Sawaftah, a Palestinian Police officer.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the Jericho-Nablus road, denying civilian access, except for farmers holding Jericho IDs.</li> </ul>
<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the "Container") checkpoint and to deny access to civilian vehicles, except for those possessing access permits.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, north of 'Ayda refugee camp, and northwest of the city of Beit Jala.</li> </ul>
<b>HEBRON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.</li> <li>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the entrance to the village of 'Arab ar Ramadin. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.</p> <p>(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues: in the section between the area south of the town of Beit Ula and Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal; the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin; and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <p>(i) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Idhna and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(ii) At 23:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:</u></b> <p>(i) At 02:30 on 17 September 2006, the Israeli army raided the area of 'Aqabet Taffuh in the city of Hebron and arrested 1 female civilian.</p> <p>(ii) At 02:00, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Dura.</p> <p>(iii) At 04:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, raided 1 Palestinian Police station in the area of Al Hawuz, and arrested 2 Palestinian Police officers. At 04:35, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</p> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> <p>(i) The Israeli army arrested Noura Mohammed Jaber in the area of 'Aqabet Taffuh in the city of Hebron.</p> <p>The Israeli army arrested 2 Palestinian Police officers in the area of Al Hawuz in the city of Hebron:</p> <p>(ii) Mohammed Ibrahim Tneineh; and</p> <p>(iii) Abdul Haleem Hasan Isleimiyeh.</p> </li> <li>• <b><u>House Occupation:</u></b> The Israeli army occupied and converted into a military post 1 house belonging to Na'im Salloum in the area of Al Kassara in the old city of Hebron.</li> </ul>

Beginning on 28 June 2006, the Israeli army has also reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the eastern border of the district of Rafah.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NORTHERN GAZA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Crossing Point:</b> Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases.</li> <li>• <b>Attacks:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Between 08:00 on 17 September 2006 and 08:00 on 18 September 2006, the Israeli army fired 9 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory around the area of Al Hawuz north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
