
# Timeline: Israel's 20th Knesset

## July

Israeli settlers burn to death the Dawabshe family, killing 18-month-old toddler Ali Dawabshe and his parents.

#### August

Despite international protests, Israel resumes construction of its illegal Annexation Wall in the Cremisan Valley, Beit Jala.

#### March

Israel declares nearly 580 acres of Jericho as "state land," thereby confiscating it as its own.

#### October

Israeli Government approves the construction of a new colonial-settlement in the Nablus Governorate.

## February

New Israeli law legalizes theft of Palestinian land by Israeli settlers.

## July

Palestinians in Jerusalem peacefully protest for nearly two weeks against the Israeli decision to install metal detectors at the entrances of Al-Aqsa Mosque Compound.

### August

The Israeli government announces its intent to demolish and forcibly transfer the Palestinian villages of Khan Al-Ahmar and Susiya.

## January

Israel's parliament approves amendment to Basic Law "Jerusalem is the capital of Israel", requiring a majority vote of 80 members of parliament, out of 120, to any further amendments.

#### January

Construction began in the settlement of Amichai, first new settlement since 1996.

#### January 25

Christian denominations and Heads of Churches protest Israeli violations of the historic "Status Quo" agreement by closing the Church of the Holy Sepulcher for the second time since 1967.

### March 30

The launch of the "Great March of Return" in Gaza.

## July

Approval of Israel's "Nation-State" Basic Law.

#### Decembe

Israeli settlers try to establish a new colonial-installation in the heart of the Battir world Heritage Site.

April 2015 to March 2019

## January

Israel decides to expel the Temporary International Presence in Hebron (TIPH), the only official mission of international observers in the occupied Palestinian territory.

## February

Palestinians reopen Bab Al Rahmeh (Gate of Mercy) of Al-Aqsa Mosque Compound, closed by Israel since 2003.

#### March

PM Netanyahu suggests that US recognition of Israel's sovereignty over the occupied Syrian Golan Heights would have consequences regarding the occupied West Bank.

#### lune

UN excludes Israel from the list of countries that commit grave violations against children in armed conflict.

## November

EU publishes Guidelines to label Israeli settlement products. (not yet enforced).

#### March

UNHRC calls on the UN to publish the database of companies involved in Israeli settlements (not yet published).

## April

French Initiative is launched towards pushing the Middle East Peace Process forward through a multilateral framework.

#### Iulv

A Quartet Report highlights a symmetry between the occupying power and the occupied population.

## December

The UN Security Council adopts Resolution 2334 reaffirming the illegality of Israeli settlements/ the importance of the 1967 border.

## November

British PM Theresa May participates in celebration of 100 years of the Balfour Declaration, which promised the land of historic Palestine to the Zionist movement.

#### December 6

US Recognition of Jerusalem as Israel's capital.

#### December

UNGA adopts a new resolution rejecting the US declaration on Jerusalem.

## January 16

US freezes \$65 million in aid to UNRWA.

#### May 14

The inauguration of the US Embassy in occupied Jerusalem.

#### Ju

Irish Parliament approves (in the first reading) a bill banning Israeli settlement products.

#### Novembe

Chilean Parliament approves a resolution calling upon its government to ban Israeli settlement products.

#### Marc

Closure of US Consulate General in Jerusalem, inaugurated as a diplomatic mission in 1844.

## March 25

US Recognition of the illegal Israeli annexation of the occupied Syrian Golan Heights.
