WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) The city of Jerusalem remains closed to residents from other districts. Thousands of worshipers were prevented from entering Jerusalem for Friday prayers at Al Aqsa mosque. (ii) The Israeli army continues to impose a strict closure on the West Bank and Gaza Strip. Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the separation wall was suspended for the weekend in Al Shayyah, Abu Dis, and Al Sawahira.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Separation Wall Construction: Construction activities in the area of Budrus were suspended for the weekend. Raids: At 10:20, and again at 16:20 and 17:00, an Israeli jeep raided the village of Kafr 'Ein. At 10:25, an Israeli jeep raided the towns of Beit Rima, Deir Ghassana and the village of Kafr 'Ein. At 23:00, an Israeli jeep raided the town of Beit Rima.
JENIN	 Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits which are based on no specific criteria. Separation Wall Construction: Israeli activities in the village of Bardala in preparation for construction of the eastern portion of the separation wall were suspended for the weekend. Israeli activities near the village of Raba for construction of the eastern portion of the separation wall were suspended for the weekend. Shepherds were prohibited from taking their livestock to graze in pasturelands in the area of Raba. Raids: At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Yamun, searched several houses, and detained 9 civilians, including 1 child and 2 brothers, who were released after 24 hours. At 23:00, the Israeli army, including 6 APCs, raided the eastern

(v) At 00:20, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided Tulkarem city. • Air Patrol: At 10:30, 4 Israeli helicopters patrolled the skies over the city.
NABLUS	 Closure: Nablus remains a closed military area. Detentions: At 11:00, Israeli soldiers located at the checkpoint near Beit Iba detained several college students and confiscated their IDs until 15:00. The students were released after intervention from the US consulate. Incursion: The Israeli army continues to occupy the city of Nablus. The Israeli army continues to impose curfew over the city and its refugee camps, searched houses, leveled the remnants of historic houses that were demolished yesterday, opened fire towards civilians who attempted to stop the leveling of the valuable ruins, injured 4 civilians, including 2 children, severely beat 2 children and prevented ambulances from reaching the site to transport the injured to hospital. Raid: At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya, searched several houses and arrested 4 civilians, including 1 officer. Injuries: The Israeli army injured 2 children in the city of Nablus: (i) Mas'ud Abu Salih, 16 years old, shot in the shoulder; and (ii) Ala Basyuni, 17 years old, shot in the left arm. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians from the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya: (i) Ala Yasin, 27 years old, Palestinian Civil Defense officer; (ii) Muhammad Izzat Rawajba, 24 years old, college student; (iii) Adli Al Shuli, 27 years old; and (iv) Basil Yasin.

QALQILYA	 <u>Separation Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits which are based on no specific criteria. <u>Raid</u>: At 08:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Funduq and imposed curfew.

 Closure: The Israeli army closed all entrances to the city of Salfit prohibited fire trucks from reaching the village of Deir Ballut to extinguish a fire, resulting in the burning down of a 2 storey house. GAZA STRIP

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure: The Erez crossing is partially open to workers. Attack: At 16:00, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location near Point 27 towards the town of Beit Hanoun.
GAZA CITY	 <u>Closure</u>: Al Shuhada' junction remains closed. <u>Attack</u>: At 16:45, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location in the settlement of Nitsareem towards the east.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Attack: At 23:40, the Israeli army opened fire from its location in the settlement of Kfar Daroom in different directions, injuring 3 children. Raid: At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the area located east of Wadi al Salqa, searched several houses and arrested 11 civilians, including 5 females and 3 elderly civilians. Injuries: The Israeli army injured 3 children: Abdallah al Odini, 3 years old; Yesmin Abu Maghasib, 13 years old; and Elham al Odini, 13 years old. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 11 civilians from Wadi Salqa:

KHAN YUNIS	 Closure: Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. Abu Holi road is partially opened. Land Leveling: At 10:00, Israeli bulldozers leveled a Palestinian National Security location in the area of Al Qarara and expanded a road leading to the settlement of Kissufim. Attack: At 16:00, the Israeli army opened fire from its location in the settlement of Hazani towards civilian houses in the western neighborhood, injuring 1 civilian. Raid: At 18:30, the Israeli army raided the area of Al Qarara, 100 meters into Palestinian territory, occupied 1 house and converted it into a military post.
RAFAH	 <u>Closure</u>: The Gaza International Airport remains closed. <u>Land Leveling</u>: The Israeli army confiscated 50 <i>dunums</i> (12.5 acres) of land belonging to Palestinian civilians near the settlement of Morag in order to build a wall to enclose the settlement. <u>Attack</u>: At 18:30, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location near Point 6 towards the Barazili neighborhood.
